Major fire breaks out on building terrace at Miramar

PANJIM: A major fire broke out on the building's terrace shed at Miramar on Saturday afternoon, sending thick plumes billowing into the sky.

Three fire tenders from Panjim fire station were deployed on the spot and about 20 fire personnel managed to bring the blaze under control.

The intense flames and

heavy smoke were visible from a distance, alarming residents and passersby. No injuries have been reported so far.

Heavy breeze caused difficulty in dousing the fire, the fire personnel said.

According to the Panjim Station Fire Officer (SFO) Rupesh Sawant, the fire was believed to have started in a storeroom that was covered with tin sheets on the terrace of the two-storey building. One of the neighbours Ajit Naik said that welding work was going on adjacent to the temporary which could have triggered the fire.

Naik said that he had kept chemicals used in swimming pool maintenance on the terrace besides some clothes, cupboards, plastic items etc were there.

SFO Sawant said that fire fighters extinguished the flames by using turn table ladder and breathing apparatus

sets. "We received the fire call at around 2.12 pm and we put out the blaze and returned by 4.15 pm. We used three fire tenders while fire tenders from neighbouring Old Goa and Pilerne fire stations were told to stand-by. But we managed to douse the fire," he said.

Besides SFO Sawant, SFO Nilesh Fernandes and fire sub-officers Suraj Ghadi and Vinayak Phadte also took part in the fire-fight-


