SC to hear pleas challenging Waqf Amendment Act on April 16

PTI, NEW DELHI: A Supreme Court bench headed by Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna will hear on April 16 as many as 10 petitions, including the one filed by AIMIM leader Asaduddin Owaisi, challenging the constitutional validity of the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025.

According to the apex court website, besides the CJI, Justices Sanjay Kumar and KV Viswanathan are part of the three-judge bench for hearing the petitions.

In addition to Owaisi's plea, the court has listed for hearing the petitions filed by AAP leader Amanatullah Khan, Association for the Protection of Civil Rights, Arshad Madani, Samastha Kerala Jamiathul Ulema, Anjum Kadari, Taiyyab Khan Salm-ani, Mohammad Shafi, Mohammed Fazlurrahim and RJD leader Manoj Kumar Jha. A few other petitions are yet to be listed before the bench by the apex court registry. The Centre, on April 8, filed a caveat in

the apex court and sought a hearing before any order was passed in the matter. A caveat is filed by a party in the high courts and the apex court to ensure that no orders are passed without hearing it.

The central government on Tuesday notified the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025, which got the assent of President Droupadi Murmu on April 5 after its

passage from Parliament following heated debates in both houses. The bill was passed in the Rajya Sabha with 128 members voting in favour and 95 opposing it. It was cleared by the Lok Sabha with 288 members supporting it and 232 against it. The All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB), Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind, the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam

MUSLIM GROUPS URGE KERALA TO REJECT WAQF AMENDMENT ACT
PTI, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Muslim organisations in Kerala have called on the state's Left government and opposition parties to pass a joint resolution saying the controversial Waqf Amendment Act will not be implemented in the state. They wanted the state to take a cue from Tamil Nadu and West Bengal. While West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee declared that she would not implement the act in her state, Tamil Nadu Assembly passed a resolution demanding the Centre to roll back the Waqf amendment bill even before it was passed by the parliament. DMK, the ruling party in Tamil Nadu, has moved the Supreme Court challenging the Waqf Amendment Act. "Stalin has already made an announcement, and their assembly has passed a resolution against the implementation of the Waqf Amendment Act. We demand that the Kerala government should also pass such a resolution," Thodiyyur Muhammed Kunji Moulavi, General Secretary of the South Kerala Jamiatul Ulama, told PTI on Thursday.

(DMK), Congress MPs Imran Pratapgarhi and Mohammad Jawed are other key petitioners. On April 7, a bench headed by the CJI assured senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind, to consider listing the peti-

tions. The party said the immediate implementation of the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025 infringes and prejudices the rights of about 50 lakh Muslims in Tamil Nadu and 20 crore Muslims in other parts of the country.

Fake flight ticket booking racket busted

PTI, NEW DELHI: Two men were arrested for allegedly duping people by offering fake airline tickets at throwaway prices, Delhi Police said on Thursday.

With their arrest, police claimed to have busted a gang selling fake airline tickets using different social media platforms.

The accused, identified as Salman Sayeed Siddiqui (50) and Rohit Rajaram Ghanekar (29), are said to be part of a larger racket, police said.

According to police, the operation came to light following a complaint lodged by Rajeev Chopra, a resident of Bhagat Singh Park. Chopra was tricked into transferring Rs 47,681 after responding to a social media advertisement for a cheap Delhi-to-Toronto flight.

"After contacting the number provided in the advertisement, which turned out to be a virtual number, he was persuaded to share personal and payment details. The fraudsters booked dummy tickets and vanished once the money was received," Deputy Commissioner of Police (Outer North) Nidhin Valsan in a statement said.

Police later registered an FIR and a team was formed to trace the accused.

Investigations revealed that the accused used virtual number to make calls, fake social media pages mimicking genuine travel agencies and phishing techniques to ensnare unsuspecting customers, said the DCP.

He said that the accused would create fake tickets of airline websites to gain trust before asking for payment. "Once the funds were transferred, they would deactivate communication channels," he said.

All 26/11 accused deserve death: Ex-cop who nabbed Kasab

PTI, MUMBAI: A former police officer, whose team had caught terrorist Ajmal Kasab during the 2008 Mumbai terror attacks, on Thursday said all the accused involved in the conspiracy of the 26/11 case should be tried by courts in India and given capital punishment.

