Goa set Nagaland a massive target

NAGALAND: Goa set Nagaland a daunting target of 545 runs after declaring their second innings at 517/7 on Day 3 of the Ranji Trophy Plate Final 2024-25 played at the Nagaland Cricket Association Stadium, Sovima, on Sunday.

Snehal Kauthankar

started with an unbeaten double century, scoring 202 runs, while Kashyap Bakhale supported with a brilliant 161.

In addition to the two centuries, Darshan Misal contributed 67 runs, helping Goa build a formidable total. With one day left in the final, Nagaland will need to score 545 runs in 90 overs

to claim victory.

At the close of play, Nagaland were 33 for no loss in their second innings.

Earlier, Goa had been bowled out for 276 runs in their first innings, with Bakhale (79), Kauthankar (63) and Suyash Prabhu (56) being the top scorers. Nagaland's Jagadeesha

Suchith took 4 wickets, while Imliwali Lemtur bagged 3.

In reply, Nagaland were dismissed for 216 in their first innings.

Rongsen Jonathan top-scored with 86 runs, while Hem Chetri contributed 55. Goa's Heramb Parab was the standout bowler, claiming 5 wickets, with support from Mohit Redkar (2) and Darshan Misal (1).

In the morning match, Priority Titans overwhelmed Sinq Rangers UC with a resounding 110-run victory. Opting to bat first, Priority Titans set an imposing target of 199/8 in 20 overs, led by contributions from Siddesh Amonkar (35), Siddharth Ghanekar (32 off 20)* and a quick-fire 26 off 9 balls by Vikrant Prabhu. For Sinq Rangers, Tunish Sawkar stood out with 3 wickets.

Desserts N'More Avengers beat Baale Tigers by 6 wickets in the first match of the day. RC Goa inflicted a 26-run defeat onto Manas Mavericks in the other match.

The results meant that RC Goa and Desserts N'More Avengers occupy second and third place in the points table respectively with 6 points each to their credit. On the other hand, Baale Tigers are now out of reckoning with their fourth successive defeat in as many matches. Defending champions Manas Mavericks suffered their third loss and are
