## Telangana tunnel collapse: Authorities exploring deployment of robos

PTI, NAGARKURNOOL (TELANGANA): Ten days after the partial collapse of the SLBC project tunnel that left eight persons trapped, the Telangana government is exploring the option of deploying robos in the rescue operation to prevent any threat to the rescue personnel, officials said on Monday.

Large quantities of slush and water inside the tunnel posed a challenge to the teams involved in the rescue operation.

Eight persons - engineers and labourers - have been trapped in the Srisailem Left Bank Canal

(SLBC) project tunnel since February 22 and experts from the NDRF, Indian Army, Navy and other agencies are making relentless efforts to pull them out to safety.

Nagarkurnool Superintendent of Police Vaibhav Gaikwad said the possibility of involving robos in the ongoing rescue efforts is being considered as safety of the rescuers is important.

Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy, who visited the tunnel on Sunday, suggested to officials leading the rescue operation to use robos inside the tunnel, if necessary, to avoid any danger to the rescue personnel.

# EC complicit in voter list manipulation: Congress

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Congress on Monday accused the Election Commission of being "complicit" in voter list "manipulation" and asserted that the party was actively working to seek a remedy through legal, political and legislative means.

A group of senior Congress leaders questioned the Election Commission's (EC) silence on multiple voters having the same identification number and said the party would not let this issue fade due to the grave danger it posed to the country's electoral democracy.

"This is a grave danger to the very idea of India as an electoral democracy. This transcends political parties and politics. Babasaheb Ambedkar fought for the setting up of an independent Election Commission to precisely resist this urge of executive interference in elections. The Congress will

not let this issue fade away and is actively working on seeking remedy through legal, political, legislative and any other means," the Congress' Empowered Action Group of Leaders and Experts (EAGLE) said in a statement.

The group includes Ajay Maken, Digvijaya Singh, Abhishek Singhvi, Paveen Chakravarty, Pawan Khara, Gurdeep Singh Sappal, Nitin Raut and Vamshi Chand Reddy.

Alleging that the EC was "complicit" in voter list "manipulation", the group claimed some startling developments on the issue had surfaced.

"The same voter ID number is being used for

several voters, both from the same constituency in the same state as well as from other states. This is utterly shocking. A unique voter ID for every Indian voter is the fundamental requirement and premise of a clean voter list. Multiple voters having the same voter ID number is as bizarre as multiple vehicles bearing the same registration number. It is unheard of in any electoral democracy," the group claimed.

In December, they said the Congress had pointed out "huge irregularities and abnormalities" in voter lists for the assembly election in Maharashtra. "It is both a logical and

statistical absurdity that the Election Commission registered more new net voters (40 lakh) in five months between the Lok Sabha and the Vidhan Sabha elections than it did in the entire five-year period between 2019 and 2024 (32 lakh)," they had said.

This was substantiated through ground reports in some constituencies where thousands of voters were added to the rolls from just one building or brought in from other states, the leaders had said. "It was further shown that suspiciously most of these new voters enrolled seem to have voted only for the BJP-led alliance in Maharashtra, thereby tilting the eventual outcome in its favour."

Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi had raised the issue in the House. There was also a joint press conference by constituents of Maharashtra's opposition alliance on the matter.

## Police constable arrested in Indore for colluding with drug gangs

INDORE: A police constable posted in Indore was arrested on Monday for allegedly colluding with drug peddlers in the city, a senior officer said. Additional Police Commissioner Amit Singh said constable Lakhan Gupta, posted at the Azad Nagar police station, was arrested for allegedly colluding with drug gangs and indulging in illegal money transactions. Gupta was responsible for serving summonses and warrants to accused in cases registered under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, but he used to delay the process, he said.

## 4 Bangladeshis arrested in Tripura for illegally entering India

AGARTALA: Four Bangladesh nationals have been arrested by the BSF in Tripura for allegedly entering India illegally, officials said on Monday. Five Indians who reportedly facilitated their infiltration have also been apprehended in two separate incidents in the northeastern state, they said. Acting on a tip-off, a patrolling party raided Dhaniabari, a remote tribal hamlet near the Chittagong Hill Tract (CHT) at Nutanbazar area of Gomati district on Sunday evening, and detected four persons trying to cross the international border. When they crossed the border, BSF personnel managed to apprehend the four.

## BSP chief Mayawati expels nephew Akash Anand from party

LUCKNOW: A day after removing her nephew Akash Anand from all key posts, Bahujan Samaj Party chief Mayawati on Monday said she has expelled him from the party "in the interest and movement" of the party. Mayawati said that Akash's response to her action against him on Sunday was "selfish and arrogant". In a BSP meeting on Sunday, Akash was relieved from all responsibilities as he was under the continuous influence of his father-in-law Ashok Siddharth, more than the interest of the party, for which he should "repent and show his maturity", she said.

## SC allows podcaster Allahbadia to resume 'The Ranveer Show'

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Monday allowed podcaster Ranveer Allahbadia to resume his podcast "The Ranveer Show" subject to maintaining "morality and decency" and making it suitable for viewers of all ages.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant and N Kottiswar Singh observed Allahbadia's submission that the podcast was his only source of livelihood and about 280 persons he employed depended on the show. "Subject to the petitioner furnishing an undertaking to the effect that his whole podcast shows will maintain desired standards of decency and morality so that viewers of any age group can watch, the petitioner is permitted to resume 'The Ranveer Show'," -Supreme court

## Visually impaired persons cannot be denied opportunity to join judicial services: SC

PTI, NEW DELHI: In a significant verdict, the Supreme Court on Monday held that visually impaired persons cannot be denied opportunity of employment in judicial services.

A bench comprising justices J B Pardiwala and R Mahadevan had reserved the judgement on six petitions, including a suo motu (on its own) case, on December 3, last year over non-grant of quota to such candidates in judicial services in a few states. Pronouncing the verdict, Justice Mahadevan said that persons with disabilities must not face any discrimination in their pursuit of judicial service recruitments and that the State must provide them affirmative action to ensure an inclusive framework. "Any indirect discrimination that results in the exclusion of persons with disabilities, whether through cutoff or procedural barriers must be interfered with in order to uphold substantive equality," the judge said. The judgement said no candidate can be denied consideration solely on account of their disability. The top court also set aside certain rules of the Madhya Pradesh Services Examination (Recruitment and Conditions of Services) Rules 1994 to the extent they barred visually impaired and low vision candidates from entering the judicial service. The pleas pertained to the validity of Rule 6A and 7 of the Madhya Pradesh rules. The PWD (persons with the disabilities) candidates, who had participated in the selection process, are entitled to be considered for judicial service selection in the light of the judgment, and they can be appointed in the vacant posts if they are otherwise eligible, the judgement said.
