Cannabis over 9.49 acres destroyed in Maharashtra's Dhule district

DHULE (MAHARASHTRA): The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) has destroyed cannabis cultivated illegally over 9.49 acres of land in north Maharashtra's Dhule district, officials said on Wednesday. The cultivators were so organised that they even used drip irrigation, said an official release here. The operation was undertaken by DRI Mumbai along with its Pune and Nagpur regional units after receiving specific intelligence that cannabis was being cultivated at Khamkheda Ambe and Rohini villages on Maharashtra-Madhya Pradesh border. After conducting surveillance of this remote area, seven sites with a total of 9.493 acres of cannabis under cultivation were found. Drip irrigation was being used on these sites to increase the yield, "indicating a very organised illicit cultivation", the release said.

Two arrested for stealing Rs 8 lakh

from Dwarka shop

NEW DELHI: Two men have been arrested for allegedly being involved in a burglary of Rs 8 lakh in Delhi's Dwarka, an official said on Wednesday. The duo, identified as Manoj Kumar (34) and Ashok Kumar (39), was nabbed by a team for breaking into a shop and stealing cash. Police said Manoj committed the crime to gift a mobile phone to his wife on their wedding anniversary. The burglary occurred on the intervening night of March 21 and 22 in the Kakrola area. Following the complaint, police analysed over 100 CCTV cameras, which led to the identification of a taxi used in the crime. Police first arrested Ashok on March 28 from Gurugram.

Infant girl succumbs to bird flu in Andhra

NARASARAOPETA (ANDHRA PRADESH): A two-vear-old girl from Andhra Pradesh succumbed to bird flu more than a fortnight ago, an official said on Wednesday. The infant died on March 15, and the Pune-based National Institute of Virology (NIV) later confirmed that she had contracted fter testing her sample. "The girl died of bird flu while undergoing treatment at AIIMS-Mangalagiri," the official told PTI. However, the official said only the infant had contracted bird flu in her entire household, which surprised authorities.

Man shoots brother's sister-in-law before killing self in UP

AGRA (UP): A man shot dead his brother's sister-in-law before killing himself with the same gun in a village here on Wednesday, police said. The motive behind the incident is yet to be ascertained, they said. Deepak (23), a resident of Tundla in Firozabad, went to the house of the in-laws of his brother Abhishek in Rahn Kalan village here. He entered a room with Abhishek's sister-in-law Jyoti (22) and locked the door from inside. Then he shot Jvoti and himself, police said. "After receiving information about the incident, police reached Rahn Kalan. The room was opened and the bodies of Deepak and Jyoti with bullet wounds were found," said Assistant Police Commissioner Piyush Kant Rai. An investigation has been launched into the incident, police said.

Man slits throats of woman, daughter in Visakhapatnam

VISAKHAPATNAM: A 25-year-old man 'attacked' a woman by slitting her throat and injured her daughter—whom he is said to be in love with—at their residence on Wednesday, said a police officer. The accused, identified as Naveen, allegedly slit the throats of Lakshmi (43) and her daughter, Deepika Gayatri (20). Lakshmi died on the spot, while Deepika was hospitalised in critical condition. "We are examining the evidence collected from the crime scene and have sent it to the forensic lab. Additionally, we are reviewing CCTV footage. The accused is on the run, and teams have been formed to apprehend him," police told PTI. Further details are awaited as a case has been registered under relevant sections, and an investigation is underway, they added.

Man, his driver booked for allegedly raping woman

THANE: Police have registered a case against a man and his driver for allegedly raping a 19-year-old woman in Thane district of Maharashtra on a false promise of job, an official said on Wednesday. The prime accused in the case, Surendra Patil, is a resident of Thakurli near Dombivli in the district and is known for his reels or short videos on social media platform Instagram, he said. The victim, who is from Nashik, alleged in her complaint lodged at the Manpada police station that Patil sexually assaulted her between February 16 and March 29 this year on the false promise of providing her a job at the Mumbai international airport.

Muslim law board to challenge Waqf Bill in court, plans street protests

PTI, NEW DELHI: The All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB), major organisation representing Muslims in India, on Wednesday said it will challenge the Wagf (Amendment) Bill in court and take the fight against the "black law" that threatens the community's rights to the streets.

The Waqf Bill was tabled in the Lok Sabha for discussion and passage on Wednesday. If passed by the Lower House, the Bill will be tabled in the Rajya

Criticising the proposed legislation at a press conference, AIMPLB member Md Adeeb claimed it was an attempt to seize properties of the Muslim community.

"They have started this spectacle thinking they can take away our property. Can this be accepted? Do not think that we are defeated," Adeeb said.

Stating that the Bill was opposed during deliberations of the Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) set up to review it, Adeeb said, "It should not be assumed that we have lost the battle. We have just begun. This is a fight to save the country because the proposed law endangers the very fabric of India."

