10 devotees killed as car collides with bus en route to Maha Kumbh

PTI, PRAYAGRAJ: Ten persons travelling in a Bolero car were killed in a head-on collision with a bus on a highway in the Meja police station area of Prayagraj late on Friday night, police said on Saturday.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP) Vivek Chandra Yadav said the devotees from Chhatisgarh's Korba district were heading to the Maha Kumbh to take a dip when the Bolero they were travelling in collided head-on with a bus on the highway.

All the 10 people travelling in the Bolero died in the accident, while those in the bus suffered minor injuries, the DCP said.

While four of the deceased were identified based on their Aadhaar cards, six were identified on the basis of information provided by their relatives. The deceased include

DIGITAL LOST-AND-FOUND CENTRES HELP 20,000 MISSING PEOPLE REUNITE WITH KIN

PTI, MAHAKUMBH NAGAR (UP): The digital lost-and-found centres set up in the Maha Kumbh Mela here have helped reunite over 20,000 missing people with their loved ones, the Uttar Pradesh government said on Saturday.

According to it, the digital lost-and-found centres, equipped with advanced AI-based facial recognition technology, machine learning and multilingual sup-

port, reunited 8,725 devotees with their families in and around the major bathing event on the occasion of Mauni Amavasya.

Similarly, during the Makar Sankranti bathing event 598 devotees were traced and united with their families while during Basant Panchami Amrit Snan, the centres helped reunite 813 pilgrims with their kin, the government said.

Prez rule in Manipur symbolic of PM, HM's collective failure: Gogoi

PTI, NEW DELHI: Congress leader Gaurav Gogoi on Saturday termed the imposition of President's rule in Manipur "symbolic of the collective failure" of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, and the BJP's leadership in the Northeast.

President's rule was imposed in strife-torn Manipur on Thursday and the state assembly put under suspended animation, days after Chief Minister N Biren Singh resigned from his post.

"The imposition of President's Rule in Manipur is symbolic of the collective failure of the Prime Minister and Home Minister and the party leadership in Northeast," Gogoi wrote on X.

The Congress deputy leader in the Lok Sabha also said that there is still no roadmap for sustainable peace and reconciliation in Manipur.

"Therefore, it can be said that the President's Rule is only there because the state BJP is in total disarray. People of Manipur and India deserve better," he said.

PTI, IMPHAL: Manipur Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla on Saturday honoured units of the Indian Army, Assam Rifles, CRPF, BSF, and Manipur Police with citations for their exemplary service in counter-insurgency and disaster response, an official statement said. Speaking at the ceremony, Bhalla appreciated the services rendered by the brave men and women in uniform in protecting our security, maintaining peace and ensuring the safety of the citizens.

Mumbai court orders police inquiry in complaint against producer Ekta Kapoor

PTI, MUMBAI: A court here on Saturday directed the city police to conduct an inquiry into a criminal complaint filed against film and television producer Ekta Kapoor for allegedly disrespecting Indian soldiers in one of her web series.

Under this section, a magistrate can carry out an inquiry into a criminal complaint, or direct the police to do so.

The complaint was filed by YouTuber Vikas Pathak, also known as 'Hindustani bhau'. Besides Ekta, it named her OTT platform Alt Balaji, and her parents Shobha and Jeetendra Kapoor.

As per the complaint filed through advocate Ali Kaashif Khan Deshmukh,

a web series on Alt Balaji showed a military officer engaging in an "illicit sexual act" in one of its episodes. Pathak came across the episode in May 2020, the complaint said. "The accused have stooped to a cheap low and shamelessly targeted the dignity and pride of our country by depicting Indian Army military uniform in the illicit sexual act with national emblem on it," the complaint said.
