Chhattisgarh: Explosives recovered from Maoist hideout in Sukma

SUKMA: A cache of explosives and a Barrel Grenade Launcher (BGL) were recovered from a Maoist hideout in Chhattisgarh's Sukma district, police said on Wednesday. The recovery was made from a forested hill near Danteshpuram village under Bheji police station limits on Tuesday when a joint team of the police's District Reserve Guard (DRG) and District Force was out on an anti-Naxal operation, a senior official said. The operation had been launched based on inputs about the presence of Naxalites in the area, he said. The seized items included 55 gelatin sticks, a BGL and 19 live rounds of .12 bore rifle, the police official said, adding that the security personnel returned to their base on Wednesday. Naxalites had amassed the explosives to target security forces during patrolling in the area but their plans were foiled with this action, he said.

Proclaimed offender nabbed in Delhi in Rs 1 crore govt job scam

NEW DELHI: A proclaimed offender has been arrested for his alleged involvement in a large-scale railway job scam, the Delhi Police said on Wednesday. The accused, Ranjan Paswan, was arrested from Tilak Bridge Railway Station. He has allegedly duped several people of over Rs 1 crore on the pretext of providing jobs in the Indian Railways, they said. "Paswan, a resident of Mayur Vihar, had been absconding since the court declared him a proclaimed offender on January 14," Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Apoorva Gupta in a statement said. He was wanted in multiple cases of cheating and FIRs were lodged against him at several police stations, including Sunlight Colony and Pandav Nagar, she said.

Woman, her lover kill husband, set body ablaze in Rajasthan

JAIPIUR: A vegetable vendor was allegedly murdered by his wife and her lover in Muhana area here, police said on Wednesday. The accused, Gopali Devi (42) and Deendayal (50), were arrested on Tuesday, they said. On March 16, Dhannalal Saini was found dead in Muhana area, DCP (South) Digant Anand said, adding that his wife Gopali Devi was soon detained and during interrogation, she confessed to killing Saini with the help of her lover Deendayal. "When Saini came to know about his wife's affair, he went to Deendayal's shop on March 15 where Gopali works. After an altercation, Gopali and Deendayal hit Dhannalal, leaving him dead on the spot," he said. Later, they dumped the body in a sack and set it ablaze. Next morning, the body was recovered.

Teenager held for molesting three-year-old girl in UP's Ballia

BALLIA (UP): A 14-year-old boy has been taken into custody after being accused of molesting a three-year-old girl in the Kotwali police station area on Wednesday, police said. The police have registered a case against the boy following a complaint by the girl's mother. The accused boy is a neighbour of the victim. Station House Officer (SHO) of the Kotwali police station, Yogendra Bahadur Singh, said, "The incident occurred on Wednesday afternoon when the boy allegedly lured the young girl to a nearby room and sexually molested her by touching her private parts." Further investigation is underway, he said.

Drug smuggler carrying Rs 30,000 cash reward arrested in Barmer

JODHPUR: A drug smuggler carrying a cash reward of Rs 30,000 was arrested in Barmer district on Tuesday, police said. The accused, Jagdish, was caught by Cycloner Team, a special unit of Rajasthan Police's Jodhpur Range, from Dhorimana village under operation 'Vishvavyanjan', IG Jodhpur Vikas Kumar said on Wednesday. Jagdish, who is about 40 years old, had an on-again, off-again connection with the criminal world. He started smuggling drugs in his vehicles, and a case was registered against him in 2012. He was arrested and released from jail in 2018. The same year, he decided to quit smuggling after his nephew died due to drugs, said the police official. Jagdish then started a small business and motivated youths to stay away from drugs. However, he could not stay away longer from the illicit drug trade and started smuggling again. In 2021, he moved to Andhra Pradesh and then to Tamil Nadu.

Ragpicker by day, burglar by night: Delhi Police arrests 22-year-old thief

NEW DELHI: A ragpicker by day and a burglar by night, a 22-year-old man has been arrested for breaking into unguarded commercial offices overnight and selling stolen items in east Delhi's grey market, Delhi Police said on Wednesday. The accused, identified as Akbar alias Haddi, has been involved in crime since his juvenile years, he said. Upon inspecting the premises, he noticed that the sliding window latch was unsecured, suggesting forced entry. A case was registered and further investigation was taken up. CCTV footage, field inquiries and coordination with informers helped confirm Haddi's location, following which he was apprehended. Ten stolen laptops were recovered from his possession, the police officer added.

Fadnavis says Nagpur is calm, vows to 'dig out attackers from their graves'

As curfew continues, a large number of armed police personnel have been posted in sensitive areas

PTI, NAGPUR/BENGALURU/MUMBAI: Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Wednesday said attackers of police during Nagpur violence will be "dug out from their graves", even as the RSS condemned the violence and described the 17th-century Mughal emperor Aurangzeb as "irrelevant".

