# Nagpur violence seems premeditated; 'Chhaava' film reignited people's emotions: Fadnavis

PTI, MUMBAI: Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Tuesday said the violence in Nagpur appears to be premeditated in which the mob targeted specific houses, and stated that "Chhaava" film reignited people's emotions against Mughal emperor Aurangzeb. Speaking in the legislative assembly, Fadnavis said the Vicky Kaushal-starrer "Chhaava", based on the life of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj, brought before the people the true history of the Maratha king. Chhatrapati Sambhaji, son of Maratha empire founder Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, was tortured and killed by Aurangzeb. "After that (the movie), people's emotions have been

reignited. The anger against Aurangzeb is being exhibited in a big way," the CM said. Fadnavis who holds the home portfolio, said 33 police personnel, including three deputy commissioners of police, were injured in the violence, and one of the senior officials was at-

tacked with an axe. Those who have attacked the police will not be spared, he said. "The mob targeted specific houses and establishments. It (the attack) appears to be premeditated," Fadnavis said. Echoing similar senti-

ments, Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde said there was a conspiracy to target a specific community. Giving the sequence of events, Fadnavis said that at 11.30 am on Monday, activists of the Vishwa Hindu Parishad (VHP) and Bajrang Dal staged a protest in the Mahal area of Nagpur, demanding the removal of Aurangzeb's grave. They also made a symbolic grave with hay and set it on fire, he said. A case was registered against the activists at the Ganesh Peth police station in the afternoon, and the section related to deliberate and malicious acts intended to outrage religious feelings was invoked against them, the CM added.

# Akhilesh slams BJP over religious controversies, Aurangzeb row

PTI, LUCKNOW: Samajwadi Party (SP) president Akhilesh Yadav has accused the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) of endangering religious sites and fostering communal tensions. Speaking to reporters on the sidelines of an Iftar party in Lucknow on Monday night, he alleged that the BJP was creating conflicts around all religious places to divert attention from "real issues" such as law and order, unemployment, and economic distress. "Slowly, not just mosques but all religious sites will be under threat due to the BJP's conduct. Even our Kedareswar Temple (in Etawah) has become a problem for them," Yadav claimed.

The former Uttar Pradesh chief minister asserted that the BJP had objections to temple construction by others. "If we build a temple with support from our people, even that troubles the BJP." On the controversy in Maharashtra over Mughal ruler Aurangzeb's grave, Yadav urged the BJP to focus on historical figures who promoted harmony rather than fostering divisions. The SP leader also reminded the BJP of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's legacy. "The BJP should tell people about the history of his coronation." "They are passing such laws in a state that was carved out of Uttar Pradesh," he said.

# India demands Pak vacate illegally occupied territory

PTI, NEW DELHI: Pakistan should vacate Indian territory under its "illegal" occupation instead of "spreading lies," New Delhi said on Tuesday hitting out at Islamabad for its reaction to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's remarks on Jammu and Kashmir during a podcast. External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said the world knows that the real issue in Jammu and Kashmir is Pakistan's "active promotion and sponsorship" of cross-border terrorism. PM Modi during the podcast with Lex Fridman said "every attempt to foster peace with Pakistan was met with hostility and betrayal" and that he hoped that "wisdom would prevail on the leadership in Islamabad to improve bilateral ties". On Monday, Pakistan rejected the remarks as "mis-

External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said the world knows that the real issue in Jammu and Kashmir is Pakistan's "active promotion and sponsorship of cross-border terrorism" leading and one-sided. "We note that Pakistan has once again made some comments about the Indian Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir," Jaiswal said. "The world knows that the real issue is Pakistan's active promotion and sponsorship of cross-border terrorism. In fact this is the biggest roadblock to peace and security in the region," he said. "Instead of spreading lies, Pakistan should vacate Indian territory under its illegal and forcible occupation," Jaiswal added.

