12 yrs after opening, Ponda hospital's facilities still not up to the mark

In the absence of essential services, patients are forced to go to GMC for treatment

PONDA: Twelve years after its inauguration, the Ponda Sub-District Hospital (SDH) continues to struggle with inadequate medical facilities, forcing patients to seek treatment elsewhere. Despite being a four-storey hospital intended to provide comprehensive healthcare under one roof, it still lacks essential services such as a CT scan machine, an MRI machine, and a sufficient number of doctors.

The hospital is now back in the spotlight as seven out of its eight lifts remain non-functional, causing severe difficulties for patients, particularly pregnant women and those undergoing dialysis.

While minor ailments are treated efficiently, the absence of modern medical upgrades means that in cases of emergencies or serious conditions, patients have no choice but to travel to Goa Medical College (GMC) in Bambolim, which is 35 km away.



The problems plaguing SDH have been raised in previous Goa Assembly sessions. In the past, South Goa MP Captain Viriato Fernandes, Opposition Leader Yuri Alemao, and Congress Party President Amit Patkar had criticised Hospital Medical Superintendent Dr lavshree Marcaikar over the hospital's lack of general surgeons, CT scan machines, and other necessary medical equipment.

PMC Councillor Venkatesh Naik said most of the people in Ponda and surrounding areas heavily depend on the Sub District Hospital. "All essential medical facilities including a CT scan, required number of doctors should be made available by the government at the earliest and the concerned MLAs and ministers of from the taluka should also look into the matter in the interest of

As patients continue to suffer, residents are calling for urgent government intervention to ensure that SDH can function as a fully equipped hospital rather than merely a referral centre.

Happy Feast of Our Lady of Health, Cuncolim

Age-old Cuncolim feast tradition to bring together faithful from across Goa Wishing all my Cuncolkars



much-awaited feast of Our Lady of Health more commonly called Saude Saibinnichem Fest in Konkani will be celebrated at Cuncolim on February 2 with grandeur and solemnity.

The Church of Cuncolim is located at one of the most scenic spots in South Goa surrounded by lush green fields and hillocks on all sides. The first Cuncolim Church was built somewhere between 1600 and 1604. It was further enlarged in 1630. In Health Church, Cuncolim, er on increased to 12. This

Goa was redesigned with two new wings in two phases, the first one in 1953 and the second one in 1967. This was all possible with the hard work and guidance from Msgr. Agapito Lourenso. On December 16, 1967, the late His Eminence Valerian Cardinal Gracious blessed the new wings

The feast is celebrated in rotation by the 12 Vangods of the parish. Vangods being the original settlers of the area are also known as gaunkars. Initially, there recent times, Our Lady of were 8 vangods which latyear the feast will be celebrated by the 10th Vangod and Wendy Gomes from Panzorconni will be celebrating it.

Cuncolim Maddi is unique because a picture of Our Lady is taken in a procession from the Church to Dandora with great solemnity and this procession attracts a large crowd even from neigh-

bouring Assolna. It is believed that many years back, a family distraught over the death of their only child who was a male, threw out all the Holy pictures from

the house and left their abode. However, their neighbour picked up the picture of Our Lady and placed it in an open space for reverence and since then a framed picture of Our Lady is taken from the church to that open space even today as part of the Maddi celebration explained Manny Fer-

nandes from Cuncolim, Being an extremely popular feast, it attracts a large fair which lasts for even three weeks. Stalls selling furniture, sweets, games for youngsters are set up with even people from neighbouring villages selling their sweets.

While the entrance to the church is occupied by those selling sweets, potters also sell their clay items specially the traditional cunnim used for cooking and rooster shaped water storage pot.

The fair does cause a lot of problems for motorists as the highway gets blocked with the crowds visiting the stalls set up along its side. Cuncolim market gets overcrowded during the fair with stalls selling readymade


In the village of Cuncolim, there is a unique and rich tradition that is on the February 1, on vesper day have a long procession going through the Cuncolim bazaar with the statue of the Sacred Heart of Mary. The said statue was gifted to the church by Joao Louis Miranda and Maria Jeraldin from Dandora, Cuncolim. They both signed an act with the church stating that all the expenses for the Vesper evening mass, sermon procession along with music (band) would be borne by them. While the procession goes through the bazaar, all shop owners light candles outside their establishments, showing the inter-religious harmony that exists in Cuncolim. It is on this day, the whole Cuncolim Parish was consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Mary, in Portuguese it is called "ACTO DE CONSAGRACAO PROCESSAO" and the procession is known as the candlelight procession or