Police arrested Fahim Khan, Minority Democratic Party candidate for Lok Sabha polls from Nagpur last year, for allegedly leading a protest outside a Nagpur police station on Monday after VHP workers staged an agitation for the removal of Aurangzeb's tomb, which triggered the violence.

Police also released a video of Khan, purportedly delivering an inflammatory speech.

Police have so far arrested 54 people in connection with the Nagpur violence, Maharashtra minister of state for home Yogesh Kadam said, stressing that attacks on police personnel will be dealt with strictly.

Opposition Shiv Sena (UBT) said the Centre should remove the projected monument tag of Aurangzeb's tomb, located in Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar district, to prevent riots and to cool down the heads of fanatics in the state.

Speaking in the state assembly following outrage over rioters allegedly touching a woman constable inappropriately and trying to disrobe her during the violence, Fadnavis said the mob hurled stones and petrol bombs, injuring 33 police personnel, including three DCP-rank officers.

POLICE: SITUATION UNDER CONTROL AS CURFEW CONTINUES IN NAGPUR

PTI, NAGPUR: The law and order situation in Nagpur, which was rocked by violence on Monday night, is under control but a curfew continues in many sensitive areas of the city, a senior official said on Wednesday. Police Commissioner Ravinder Kumar Singal said the situation will be reviewed in the afternoon. Another official said that more than 2,000 armed police personnel have been deployed in the sensitive areas. Similarly, the QRT (quick response team) and RCP (riot control police) are conducting patrolling led by a DCP-rank officer, he said.

police during the arson in Nagpur will be dug out from their graves. Attacks on police are unpardonable. They will get the strictest punishment. We won't spare them," Fadnavis said, while replying to a debate on the budgetary demands of the Home department headed by him.

Fadnavis, who hails from Nagpur, said the situation in the city is calm now. Nagpur is known for peace and communal harmony, he added.

"No riot occurred in the city after 1992. The violence was planned by some people. Only a replica of Aurangzeb's grave was burnt (during the VHP's protest). We have verified that no ayat (verses from the Quran) was burnt. But rumours were spread deliberately," he said.

RSS chief spokesperson Sunil Ambekar told reporters in Bengaluru that any form of violence is detrimental to the society's well-being. He described Aurangzeb as "irrelevant".

"Any type of violence is not good for the health of the society and I think police have taken cognizance of it and so they will get into the details," Ambekar said.

Fresh shutdown in curfew-bound Churachandpur MLAs, tribal bodies appeal for peace

PTI, CHURACHANDPUR/IMPHAL: Hours after a fresh shutdown was imposed by a student body in Manipur's curfew-bound Churachandpur district following clashes between Hmar and Zomi people, a group of MLAs and tribal organisations separately appealed for peace on Wednesday.

Educational institutions remained closed and most shops and markets downed shutters throughout the day. Private vehicles also stayed off the roads, as tensions continued to grip the district.

Several persons were injured as fresh clashes broke out between people belonging to Zomi and Hmar tribes late on Tuesday, just hours after

a peace settlement was reached between the apex bodies of the two communities.

The fresh clashes erupted after a group of men tried to take down a flag of a Zomi militant outfit in the town. In response to the development, the Zomi Students' Federation imposed a shutdown in the district with immediate effect.

In a joint statement, at least 12 Kuki-Zomi and Hmar organisations based in Churachandpur district have called for peace among communities and agreed to form a joint peace committee to monitor the situation and prevent misunderstandings in the future.

The organisations, including Kuki Inpi, Hmar Inpi and Zomi

Council, pledged to work towards communal harmony and peaceful coexistence.

The statement condemned all forms of violence, hate speech, destruction of properties and acts of aggression.

No language imposition under NEP's 3-language formula: Minister of State in Rajya Sabha

PTI, NEW DELHI: The three languages to be learned by school-going children under the National Education Policy (NEP) will be chosen by states, regions and students and no language will be imposed on any state," Union Minister of State for Education Sukanta Majumdar informed Parliament on Wednesday.

The three-language formula recommended by the NEP has been at the centre of controversy with Tamil Nadu refusing to implement it alleging imposition of Hindi by the Centre.

The Centre has, however, refuted Tamil Nadu's charge.

In response to a written question in Rajya Sabha, Majumdar said the three languages to be learned by children will be the choices of states, regions and of course the students themselves, so long as at least two of the three languages are native to India. "There will be a greater flexibility in the three-language formula, and no language will be imposed on any state," he said.

"The NEP 2020 provides that the three-language formula will continue to be implemented while keeping in mind the Constitutional provisions, aspirations of the people, regions and the Union and the need to promote multilingualism as well as promote national unity," Majumdar added.

The minister noted that the policy also provides for making available high-quality textbooks in the home language or mother tongue and encouraging teachers to use a bilingual approach while teaching.

"In order to achieve this objective, the government