J&K POLITICAL PARTIES OPPOSE WAQF BILL. TERM IT INTERFERENCE IN RELIGIOUS MATTERS

PTI, SRINAGAR: Political parties in Kashmir on Wednesday opposed the amendments made to the Waqf Act saying it was an interference in religious matters and an attempt to disempower Muslims. Union Minority Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju on Wednesday tabled the Wagf (Amendment) Bill, 2025, in the Lok Sabha. The Bill seeks to improve the functioning of Wagf properties, address complexities, ensure transparency and introduce technology-driven management Opposition parties have slammed it as "unconstitutional" and against the interest of the Muslim community. She said the secular forces should intervene to prevent the country becoming another Myanmar.

He urged all conscientious citizens to resist the Bill and reaffirmed the AIMPLB's commitment to oppose it both legally and through public demon-

"We will go to court. We will not rest until this (proposed) law is withdrawn," he added.

AIMPLB Vice President Mohammad Ali Mohsin said the Muslim body

"categorically rejects" the Wagf (Amendment) Bill 2025, describing it as discriminatory, communally motivated and a blatant infringement on the constitutional rights of Muslim citizens.

AIMPLB spokesperson Mohammad Ali Mohsin said, "We have started this fight because we want to save the country. Our aim is to put an end to this black law."

He said board members will hold nationwide protests on the lines of the farmers' agitation.

"We will organise programmes across the country just like farmers did. If needed, we will block roads and take all peaceful measures to oppose the bill," Mohsin said.

He said that the Bill undermines fundamental principles of religious freedom, equality and justice, enshrined in Articles 14. 25 and 26 of the Constitution. He outlined several key

objections, including concerns that the Bill erodes Waqf Board autonomy by altering its composition and introducing non-Muslim members, thereby compromising the community's right to manage its own religious and charitable endowments.

Withdraw Waqf Bill, CM Stalin urges PM

PTI, CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin on Wednesday wrote to Prime Minister Narendra Modi seeking withdrawal of the Waqf (Amendment) Bill, 2024, saying it will harm the interest of Muslims.

Stalin said the Constitution grants every citizen the right to follow their respective religion and it is the duty of the elected governments to uphold and

protect this right.

Pak army violates ceasefire after mine blast along LoC in J&K

PTI, JAMMU: Pakistani troops violated the ceasefire by resorting to unprovoked firing after a mine exploded along the Line of Control (LoC) in Poonch district of Jammu and Kashmir, a defence spokesman said on Wednesday.

Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh

He said the Indian army responded effectively to the ceasefire violation and continues to dominate the LoC where the situation is under control.

Official sources said the violation took place at 1.10 pm on Tuesdav.

While the Indian Army made no mention of any casualty on the Pakistan side, the sources said five enemy soldiers were injured in the explosion and the subsequent firing between the two sides.

On 01 Apr 2025, a mine blast occurred in Krishna Ghati Sector while the Pakistan Army was patrolling along the LoC. This was followed by unprovoked firing and ceasefire violation by Pakistan Army," Jammu-based defence PRO Lt Col Suneel Bartwal said in a revised

statement.

Own troops responded effectively. The Indian Army continues to dominate the LoC. The situation is under control, he said.

The earlier statement had mentioned that "a mine blast occurred in Krishna Ghati Sector due to Pakistan Army intrusion across LoC".

On February 21, India and Pakistan military held a flag meeting along the LoC in Poonch district in an effort to de-escalate tension after several incidents of cross-border firing and an IED attack.

The brigade-commander level flag meeting, lasting 75 minutes, had taken place in the Chakkan-Da-Bagh crossing point area with both sides highlighting the need to maintain peace along the borders.

The ceasefire violations along the borders of Jammu and Kashmir have been rare since the two countries renewed an agreement on February 25, 2021. However, several incidents were reported on the LoC in Poonch-Rajouri sector in February.

Kuki groups set three pre-conditions ahead of April 5 Delhi talks

PTI. IMPHAL: Ahead of the April 5 talks between Kuki Zo and Meitei groups called by the Ministry of Home Affairs in New Delhi, the Kuki leadership based in Manipur's Kangpokpi district has set up three pre-conditions including no cross movement between Meitei and Kukis in the areas where the other community is in majority.

Kuki Zo Council (KZC) chairman Henlianthang Thanglet said the three conditions were set up during a consultation meet organised at Kangpokpi by the Committee on Tribal Unity (COTU) on Tuesday.

Thanglet

said the

pre-conditions three are "the movement of Meitei individuals in Kuki-Zo-dominated areas and vice versa shall be strictly restricted, hostilities shall be halted for a minimum period of six months to facilitate negotiations, a structured formal and meaningful dialogue process must be initiated during the ceasefire period."
