

Texas measles outbreak hits 505 cases, spreading to various states

virus began to spread in late January and health officials say it has spread to New Mexico, Oklahoma, Kansas and Mexico.

Three people who were unvaccinated have died from measles-related illnesses this year, including two elementary school-aged children in Texas. The second child died Thursday at a Lubbock hospital, and Health Secretary Robert F. Kennedy Jr. attended the fu-

neral in Seminole, the epicentre of the outbreak.

As of Friday, there were seven cases at a day care where one young child who was infectious gave it to two other children before it spread to other classrooms, Lubbock Public Health director Katherine Wells said. "Measles is so contagious I won't be surprised

if it enters other facilities," their last exposure, Wells Wells said. There are more than 200 children at the day talisation numbers in Texcare, Wells said, and most as have climbed steadily since the outbreak began, have had least one dose of the measles, mumps and and spiked by 81 cases rubella vaccine, which is first recommended between 12 and 15 months old and a second shot between 4 and 6 years old.
