114 arrested so far for March 17 violence in Nagpur

PTI, NAGPUR: As many as 114 people have been arrested in connection with the March 17 violence in Nagpur, and the probe is moving in the right direction, a senior police official said on Tuesday.

Speaking to reporters, Nagpur police commissioner Ravinder Singal said that the police were probing into social media posts circulated around the time of the violence, and some people involved in uploading them have been identified.

Large-scale stone pelting and arson took place in several parts of Nagpur on March 17 after baseless rumours were spread claiming that a "chadar" with holy inscriptions was burned during the VHP protests demanding the removal of Mughal emperor Aurangzeb's tomb in Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar, according to the authorities.

Thirty-three police per-

sonnel, including three Deputy Commissioner of Police-rank officers, were injured in the violence.

Following the violence, in which one person lost his life, a curfew was imposed in several areas of the city and was lifted on Sunday.

Singal said, "At least 13

cases have been registered, and 114 people have been arrested for the violence. The accused were produced in court. The probe is moving in the right direction."

The police department has also got some leads in four cyber crime cases reg-

istered in connection with the rioting, he said.

Social media posts circulated at the time are also being probed, he added.

The commissioner further said preparations were underway for Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the city on March 30.

Will make an announcement, says CM Stalin on language row

PTI, CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin on Tuesday slammed the Centre over alleged language imposition and financial injustices and batted for resolution of the issue once and for all by way of precise initiatives and asserted that he would soon make an announcement in this regard.

Stalin, replying to the discussion on the calling attention motion on the language policy in the assembly, said the Tamil Nadu government fully concurred with the legislators who spoke firmly backing the 2-language policy.

"Tamil and English are the two languages of Tamil Nadu's 2-language policy. There is no change on that," the CM asserted and added that there shall be no compromises, come what may.

"We are not against any language. We say that these two languages are enough," he said and added that the government did not pose hindrance to anyone desirous of learning any language.

"At the same time, we do not allow any hegemonic language that intends to destroy Tamil and that is why we follow the 2-language policy," Stalin said. Several states, including Tamil Nadu's neighbouring states, now realise that Tamil Nadu's language policy and the commitment to follow that are correct.

The CM said leader of opposition Edappadi K Palaniswami has gone to Delhi and during his visit, he must take up the language policy issue.

Odisha assembly suspends 12 Congress MLAs for 7 days over indiscipline in House

PTI, BHUBANESWAR: Odisha Assembly Speaker Surama Padhy on Tuesday suspended 12 Congress MLAs for seven days over indiscipline in the House.

The action against the Congress legislators came after the House adopted a motion moved by government Chief Whip Saroj Pradhan.

The suspended MLAs include Congress Legislature Party (CLP) leader Rama Chandra Kadam, Sagar Charan Das, Mangu Khilla, Satyajeet Gomango, Ashok Kumar Das, Dasarathi Gamango and Sofia Firdous.

Two other Congress MLAs Taraprasad Bahinipati and Ramesh Jena were, however, not sus-

pending as they were not present in the House when the announcement was being made. Bahinipati was earlier suspended for seven working days on similar grounds on March 11.

As soon as Padhy announced the decision, Congress members created a ruckus in the assembly, playing gongs as a mark of protest.

The suspended MLAs also

demonstrated in the Well of the House and recited hymns, even as Padhy urged them to vacate the assembly and stop the sit-in.

Odisha's main opposition party, the BJD, condemned the Speaker's move, called it a motivated one to suppress the voice of opposition in the assembly.

"Congress MLAs have been suspended to scare us. We will not be afraid of the action. We will fight and not compromise in any way, Bahinipati said.

Odisha Pradesh Congress Committee (OPCC) president Bhakta Charan Das also criticised the decision and demanded immediate withdrawal of the suspension order.

Rs 858 crore for pollution control remains unutilised due to lack of approval: Par panel

PTI, NEW DELHI: The budgetary allocation of Rs 858 crore for pollution control in 2024-25 remains unutilised due to lack of approval from the Union Environment Ministry for the continuation of the scheme, a parliamentary panel has said in its report.

In the report tabled in the Rajya Sabha on Tuesday, the department-related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Science and Technology, Environment, Forests and Climate Change said air pollution has assumed "gigantic proportions", affecting not just Delhi but many

other cities.

"In such a scenario, the committee is shocked to note that amount to the tune of Rs 858 crore allocated for 'Control of Pollution', which is 27.44 per cent of the annual revised allocation of the ministry, remains unutilized since the approval for continuation of Control of Pollution Scheme till 2025-26 is awaited," the 31-member panel headed by BJP Rajya Sabha member Bhubaneswar Kalita said.

"At a time when the ministry is required to address the grave and critical chal-

lenge of deteriorating air quality, the ministry has not been able to decide the continuation of the concerned scheme, as a result of which not even 1 per cent of the funds allocated for the scheme have been utilized so far," the panel said.

Under the 'Control of Pollution' scheme, the Centre provides financial assistance to pollution control boards/committees and funding for the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) which aims to reduce particulate pollution in 131 highly polluted cities by 40 per

cent by 2026 compared to 2019-20 levels.

The committee noted that rising pollution not only leads to various health issues but also harms the environment.

"The scenario of air pollution in the country is indeed very grim and has been affecting one and all," it said, recommending that the ministry take serious note of the reasons for this gross underutilization.

It also observed that while plantation drives are carried out frequently, the survival rate of these plants is very low.
