K'taka passes 4% quota for Muslims in govt contracts

PTI, BENGALURU: Karnataka Legislative Assembly on Friday passed a Bill to provide 4 per cent reservation for Muslims in public contracts, amidst strong protests by opposition BJP.

BJP MLAs climbed on the podium where Speaker U T Khader's chair is placed and threw papers at him. On Khader's direction, Marshals evicted the MLAs, who tried to surround the Speaker's chair. Leader of Opposition, R Ashoka, termed the Bill "unconstitutional".

The Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements (Amendment) Bill, 2025) was piloted by Law and Parliamentary Affairs Minister H K Patil. The Cabinet last Friday had approved an amendment to the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements (KTPP) Act, reserving for Muslims 4 per cent of contracts in (civil) works valued up to Rs 2 crore, and goods/services procurement contracts up to Rs 1 crore. BJP SLAMS SUSPENSION OF 18 PARTY MLAS FROM K'TAKA ASSEMBLY FOR SIX MONTHS



PTI, BENGALURU: The opposition BJP on Friday condemned the suspension of 18 MLAs from the Karnataka Assembly for six months and called the move "undemocratic". The party accused the ruling Congress of committing a "grave injustice" to the suspended MLAs, who were protesting against the four per cent reservation for Muslims in public contracts and charges of an attempted "honey trap" involving Karnataka Ministers. The BJP legislators also submitted a memorandum to Governor Thawarchand Gehlot, urging him to reject the reservation for Muslims in contracts through the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements (Amendment) Bill. "The suspension of 18 MLAs was undemocratic. I am saying this because a senior Minister in the Congress government himself said in the Assembly that attempts were made for honey trap 48 MLAs in the state," the BJP state president B Y Vijayendra told reporters outside the assembly.

his 2025-26 Budget, presented on March 7.

At present, Karnataka has reservation in civil works contracts for SC/STs (24 per cent) and OBC contractors belonging to Category-1 (4 per cent) and Category-2A (15 per cent). There were demands to add Muslims under Category-2B of the OBCs with a reservation of 4 per cent.

The BJP has termed the Karnataka government's move to provide four per cent reservation to Muslims in government contracts an "unconstitutional misadventure", and had said it will oppose it at all levels, including challenging it in court, until it is rolled back. As per the Bill, it aims to overcome the unemployment problem in the backward classes and to encourage their participation in construction works, not exceeding 4 per cent for the persons belonging to the category 2B of backward classes (Muslims), out of the total number of government construction works upto Rs 2 crore.

DMK to host first Joint Action Committee meet on delimitation

PTI, CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu's ruling DMK is all set to host its first meeting of states over delimitation of states on March 22 and Chief Minister M K Stalin on Friday said it was more than a meeting, which marked the beginning of a movement that will shape the future of the country to achieve fair delimitation.

Chief Ministers of Kerala, Telangana, and Punjab: Pinarayi Vijayan, Revanth Reddy, Bhagwant Singh Mann, and working president of Shiromani Akali Dal Balwinder Singh Bhunder, and general secretary of Indian Union Muslim League Kerala P M A Salam, were among the leaders who arrived in Chennai to take part in the meeting.

Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, West Bengal and Punjab are the seven states the DMK has reached out to for the meeting.

"A historic day for Indian federalism," Stalin said on the eve of the meeting and BJP Tamil Nadu President K Annamalai alleged the meeting on delimitation was a "delusional drama." Stalin said: "I extend my warmest welcome to the leaders from Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, West Bengal and Punjab are the seven states the DMK

TMC TO SKIP DMK'S DELIMITATION MEET

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Trinamool Congress will not send any representative for the March 22 meeting of states over delimitation called by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin in Chennai, said a source in the ruling party of West Bengal on Friday. The source said the Trinamool Congress (TMC) feels the duplicate voter ID number issue is more important at present, as it may have an impact on the assembly elections in Bihar, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal. Assembly election in Bihar is slated to be held later this year while polls in Kerala, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal are due in 2026. Delhi court dismisses Engineer Rashid's bail plea in terror funding case

PTI, NEW DELHI: A Delhi court on Friday dismissed the bail application of Lok Sabha MP from Jammu and Kashmir's Baramulla, Engineer Rashid, in a terror funding case.

"The bail plea dismissed," Additional Sessions Judge Chanderjit Singh said. Rashid has been lodged in Tihar jail since 2019 after he was arrested by the National Investigation Agency (NIA) under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act in the 2017 terror funding case.

388 Indians deported from US since Jan 2025: Govt in LS

PTI, NEW DELHI: Around 388 Indian nationals have been deported from the US since January 2025, the government informed Parliament. Of these, 333 Indians were deported directly from the US to India on three separate flights in February. Separately, the US, through Panama, "deported 55 Indian nationals, who arrived on commercial flights", Minister of State for External Affairs Kirti Vardhan Singh said in a written response in the Lok Sabha.

The Ministry of External Affairs was asked whether the Union government has received the details of the persons to be deported from the US this year, and if the government has requested the US officials to provide adequate facilities for them.

The ministry was also asked whether the Prime Minister had raised concerns with the US President and top US officials for the "ill treatment" meted out to the deportees. The MEA was also asked if the government has any plan to send our own aircraft to bring back Indians designated as illegal immigrants by the US.

During a hearing this week, Rashid had challenged a March 10 order of the trial court, refusing him custody parole or interim bail to attend Lok Sabha proceedings till April 4.