# Missing Manipur youth's mother appeals for son's safety

PTI, IMPHAL/CHURACHANDPUR: A day after curfew was imposed in Manipur's Churachandpur district in view of clashes between Hmar and Zomi people, apex bodies of the two communities on Tuesday lifted shutdowns they had clamped there, leading to normalisation of the situation. During the day, families belonging to Hmar and Zomi communities settled their dispute by reaching a monetary settlement, officials said adding that the expenses of the victim's medical treatment will be borne by the other side. General Secretary Richard Hmar of Hmar Inpui, one of the apex bodies of the tribe, was attacked by Zomi people on Sunday, leading to the violence and imposition of curfew the next day. "Though the prohibitory orders were not withdrawn, Hmar Inpui and

TRIBAL BODIES LIFT SHUTDOWN IN CURFEW-BOUND CHURACHANDPUR PTI, IMPHAL: The mother of a Manipur youth who went missing two days ago made a fervent appeal to the authorities on Tuesday to ensure the safety of her son. She also took part in a demonstration in the state capital Imphal demanding that security forces immediately rescue the 20-year-old man who was allegedly kidnapped a day before. Holding the demonstration at Keisampat locality, the protestors also demanded that the lives of innocent civilians be saved. Luwangthem Mukesh has gone missing after he left home in a car on Sunday afternoon. The vehicle was last seen in Bishnupur district near Chinikon, close to the Kuki-majority Kangpokpi district. His last mobile tower location showed that he had been in Jouzangtek area in Noney district, where also the Kukis are in the majority. Zomi Council, the apex bodies of the respective tribes, decided to work together and restore peace in the district, and the situation is normal now," an official said on Tuesday evening. # Guj ATS busts drug racket, finds Mexican Cartel link

PTI, AHMEDABAD: Gujarat Anti Terrorist Squad (ATS) arrested two persons for illegally exporting precursor chemicals for manufacturing fentanyl and other banned psychotropic substances by air to drug mafias in Mexico, Guatemala, and other countries, it said. An investigation showed that the partners of certain chemical and pharma companies in Surat had illegally procured and exported precursors for the manufacturing of the controlled psychotropic substance fentanyl, prohibited in many countries, the ATS said in a release. The accused individuals used bogus end-user certificates and fake invoices, and misdeclared the shipments to evade detection by the Customs Department and international

narcotics agencies while smuggling the chemicals via air cargo to companies in Mexico and Guatemala, it said. These substances - 1 Boc 4-piperidone (N-Boc-4-piperidone) and 4-piperidone - have been placed on the Red List by the United Nations International Narcotics Control Board (INCB) and also listed under the International Special Surveillance List (ISL) by India's Central Bureau of Narcotics (CBN), the ATS said. The ATS stated that Satishkumar Sutariya, the main partner of Athos Chemicals Pvt. Ltd, Agrat Chemicals & Pharmaceuticals, and S.R. Chemicals & Pharmaceuticals in Surat, along with his partners and certain drug mafias from Mexico and Guatemala, conspired to smuggle contraband.

# Sunita Williams' ancestral village plans fireworks and procession to welcome her return to Earth

PTI, MEHSANA: Residents of NASA astronaut Sunita Williams' ancestral village in Gujarat's Mehsana district are gearing up for Diwali-like festivities on Wednesday morning to celebrate her scheduled return to Earth after a nine-month stay at the International Space Station. Williams has been in the thoughts and prayers of the villagers, eagerly awaiting her safe return. Jhulasan village, known as the ancestral home of Williams' father, Deepak Pandya, is alive with excitement. Villagers have

been praying for her safety, with many offering special prayers and lighting an Akhand Jyot (eternal flame) at the local temple of Goddess Dola Mata.

According to Williams' cousin, Navin Pandya, a grand procession will be held in her honour, accompanied by prayer chanting and fireworks to create a festive atmosphere similar to Diwali and Holi. The villagers are keen to invite her to her paternal village in future. "We have organised a procession with Sunita Williams' photograph and will perform a dhun (prayer chanting) at the temple. We had been offering prayers and lighting the Akhand Jyot for her safe

return. This Jyot will be offered to Goddess Dola Mata on Wednesday after her return to Earth," said Pandya. He said villagers are looking forward to inviting Williams to visit Jhulasan. The villagers' excitement has only grown with the news of her third space mission. "The atmosphere here is festive, with everyone eagerly anticipating her return. We will definitely invite her to visit Jhulasan in the future. It would be an honour to have her among us in her ancestral village," he added.
