Woman, lover experience withdrawal symptoms in jail

PTI, MEERUT (UP): In judicial custody for allegedly murdering former Merchant Navy officer Saurabh Rajput, his wife and her lover are having a hard time adjusting to life in jail here, with prison officials claiming that the duo were experiencing drug withdrawal symptoms.

MEERUT MURDER CASE

Muskan Rastogi and her lover Sahil Shukla have been lodged in Chaudhary Charan Singh district jail since March 19 after a court sent the duo to judicial custody for 14 days. The duo wanted to be lodged in same barrack but they were told that as per rules, it was not possible, the officials said. Muskan has also asked

Doctors have prescribed medication to manage their symptoms, and a dedicated team is monitoring their condition, he said. Police investigations have revealed that the two accused consumed drugs and alcohol regularly

for a government lawyer as her family is upset with her, they added.

Jail sources said the duo have been showing signs of extreme distress. "Muskan and Sahil are not able to sleep properly. They are also refusing to eat and drink," a source said.

While some speculate that this might be due to remorse, jail officials attribute it to drug withdrawal.

Senior Jail Superintendent Viresh Raj Sharma said, "Both Sahil and Muskan have been taking drugs for a long time. Due to this, they are having problems of restlessness and are not even able to sleep at night."

a government lawyer who can fight my case in the court". Talking to reporters, Sharma said that Muskan requested to meet him on Saturday.

"When I called Muskan, she said that her family members will not fight for her as they are angry with her, and demanded a government lawyer to fight the case," the official said. "If a prisoner demands a government counsel, then it is our duty to provide him/her a lawyer. We have accepted her application and sending it to the court, so that she can be provided a government lawyer. However, Muskan's lover Sahil has not yet demanded a government lawyer," he said.

The senior jail superintendent also said that the two accused had sought to stay together in the jail.

Kerala Police bust fake theft, three held in Kozhikode

PTI, KOZHICKODE (KERALA): Three persons have been arrested for allegedly orchestrating a fabricated theft to defraud approximately Rs 40 lakh from the father-in-law of the primary suspect of the case in Kuttikattoor of this district, police said on Sunday.

The arrested have been identified as P M Rahees, Sajid alias Shaji and Jamshid, police added.

The case was solved after two days of investigation by a special squad, which analysed CCTV footage from multiple locations, police said.

According to police sources, the prime accused P M Rahees filed a complaint on March 20 stating that Rs 40.25 lakh had been stolen from his car when it was parked at a private hospital in Poovattuparamba, the previous day.

Rahees claimed the money belonged to a close relative who had entrusted it to him for safekeeping. Following his complaint, a case was filed, and an investigation was launched, police said.

According to the police, CCTV footage from nearby cameras showed two individuals on a scooter smashing the car window, taking an item from the vehicle, and fleeing the scene.

However, the suspects were wearing helmets, making it difficult to identify them, police added.

Rahees claimed the stolen bag contained the cash he had placed in the car. Upon further investigation, the Kozhikode City police discovered that the number plate of the vehicle used in the theft was fake.

This discovery complicated the investigation, but after intensifying their efforts, the police located the scooter involved in the crime, police said.

Two suspects, Sajid alias Shaji and Jamshid, were taken into custody. While questioning, Sajid revealed that the item taken from the car was not as Rahees had claimed, police said.

Today's rulers worse than the British: Kejriwal attacks BJP

PTI, NEW DELHI: AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal on Sunday accused the BJP of disregarding the legacy of freedom fighter Bhagat Singh and social reformer Bhimrao Ambedkar.

The former Delhi chief minister also said "today's rulers are worse than the British", taking a dig at the ruling BJP. Kejriwal was speaking at the AAP's 'Ek Shaam Shaheedon Ke Naam' event here, his first public appearance in Delhi after losing the assembly polls in the national capital.

He said his party entered politics to fulfil the dreams of Bhagat Singh and Ambedkar, and not for power.

Senior AAP leader Gopal Rai likened his party's recent electoral loss in Delhi to the way Abhimanyu was trapped and deceived in the "Chakravyuh" (maze) in the Mahabharata. He asserted that just as Abhimanyu fought valiantly, the AAP too would rise again with greater strength. The event was organised

at the AAP headquarters to pay tributes to freedom fighters Bhagat Singh, Rajguru and Sukhdev to commemorate Shaheed Diwas.

Senior AAP leaders, including Manish Sisodia, MP Sanjay Singh, Leader of Opposition in Delhi Assembly Atishi, party's Delhi unit chief Saurabh Bharadwaj, Gopal Rai, MLAs, councillors, and other party workers attended the event.

Addressing the event, Kejriwal said, "Our role models are Babasaheb Ambedkar and Bhagat Singh. Bhagat Singh used to say that merely removing the British was not enough, the structure of society had to change. Otherwise, brown rulers would replace the British."

"This is exactly what has happened and today's rulers are worse than the British," Kejriwal added.

"I want to ask them if there is anyone who has sacrificed more for the country than Bhagat Singh," he said.

China's PLA deploys AI tool DeepSeek in military hospitals, non-combat functions

PTI, BEIJING: China's People's Liberation Army (PLA) has started using the recently released Chinese AI tool 'DeepSeek' for non-combat support functions, especially in military hospitals, to assist the doctors in devising treatment plans besides other civilian areas, media reports said.

DeepSeek's open-source large language models (LLMs) are being used in PLA hospitals, People's Armed Police (PAP), and national defence mobilisation organs, the Hong Kong-based South China Morning Post reported on Sunday.

Earlier this month, the general hospital of the PLA Central Theatre Command announced that it had authorised "embedded deployment" of DeepSeek's R1-70B LLM, saying it could provide treatment plan suggestions to support doctors, according to the Post.

The hospital also emphasised patient privacy and data security, noting that all data was stored and processed on local servers. Similar deployments have been seen in other PLA hospitals nationwide,

including the elite PLA General Hospital in Beijing, also known as "301 Hospital", where senior Chinese officials and military officers receive treatment and highly sensitive personal data is believed to be stored.

Earlier, the PLA, which is investing heavily in modernisation, cautioned its armed forces against banking heavily on artificial intelligence, saying that AI should be a tool to guide but not a replacement for human decision-making on the battlefield because it lacks self-awareness capability.

"As AI evolves, it must remain a tool guided by human judgment, ensuring accountability, creativity, and strategic adaptability remain at the forefront of military decision-making," an article published in the People's Liberation Army Daily, the official media of the Chinese military, said in January.

"AI must work in tandem with human decision-makers to optimise command effectiveness, enhancing rather than replacing human agency," it said.
