Centre endangering national security to benefit billionaires: Cong

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Congress hit out at the Centre on Wednesday, alleging that it has endangered national security to benefit private billionaires, over reports that border security rules were relaxed for a business group to set up an energy park. Reacting to media reports that the government relaxed national security protocols along the Pakistan border in to make way for a renewable energy park of the Adani Group in Gujarat, Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge said the pseudo-nationalism face of the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has once again been unmasked. The Adani Group did not respond to the allegations. "Narendra Modi, you have endangered national security at our borders in order to benefit private billionaires," Kharge alleged in a post on X. "Is it true that you have gifted precious strategic land, just 1 km near the International Border with Pakistan, to your 'dear friend' by relaxing border security rules?" he asked the prime minister. "Is it not true that your government has relaxed such rules, not just at the India-Pakistan border, but also

ment's cronyism is a threat to our national security. Allowing India's largest solar project to be constructed hardly 1 km away from the Pakistan border is extremely dangerous and goes against all established military norms," Venugopal said in a post on X. In a post on X in Hindi, Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra asked, "Has the process of handing over all the resources of the country to the prime minister's 'friend' reached such a point that even the border security rules are being changed?" She alleged that according to news reports, India's border security rules were changed for the Adani Group's energy park. Citing the reports, which claimed that apprehensions raised by senior Army officers about obstacles in border security and surveillance work are not being heard, Priyanka Gandhi said, "The security responsibilities of the Army are being made difficult and sensitive to give cheap land and business benefits to the prime minister's friend." "Is one person's business interest bigger than the question of national security?" she asked.

Five nursing students arrested for ragging juniors at Govt college in Kerala

PTI, KOTTAYAM (KERALA): Five third-year students have been arrested for allegedly ragging first-year students at the Government Nursing College here, police said on Wednesday. A case was registered after three first-year students lodged a complaint, alleging that the ragging had been ongoing for nearly three months at the nursing institute, which functions under the Government Medical College. The accused students have been suspended, college authorities said. The action was taken following an inquiry conducted under the anti-ragging law, they added. The arrested students have been identified as Samuel Johnson (20), Rahul Raj (22), Jeev (18), Rijil Jith (20), and Vivek (21). According to the complaint, the ragging began in November last year. The students reported that the incidents involved extreme brutality.

1984 Anti Sikh riots: Delhi court convicts ex-Congress MP Sajjan Kumar in murder case

PTI, NEW DELHI: A Delhi court on Wednesday convicted former Congress MP Sajjan Kumar in a case related to the murders of two persons in Saraswati Vihar area during the anti-Sikh riots. Special judge Kaveri Baweja passed the conviction order and posted the arguments on sentence on February 18. Kumar was produced before court from Tihar jail for

Kumar was produced before court from Tihar jail for the pronouncement. The case relates to the killings of Jaswant Singh and his son Tarundeep Singh on Nov 1, 1984. Though Punjabi Bagh police station registered the case initially, a special investigation team later took over the investigation. On December 16, 2021, the court framed charges against Kumar, finding a "prima facie" case against him. According to the prosecution, a huge mob, armed with deadly weapons, resorted to large-scale looting, arson and destruction of properties of Sikhs to avenge the assassination of former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi. The mob attacked the house of the complainant, Jaswant's wife, killing her husband and son apart from looting articles and setting their house ablaze, alleged the prosecution. Putting Kumar on trial, the court order found sufficient material to form a "prima facie" opinion that he was not only a participant, but had also led the mob".
