Trump trade envoy pick says universal tariffs should be 'considered'

President Donald Trump's trade envoy nominee Jamieson Greer told his confirmation hearing Thursday that universal tariffs should be "studied and considered" as a potential way to reverse off-shoring and deficits.

On the campaign trail, Trump had floated the idea of across-the-board tariffs on all US imports and Greer would be a crucial figure in implementing the president's trade and tariffs agenda if confirmed as US trade representative.

Trump has also imposed an additional tariff on Chinese imports taking effect this week, while threatening broad tariffs on Canada and Mexico.

Addressing the Senate Finance Committee, Greer said US workers ought to have a "level playing field" to compete globally, and stressed the need for the world's biggest economy to have a "robust manufacturing base."

Greer, a partner at law firm King & Spalding, served as chief of staff to Trump's former trade representative Robert Lighthizer during his first presi-

trade deal between the United States, Mexico and Canada -- although Trump has since announced and paused fresh tariffs on both neighbors as talks continue.

He also noted that the United States needs to "gain have been closed," calling for the use of "all the tools at our disposal" in order to

He added there is a "relatively short window of time" to restructure the international trade system to better serve US interests.

Beyond the issue of reciprocity with Beijing, Washington has to have a "balanced relationship" overall with China, Greer said.

He added that if confirmed, he would swiftly assess and enforce China's compliance with a Phase One trade deal Washington and Beijing inked in 2020, marking a truce in the trade war between both sides.

Greer additionally said he was committed to looking at other unfair trade practices if confirmed as

During Trump's first term from 2017 to 2021, the United States introduced tariffs on billions of dollars worth of imports -- notably on China but also America's allies.

In particular, the first Trump administration imposed levies on some \$300 billion in Chinese goods as Washington and Beijing engaged in an escalating tariff war.

New Attorney General Bondi orders review of Trump cases

AP, WASHINGTON: New Attorney General Pam Bondi on Wednesday ordered a review of the federal prosecution of Donald Trump as she unveiled a series of directives designed to overhaul a Justice Department the president claims is biased against conservatives.

Hours after she was

sworn in at the White House, Bondi called for the creation of "weaponization working group" that will examine the work of special counsel Jack Smith, who charged Trump in two criminal cases. The group will also review the "pursuit of improper investigative tactics and unethical prosecutions" stemming from the Jan. 6, 2021 riot at the US Capitol, among other things, according to the memo.

The memo satisfies the longstanding contention of Trump and his allies that the Justice Department under the Biden administration had become "weaponized" against conservatives, even though some of its most high-profile probes concerned the Democratic president and his son and there's been no evidence to support the idea that the prosecutions against Trump were launched for a nartisan nurnose

Bondi herself had foreshadowed the working group's creation by asserting at her confirmation hearing last month that the Justice Department had "targeted Donald Trump."

AP, WASHINGTON: Demonstrators gathered in cities across the US on Wednesday to protest the Trump administration's early actions, decrying everything from the president's immigration crackdown to his rollback of transgender rights and a proposal to forcibly transfer Palestinians

from the Gaza Strip. Protesters in Philadelphia and at state capitols in California, Minnesota, Michigan, Texas, Wisconsin, Indiana and beyond waved signs denouncing President Donald Trump; billionaire Elon Musk. the leader of Trump's new Department of Government Efficiency; and Project 2025, a hard-right playbook for American government

and society. "I'm appalled by democracy's changes in the last, well, specifically two weeks — but it started a long time ago," Margaret Wilmeth said at a protest outside the Statehouse in Columbus, Ohio. "So I'm just trying to put a pres-

The protests were a result of a movement that has organized online under the hashtags #buildtheresistance and #50501, which stands for 50 protests, 50 states, one day. Websites and accounts across social media issued calls for action, with messages such as "reject fascism" and "defend our democracy."

Outside the state Capitol in Lansing, Michigan, a crowd of hundreds gathered in freezing temperatures.

Catie Miglietti, from the Ann Arbor area, said Musk's access to Treasury Department data was especially concerning. She painted a sign depicting Musk puppeteering Trump from his outraised arm evoking Musk's straightarm gesture during a Janu-

ary speech that some have interpreted as a Nazi salute.

"If we don't stop it and get Congress to do something, it's an attack on democracy," Miglietti said.

Demonstrations in several cities piled criticism on Musk and the Department of Government Efficiency.

"DOGE is not legit," read one poster on the state Capitol steps in Jefferson City, Missouri, where dozens of protesters gathered. 'Why does Elon have your Social Security info???"

Members of Congress have expressed concern that DOGE's involvement with the US government payment system could lead to security risks or missed payments for programs such as Social Security and Medicare. A Treasury Department official says tech executive working with DOGE will have "read-only access."

Bank of England cuts key rates to 4.50%

AP, LONDON: The Bank of England has cut its main interest rate for the third time in six months with the British economy struggling to post any meaning-

ful growth. The bank said the Monetary Policy Committee lowered its main interest rate by a quarter of a percentage point to 4.50% taking it to its lowest level since mid-2023. Seven of the members backed the cut, while the other two voted for an even bigger reduction of half a per-

centage point to 4.25%. The latest cut reflects some concern about the outlook for the British economy, which has barely grown over the past six months. In forecasts accompanying the decision, the bank halved its growth projection for the British economy to 0.75%.

"It will be welcome news to many that we have been able to cut interest rates again today," said Bank Gov Andrew Bailey. "We'll be monitoring the UK economy and global developments very closely and taking a gradual and careful approach to reducing rates further. Low and stable inflation is the foundation of a healthy economy and it's the Bank of England's job to ensure that."

China cries foul over India, others imposing curbs on DeepSeek

PTI, BEIJING: After several countries, including India, clamped restrictions on officials accessing the newly-released Chinese AI tool DeepSeek, China on Thursday said such actions amounted to politicisation of trade and tech issues and vowed to protect the interests of its firms.

China has all along opposed moves to overstretch the concept of national security or politicise trade and tech issues, Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Guo Jiakun told a media briefing here while replying to a question on several countries either banning the use of DeepSeek or restricting its use by officials over suspicions of

data leaks. "We have never asked and will never ask any company or individual to collect or store data against laws," Guo said, referring to apprehensions concerning China's 2017 national intelligence law which gave the Chinese government powers over private companies.

"China has all along opposed moves to overstretch the concept of national security or politicise trade and tech issues. We will



firmly protect the lawful rights and interests of Chinese companies," Guo said.

India's Finance Ministry has directed its officers not to download or use AI tools and apps such as ChatGPT and DeepSeek in office computers and devices, saying they pose confidentiality risks to data

and documents. In a communication last month to all its departments, the ministry said AI tools and AI apps in office devices may be strictly avoided.

"It has been determined that AI tools and AI apps (such as ChatGPT, DeepSeek etc) in the office computers and devices pose risks for confidentiality of government data and documents," the Department of Expenditure under the ministry said in a note on

January 29. South Korea has blocked its government departfrom accessing ments DeepSeek. According to media reports, Italy, Australia, the US and Japan also blocked access

to DeepSeek. DeepSeek's latest AI offering has drawn global attention for its low-cost model — at just \$6 million against global average of billions of dollars. Further, DeepSeek's R1 used a fraction of compute power as compared to established AI

models like ChatGPT. DeepSeek overtook ChatGPT as the topranked free app on Apple's Appstore, as the US tech industry — that has long-justified injecting billions of dollars into Al investments - watched in sheer disbelief last week.
