Murshidabad Waqf Act protests: 22 arrested, security heightened

PTI, KOLKATA: Twenty-two people were arrested in connection with the violence in the Muslim-dominated Murshidabad district of West Bengal during a demonstration against the Waqf (Amendment) Act, police said on Wednesday.

The situation has been peaceful with a huge contingent of police maintaining a strict vigil on the sensitive areas, especially in and around Jangipur, which was rocked by the violence on Tuesday, they said.

"The situation is calm, peaceful and under control. Not a single untoward incident was reported from anywhere in the district. Prohibitory orders would continue to remain in force till 6 pm on April 10. Internet would also remain suspended till 6 pm on April 11," a senior police officer said.

Prohibitory orders were clamped in and around Raehunathgani and Suti police station areas following the violence.

Stones were hurled targeting the police, and vehicles of the force were set on fire by a mob that blocked

You don't need to feel rattled." The Wagf (Amendment) Bill was passed by the Lok Sabha on April 3, and by the Rajya Sabha in the early hours of the next day after marathon debates in both Houses of Parliament. President Droupadi Murmu gave her assent to the Bill on April 5. Kerala: Lathicharge during protest against Waqf Bill near Karipur airport The Wagf (Amendment) Act, which was passed by Parliament last week, has come into force on April 8

PTI, KOZHIKODE (KER-ALA): Tension prevailed near Karipur International Airport here for a while on Wednesdav after a protest march by an Islamist outfit against the Waqf Bill turned violent.

The incident occurred during a march organised by activists of the Solidarity Youth Movement and the Students Islamic Organisation (SIO), both affiliated with Jamaat-e-Islami. The protesters were demanding the scrapping of the recently passed Bill, police said.

Barricades were set up by the police to prevent the protesters from advancing. When the protesters attempted to break through despite warnings, police resorted to a lathicharge and used water cannons multiple times to disperse the crowd.

RBI cuts repo rate by 25 bps; lowers GDP outlook to 6.5%

Concerns over impact of US tariffs on growth trumps fight against inflation, monetary stance changed to accommodative; home, auto loans to get cheaper

PTI. MUMBAI: Home, auto and other loans are likely to cost less as the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) cut interest rates on Wednesday for a second consecutive time and signalled more easing to come as it sought to bolster the economy that is facing further pressure from damaging US tariffs. The Monetary Policy Committee

(MPC), consisting of three central bank members and an equal number of external members, voted unanimously to cut the repurchase or repo rate by 25 basis points

remain vigilant to the possible risks from global uncertainties and weather disturbances", Malhotra said. Explaining the meaning of change in policy stance, he said, "The change in stance means MPC intends only the status quo or rate cut."

Since taking office in December, Malhotra has pivoted to a more growth-friendly approach than his predecessor Shaktikanta Das, who was more focused on containing price rise (inflation).

The new governor cut rates in his global tariff war on India, he said it shall have a negdebut policy meeting in February, and has injected more than USD 80 billion into the banking system in the last two months. Lower interest rates provide relief to businesses and consumers alike, potentially spurring credit demand, investments, and job creation. On the impact of global trade and policy uncertainties on growth and inflation, the RBI governor said uncertainty in itself dampens growth by affecting investment and spending decisions of businesses and households.

funding needs. With a 25 bps cut in the repo rate, all external benchmark lending rates (EBLR) linked to it will come down. And if the banks fully pass on this to the borrowers, equated monthly

instalments (EMIs) on home, auto and personal loans will decline by 25 bps. The move lowers borrowing
