Nigerian woman, autorickshaw driver held with mephedrone worth Rs 1.04 cr

PALGHAR: A Nigerian woman and an autorickshaw driver were arrested in Palghar allegedly with mephedrone worth Rs 1.04 crore, a senior police official said on Monday. The duo was held on February 22 from Pragati Nagar area in Nalasopara following a tip-off, Assistant Commissioner of Police Madan Ballal said. "We seized 520 grams of mephedrone worth Rs 1.04 crore. They have been charged under Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and further probe into the peddling network is underway," the ACP said.

Odisha man arrested for duping people with promise to double money in 10 months

BHUBANESWAR: The economic offences wing of Odisha Police arrested a man for allegedly duping people by collecting deposits with the false promise of doubling their money in 10 months, police said. The accused, identified as Dhanajaya Sahoo, was arrested in Hyderabad and brought to Odisha on remand on Monday. A case has been registered against him under various sections of the IPC and the Banning of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Act, police added. He was arrested following a complaint by Govinda Chandra Sahoo of Jajpur district, who had deposited money with Mutual Alliance Global Private Limited, a company owned by Dhanajaya.

Three youths killed as truck hits bike in UP

UNNAO (UP): Three youths, including two teenage twins, were killed after an unidentified truck hit their motorcycle on the Bihar-Buxar road near Sarai Manihar village in Úttar Pradesh's Unnao district, police said on Monday. The deceased have been identified as Sarfaraz (22) and twin brothers Arbaaz Khan (16) and Adil Khan (16), Additional Superintendent of Police Akhilesh Singh said. According to police, the accidents took place on Sunday night when the trio was returning home from Digpalgani Pathai in Raebareli district, where they worked as confectioners.

MCD announces house-tax waiver for Delhi residents

NEW DELHI: The Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has announced a house-tax waiver scheme, allowing residents to clear their house-tax dues of 2024-25 and have all previous pending taxes written off. The announcement was made at a press conference here on Monday by MCD Mayor Mahesh Khichi, Deputy Mayor Ravinder Bhardwaj, Leader of the House Mukesh Goel and senior Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader and Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh. The AAP-led civic body's proposal, which aims at easing financial burdens on citizens and curbing corruption in tax collection, is set to be passed in the MCD House on Tuesday.

Three women killed in TN fireworks unit explosion

DHARMAPURI (TAMIL NADU): Three women were killed in an explosion at a fireworks factory in this district on Monday, with Chief Minister M K Stalin expressing grief over the incident. The incident happened in a private unit at Kambainallur village in this district and the victims were killed on the spot. BJP leader George jailed for hate speech

PTI, KOTTAYAM (KER-ALA): A court in this district remanded BJP leader P C George to judicial custody on Monday in a hate speech case after sending him to police custody until 6 pm the same day.

The Erattupetta Munsif Magistrate Court rejected George's bail application earlier in the day. He was shifted to a prisoner's facility at Kottayam Government Medical College after a medical examination. He was subjected to questioning by senior police officers, police sources said.

George, a former MLA, surrendered before the Court around 11 am. The case was taken up for consideration at 12.30 pm, followed by arguments from both sides.

After hearing the submissions, the court adjourned the case for further consider-

ation at 2 pm. George's lawyer argued that the BJP leader did not "incite religious hatred or hurt religious sentiments", asserting that custodial interrogation or evidence collection was unnec-

The prosecution, however, presented details of George's previous cases, stating that he had violated bail conditions.

The National Capital Region (NCR) comprises Delhi and certain districts of Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan. If there was no proper segregation of waste, the court said, even waste-to-energy projects would create more pollution.

Senior advocate Aparajita Singh, the amicus curiae in the pollution matter, referred to solid waste management in the NCR while flagging the low percentage of segregation of waste.

She said sending unsegregated waste waste-to-energy plants caused more pollution.

"As rightly submitted by the amicus curiae, the segregation of waste at source is of vital importance for the environment. If their is no proper segregation, even waste-to-energy projects will create more pollution," the bench said.

The NCR states were ordered to file affidavits dealing with the compliances of all the urban local bodies with the provisions of the 2016 Rules so far. They have been asked to file the affidavits by end of March following which the matter

would be taken up. The bench has also

asked the states to set out a comprehensive plan for waste management along with timelines and implementing agencies and said, "Needless to add that the affidavits will state compliance in relation to all urban local bodies within the NCR." The authorities were asked to set out the "best practices" they proposed to follow for solid waste
