Allahbadia skips police summons, ordered to appear on Friday

PTI, MUMBAI: Social media influencer Ranveer Allahbadia was asked to remain present at the Khar police station here on Friday after he failed to appear in connection with a probe into his controversial comments on a YouTube show, an official said. The city police as well as Maharashtra Cyber Department have also asked comedian Samay Raina, who was a part of the controversial reality show "India's Got Latent", to appear before them in the next five days. Allahbadia, who was expected to visit the Khar police station on Thursday, did not turn up, and told police that he was afraid of the media, an official said. But it was made clear to him that he can not evade questioning and must come on Friday, the official added. PTI, NEW DELHI: Several members of a parliamentary committee on Thursday raised the issue of social media influencer Ranveer Allahbadia's crass comments, calling for strict action and strengthening measures to curb such incidents. BJD MP Sasmit Patra said several members cutting across party lines raised the issue and expressed the need to take stringent measures to ensure that such incidents do not recur. The committee, which is headed by BJP MP Nishikant Dubey, is likely to write the Information and Broadcasting Ministry on the issue. BJP MPs Anil Baluni, V D Sharma, Lahar Singh Siroya and Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Priyanka Chaturvedi were among those who raised the issue, sources said.

But they have not registered any FIR yet. The state cyber department has summoned more than 40 persons, including Allahbadia and Raina, asking them to join the probe into a First Information Report it has registered over Allahbadia's remarks. BJP cannot win Bihar assembly polls: Lalu

PTI, PATNA: RJD president Lalu Prasad on Thursday claimed that the BJP-led NDA will be defeated in the Bihar assembly polls, due later this year, notwithstanding the momentum gained by the saffron party after its victory in Delhi. The former Bihar chief minister, whose party has the highest number of seats in the 243-strong assembly, was replying to journalists' queries about the impact of INDIA bloc partner Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) getting ousted from power in Delhi. "There will be no impact here. The BJP will go", replied the septuagenarian who prides himself on being a staunch "secularist" who has never had a truck with the saffron party. When it was pointed out to the RJD supremo that leaders of the NDA in Bihar, where his arch-rival Nitish Kumar, the JD(U) president, has been chief minister since 2005, were confident of return to power, Prasad dismissed such a possibility. "As long as we are around in Bihar, they cannot form a government here. The people have sized up the BJP. They will size up the NDA here as well," Prasad said. The avertment drew a sharp response from senior BJP leader and Deputy CM Vijay Kumar Sinha, who said "Lalu ji may or may not be around, but the NDA's return to power is certain".

More than 10 students detained, security stepped up in Jamia

PTI, NEW DELHI: Over 10 Jamia Millia Islamia University students were detained by Delhi Police for protesting against the university's disciplinary action against two PhD scholars, who were served show-cause notices for allegedly organising a demonstration last year, an official said on Thursday. The protest began on Monday, with students condemning what they termed as the administration's "crackdown on student activism." The university claimed the protesting students vandalised university property, including the central canteen, and broke the gate of the security advisor's office, forcing the administration to take action. According to police sources, the university

sought police intervention to remove the students from the protest site to maintain law and order. "We removed over 10 students at around 4 am after receiving a request from the university administration. Further, we have deployed heavy police security outside the campus to maintain law and order," a police source said. Some of the protestors are also sitting outside the Kalkaji police station, claiming that 20 students are missing after the police move, and that the authorities are not giving details of the whereabouts of the alleged detainees.

Ragging at Nursing College in Kerala: Junior student tortured, pierced with compass

PTI, KOTTAYAM: Disturbing visuals of the brutal ragging of a junior student at the Government Nursing College here surfaced on Thursday, showing the victim being tied to a cot and his body repeatedly pierced with a compass. According to footage received by the Gandhinagar police, the victim was stripped half-naked and subjected to horrifying acts, including having dumbbells placed on his private parts after being tied to a cot and having

facial cream poured into his mouth. Kottayam District Police Chief Shahul Hameed said that police are investigating whether more students were subjected to ragging. "The case has been registered based on a complaint from one student but we will record statements from others to determine if there are more victims," he told reporters here. Hameed added that the investigation will also examine whether there were any lapses on the part of the college authorities. The five students arrested on Wednesday in connection with the case are currently in the district jail after being remanded by a court here. The visuals aired by TV channels showed the junior student-lying on the bed with lotion all over his body and his hands and legs tied with a rope-screaming in pain, unable to move while his body was repeatedly pierced with the compass. The senior students pierced various parts of his body with the com-

pass, counting aloud, "one, two, three". As the victim screamed in pain, the accused mocked him, taunting and insulting him by calling him a "sexy body". The video recorded by third-year students captured this brutal act of ragging, police said. The abuse took place in the boys' hostel targeting first-year nursing students. The arrested students have been identified as Samuel Johnson (20), Rahul Raj (22), Jeev (18), Rijil Jith (20), and Vivek (21).