Talking to PTI, retired officer Hemant Bavdhankar congratulated the National Investigation Agency (NIA) on the successful extradition of Tahawwur Hussain Rana, one of the key conspirators of the 26/11 attacks, to India.

"Not only me, but all the Indians have a feeling that the accused involved in the 26/11 terror attacks should get capital punishment after a trial in India," he said.

"If we are able to punish all the accused persons who were involved in the Mumbai terror attacks conspiracy, our martyrs and

RANA'S EXTRADITION A GOOD MOVE: EX-HOME MINISTER SHINDE
PTI, MUMBAI: Senior Congress leader and former Union home minister Sushilkumar Shinde and the other opposition parties on Thursday welcomed the extradition of the 2008 Mumbai terror attacks case accused Tahawwur Hussain Rana. "It's a good thing," Shinde told reporters in Ahmedabad, where he attended the AICC session. Shinde was the Union home minister in the Congress-led UPA government in 2012 when Ajmal Amir Kasab, the lone terrorist captured alive from the Pakistani group that carried out the terror attack, was hanged to death in Pune's Yerawada Jail. Rana, 64, is being brought to India after his last-ditch attempt to evade extradition failed as the US Supreme Court justices rejected his application. He is expected to reach New Delhi on Thursday.

innocent citizens who were killed or injured in the attack, will get justice. This is what I feel," Bavdhankar said.

Soon after the terrorists launched attacks at different places in the metropolis on November 26, 2008, Bavdhankar, who was then a police inspec-

tor, was posted at Girgaon Chowpatty in south Mumbai along with his team as part of the nakabandi (road blockade) operation. Bavdhankar and other members of the team later apprehended Kasab alive, whereas Abu Ismail was killed by the bullet fired by the officer.

While dealing with a woman's plea for initiating criminal contempt proceedings against the husband and awarding him six-month jail time, the bench observed that though several events had occurred during the proceedings in the high court and the family courts, he couldn't be squarely blamed.

Lawyers should not "fuel" allegations in matrimonial disputes: Delhi HC

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court has said lawyers must advise clients in matrimonial disputes for a resolution instead of levelling and "fueling" allegations against each other.

A bench of Justices Prathiba M Singh and Amit Sharma observed in matrimonial disputes, the litigants experienced emotional trauma, with their personal lives com-

ing to a standstill and it was conscious of their "frustration and exasperation".

Peace and tranquillity, however, were extremely necessary and the conduct of litigants in such matters could not cross the boundaries prescribed in the law, the bench added.

"Lawyers also have a great responsibility in such matters not only towards their own client

but also towards the court and the society. Peace and tranquility are extremely necessary. Lawyers ought to advise clients towards resolution of disputes rather than making and fuelling allegations against each other," said the court in an order passed on April 7.

The court went on, "Allegations in such matters could be taken extremely personally which could

lead to clients misbehaving with opposing counsels, though the same cannot be justified in any manner. Finally, however, the conduct of litigants in such matters cannot cross the boundaries which are prescribed in law."

The court made the observations while imposing costs of Rs 1 lakh on a husband, to be paid to his estranged wife, for his misbehaviour in a family

Pleas over religious conversions: SC to hear on April 16

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court is scheduled to hear on April 16, a batch of pleas relating to the issue of religious conversions in the country.

While some pleas have challenged the anti-conversion laws in several states, another petition has sought a relief against forced religious conversions.

The April 16 causerlist on the apex court website shows the matter would come up before a bench of Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justices Sanjay Kumar and KV Viswanathan.

During the hearing in one of the pleas in January 2023, the apex court observed religious conversions was a serious issue and should not be given a political colour.

It had sought the assistance of attorney general R Venkataramani on a plea seeking direction to the Centre and states to take stringent steps to control the alleged fraudulent religious conversions.

The plea sought a check on religious conversions through "intimidation, threatening, deceptively luring through gifts and monetary benefits".

The top court had in 2023 asked the parties challenging the anti-conversion laws of several states to file a common petition for the transfer of cases on the issue from the high courts to the apex court.

There were also two separate petitions filed by the states of Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh challenging the interim orders of the respective high courts staying certain provisions of their laws on conversion.
