Village head thrashed in Latur district; three booked

LATUR (MAHARASHTRA): A sarpanch was allegedly assaulted by a mob in Latur district on Saturday, police said. A case was registered at Nilanga police station against three persons on a complaint lodged by Shedolwadi village sarpanch sarpanch Shaikh Rubab, inspector Sudhir Suryawanshi told PTI. Rubab was attacked by some men who alleged that a relative of one of them suffered an electric shock at a pole in the village. They also manhandled gramsevak NS Patil and ransacked the panchayat office. A video of the incident has gone viral.

Escaped undertrial killed in encounter in Bengal

KOLKATA: An undertrial, who shot at policemen while escaping from custody three days ago, was killed in an encounter in West Bengal's Uttar Dinajpur district early on Saturday, a senior officer said. The police action came after West Bengal DGP Rajeev Kumar said, "If someone fires at police, we will respond with four times the force". Sajjak Alam was gunned down by a specialised police team during the encounter at Kichaktala in Goolpokhar, Additional Director General (Law and Order) Jawed Shamim said. "Several teams led by senior officers were on the lookout for him since Wednesday, when he escaped near Panjipara in Goolpokhar.

TMC MP seeks 'harshes punishment' for RG Kar convict

KOLKATA: Senior TMC MP Sougata Roy on Saturday welcomed the conviction of Sanjay Roy in the rape and murder of the doctor at the RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, and called for the "harshes punishment" to set a precedent. Speaking to PTI, he said the judgement should send a clear message. "The ruling must be followed by the harshes punishment possible for Roy," he said. "This will not only serve as a warning to others who think they can get away with lawlessness but also restore people's faith in the system. We need to ensure that such actions are met with the strongest deterrent," he added. A trial court in Saldah found the civic volunteer guilty of raping and murdering the on-duty doctor at the state-run hospital on August 9. The court will pronounce the sentence on Monday.

Manipur NPP MLA N Kayisii dies at 58

IMPHAL: Former Manipur minister and National People's Party (NPP) MLA N Kayisii died here on Saturday after a prolonged illness. He was 58. Kayisii, a Naga, is the MLA from Tadubi constituency in Senapati district and also the NPP state president. Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh condoled the death of Kayisii and said his service to the people of Manipur will always be remembered. The CM visited the residence of Kayisii and offered his condolences. Singh said, "Kayisii was soft-spoken, a very good man and a good leader. I had contacted him twice while he was ill. Very sorry over the loss." Kayisii was minister of Tribal and Hill Areas department from 2017-2020.

Keralite doctor booked, imposed fine for obstructing ambulance

KANNUR (KERALA): A doctor has been booked and penalised for obstructing the passage of an ambulance while it was on its way to a hospital with a patient in Kerala's Kannur district, police said on Saturday. The incident alleged to have happened at Eranholi in Thalassery on Thursday evening and it's visuals were telecast by television channels later. According to police, a car obstructed the passage of an ambulance when it was proceeding with a critical patient on Nayanar road here. Police identified the driver of the car as Rahul Raj, a doctor who runs a private clinic in nearby Iritty. The ambulance driver alleged that despite repeated sirens, the car driver didn't give space for the ambulance to proceed.

Three juveniles held for opening fire at man in Delhi

NEW DELHI: Delhi Police has apprehended three juveniles for their alleged involvement in a shooting incident at the Ramilla Maidan in outernorth Delhi that left a man seriously injured, officials said on Saturday. Nikhil, a resident of Mukundpur, was playing football on January 16 when he got involved in a heated argument with a minor boy, a police officer said. The minor left the park following the altercation, only to return with three of his accomplices, all Class-11 students of a government school, he said. As they confronted Nikhil, one of the minors fired a shot at him from a country-made pistol before all four fled from the spot. An eyewitness report led to the registration of an FIR at the Bhalswa Dairy police station, the officer said.

AAP claims Kejriwal's car attacked during campaigning; BJP alleges vehicle hit 3 people

PTI, NEW DELHI: The AAP on Saturday alleged that Arvind Kejriwal's car was attacked by BJP candidate Parvesh Verma's supporters during campaigning in the New Delhi constituency, prompting Verma to hit back as he accused the AAP chief of hitting three people with his vehicle.

Verma claimed that the three victims have sustained leg injuries and said he would file an "attempt to murder" case against Kejriwal.

The incident has sparked a political war of words between the ruling AAP in Delhi and the BJP ahead of the February 5 assembly polls.

Sharing a video on social media, the AAP claimed that a stone can be seen

landing on Kejriwal's vehicle, accusing BJP's Verma of getting its chief attacked by his "goons".

A police official, however, said that no one pelted stones at the Kejriwal's car but some people were trying to show black flags to the AAP chief, who was immediately removed from the location.

The official said that no

complaint has been received so far, adding that they are checking CCTV footage to know more about the incident.

Kejriwal is pitted against Verma from the New Delhi constituency in the Delhi Assembly polls.

Later, addressing a press conference, AAP spokesperson Priyanka Kakkar said that Verma was "baffled",

claiming that "though he (Verma) distributed money and gold chain in New Delhi, people in the constituency are supporting Kejriwal".

The Election Commission and Delhi Police should take suo moto cognizance of the incident and conduct an "impartial probe" to ensure strong action against Verma, Kakkar said.

"The attack on Kejriwal is extremely condemnable. The BJP does not want to allow peaceful elections in the New Delhi constituency," she charged.

The AAP spokesperson demanded Delhi Police to detain Verma and his "goons" for questioning them over the incident.

Hitting back at Kejriwal, Verma said the AAP chief's car hit three youths who

were asking him for jobs, and that he would file a police complaint of "attempt to murder".

Talking to reporters, Verma showed a damaged phone of one of the youths, claiming he was hit by Kejriwal's vehicle.

Cancer of terrorism now consuming Pak's own body politic: Jaishankar

PTI, NEW DELHI: The "cancer" of terrorism is now consuming Pakistan's own body politic and that country remains an "exception" in India's neighbourhood in view of its support for cross-border terrorist activities, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said on Saturday.

He said the entire sub-continent has a shared interest in Pakistan "abjuring" that approach of supporting terrorism.

The external affairs minister was delivering the Nani Palkhivala memorial lecture in Mumbai.

"Pakistan remains the exception in our neighbourhood in view of its support for cross-border terrorism, and that cancer is now consuming its own body politic," he said.

"There are also issues in respect of two other neighbours, Myanmar and Afghanistan. We, in India

have longstanding people-to-people ties with both societies and we must be mindful that those more proximate have stakes which are quite different from others far away," he said.

The external affairs minister said even as India's growth serves as a lifting tide beyond its borders, the extended neighbourhood too is keen to revive its historical connections.

"Three decades ago, a Southeast Asia led by Singapore displayed that interest, laying the foundation of what then came to be known as the Act East policy," he said.

"In the last decade, the United Arab Emirates has spearheaded an even deeper effort on the part of the Gulf kingdoms," he added.

Jaishankar said the Gulf region houses India's largest diaspora and it is among New Delhi's key trade partners, as well as

the dominant source of its energy needs.

"It is now increasingly investing in India's growth and partnering it in collaborative ventures," he said.

"The current conflict in the Middle-east is therefore as much a cause of anxiety to India as it is to others," he said.
