AP. WASHINGTON: A federal judge dealt President Donald Trump and billionaire ally Elon Musk their first big setback in their dismantling of the US Agency for International Development, ordering a temporary halt to plans to pull thousands of agency staffers off the job.

US District Judge Carl Nichols, a Trump appointee, also agreed to block an order that would have given the thousands of overseas USAID workers the administration wanted to place on abrupt administrative leave just 30 days to move families and households back to the US on government expense.

US District Judge Carl Nichols pointed to accounts from workers abroad that the Trump administration, in its rush to shut down the agency and its programmes abroad, had cut some workers off from govt emails and other communication systems they needed to reach the US govt in case of a health or safety emergency

- "Administrative leave in Syria is not the same as administrative leave in Bethesda," the judge said
- He cited statements from agency employees who had no home to go to in the US after decades abroad, who faced pulling children with special needs out of school midyear, and had other difficulties

Gigantic triangle has narrowed roads, destroyed parking space near iconic cafe

PANJIM: The State's capital city and its residents continue to suffer on account of the "unsmart" city works. The classic example of "ridiculous" planning by Smart City officials is the "mindless" huge triangular shape structure constructed in front of Panjim's iconic Café Bhonsle and other establishments.

The contractor has constructed the gigantic structure where the once triangular garden stood, which has narrowed the road to such an extent that if one vehicle is passing along the route, the other cannot pass. The construction of
