Noisy venues in Anjuna, Vagator under GSCPCR radar

Commission for Protection of Child Rights instructs Police, Pollution Control Board and North Magistrate to carry out rigorous enforcement operations against bars, clubs and restaurants for blatantly violating noise control regulations, thereby disrupting the peace of students during examination period

PANJIM: In a stern directive targeting bars, clubs and restaurants in the Anjuna and Vagator areas, the Goa State Commission for Protection of Child Rights (GSCPCR) has instructed Goa Police, Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSP-CB) and the North Goa District

SOUND CHECK

Magistrate to carry out immediate and rigorous enforcement operations against them.

The GSCPCR has noted that the establishments have been identified for blatantly violating noise control regulations, thereby disrupting the peace and affecting the well-being of students. particularly during their examination period.

"These operations are called for the crucial months of March, April, and May when students are most in need of a quiet environment to concentrate on their studies," it said.

PROTECTING **CHILDREN'S RIGHTS**

► The directive has been issued after the Commission received number complaints about the excessive noise levels emanating from entertainment venues

>> These venues not only breach legal sound limits but also infringe on the rights of children to a conducive study environment

>> The Commission emphasises the critical need for the establishments to adhere strictly to the noise pollution rules laid out under the law Demands monthly reports from the involved authorities to monitor progress and ensure accountability

>> The reports are expected to detail the actions taken against non-compliant establishments and the measures put in place to prevent future violations
