Jaising, appearing for the mothers of students Rohith Vemula and Paval Tadvi, who allegedly died by suicide after facing caste-based discrimination, said universities and colleges hadn't given entire data on suicides taking place in their campuses despite a court order.

While Vemula, a PhD scholar at Hyderabad Central University died on January 17, 2016, Tadvi, a student at TN Topiwala National Medical College, died on May 22, 2019, after she was subjected to

purported discrimination by three doctors in her college.

Solicitor Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, said the University Grants Commission (UGC) had formulated draft regulations, which took care of majority of the concerns raised by the petitioners, and were uploaded on its website inviting suggestions and objections from the public.

Jaising said 40 per cent of the universities and 80 per cent of the colleges had not created equal opportunity cells in their campuses.

Pune bus rape: Thirst forced accused to come out of hiding

Cop's brother provided crucial tip-off leading to the arrest

PTI. MUMBAI: Thirst forced the accused in the Swargate bus rape case to leave the field he was hiding in and approach a house to seek water, but the owner, brother of a police constable, promptly alerted the police teams who were on his trail, leading to the arrest, officials said on Friday.

Dattatray Ramdas Gade (37), who was on the run since Tuesday morning, was nabbed around Thursday midnight from his native village Gunat in Shirur tehsil of Pune district. A court on Friday remanded him in police custody till March 12.

A ligature mark was found on his neck, and as per the preliminary probe, he tried to hang himself from a tree in the field in which he was hiding for two days, but the rope snapped and the suicide attempt failed, officials said.

Besides darkness, the presence of leopards -- who are known to take shelter in sugarcane fields -- in Shirur area was one of the factors that made the operation more challenging, said another official.

Gade, a history-sheeter, fled to his native place after allegedly sexually assaulting a 26-year-old woman inside a state transport bus at Swargate bus station in Pune city in the early hours of Tuesday.

Cong, NCP (SP) demand Shakti bill

PTI, MUMBAI: The Congress and NCP (SP) on Friday raised concerns over the rape of a woman inside a bus in Pune and demanded that the Maharashtra government implement the Shakti bill, which has provisions for the death penalty for atrocities against children and

Talking to reporters, former state home minister and NCP (SP) leader Anil Deshmukh said the Shakti bill, which has provisions for strict punishment for crimes against women, was introduced and passed by the Maha Vikas Aghadi government four years ago and is still pending approval from the Central government.

He said the Shakti bill was framed and passed in the state legislature, and members of all parties were part of the legislature standing committee to examine the provisions before its passage.

SC refuses to hear plea against temporary release of Gurmeet Ram Rahim

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Friday refused to hear a plea of the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) against the temporary release of Dera Sacha Sauda chief Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh.

A bench of Justices B R Gavai and Prashant Kumar Mishra had a plea before them challenging the Punjab and Haryana High Court order.

The bench noted Singh's counsel objection to the maintainability of the PIL before the high court, which it disposed of, on the ground that it was filed against a single person, who was Singh. "In that view of the matter, we are not inclined to consider the present petition," the

Singh is serving a 20year jail term for raping two of his disciples. The SGPC moved the apex court against a August 2024 order of the high court.

All parameters normal after trials of Union Carbide toxic waste disposal begins: Officials

PTI, INDORE: The trial incineration of 10 tonnes of waste linked to the 1984 Bhopal Gas Tragedy commenced on Friday in Pithampur area of Madhya Pradesh's Dhar district with initial reports indicating that air quality and other monitored parameters remained within normal ranges, officials said

This trial disposal, which

involves 10 tonnes out of a total of 337 tonnes of hazardous waste, is being conducted following directives from the Madhya Pradesh High Court.

"We started the process of burning 10 tonnes of waste in the designated plant's incinerator at 3pm under strict monitoring of the MP Pollution Control Board. All reports are nor-

and other parameters are normal," Indore division commissioner Deepak Singh, who visited the site, told reporters.

On January 6, the HC had directed the state government to take steps within six weeks to dispose of the waste by following safety guidelines. In its order of February 18, MP Chief Justice mal at present. Air quality Suresh Kumar Kait and

Justice Vivek Jain had directed that the state government undertake "first trial run of 10 metric ton by taking all protocols into consideration" on February 27.

"If there is no adverse effect, the second trial run will take place on March 4, followed by the third trial run on March 10. Thereafter, based on results of same, after the due tests,

they will continue to dispose of the remaining waste and file the status report," the HC said.

The Supreme Court had, on February 27, refused to interfere with the order of the Madhya Pradesh High Court to transfer and dispose of the waste. The bench of Justice BR Gavai and Justice AG Masih had also refused to stay the test process.

Militants open fire at Meitei religious site in Imphal

PTI, IMPHAL: Amid mass surrender of firearms by village volunteers in strife-torn Manipur, unidentified militants on Friday opened fire at a Meitei religious site in Imphal East district from adjoining hills, officials said. However, no casualties were reported in the in-

cident. The incident took place around 9.30 am when a group of devotees, under heavy security cover, visited Kongba Maru, a sacred site for Meiteis, to offer prayers, they said.

A total of seven rounds were fired from adjoining hills but no person was injured in the incident, the officials said, adding additional security forces have been sent to the spot.

After the firing incident, irate locals from nearby villages came out on the streets and blocked vehicular traffic to register their protest. Kongba Maru had ear-

Additionally, arms and ammunition were surrendered in various police stations in Imphal West and Imphal East districts, police added. On February, Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla had urged people of the state to voluntarily surrender looted and illegally held weapons within seven days, assuring no punitive action would be initiated against those giving up arms during this period. More than 250 people have been killed and thousands rendered homeless in ethnic violence between Imphal valleybased Meiteis and adjoining hills-based Kuki-Zo groups since May 2023.
