PTI, NEW DELHI: Amid protests over the new Waqf legislation in several parts of the country, Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah on Monday alleged the law "targeted one particular religion" despite India being a secular country. Abdullah was speaking to reporters on the legislation and protests in West Bengal's Murshidabad district over the law on the sidelines of a conference in Delhi. The Centre on April 8 notified the Waqf (Amendment) Act, which received President Droupadi Murmu's assent on April 5 after its passage in Parliament following heated debates in both Houses.

The discussions witnessed objections from opposition parties that described the legislation as "anti-Muslim and unconstitutional" while the government said the "historic reform" would benefit the minority community.

"My party has already filed a petition in front of the Supreme Court, and now leave it to the judges. We are among a number of organisations that have approached the Supreme Court to look at this. Let them take a look," the National Conference vice-president said.

"We believe this piece of legislation has targeted one particular religion... We are supposed to be a secular state, all religions are supposed to be treated equally, we believe that we have a right to be treated equally. We want the Supreme Court to adjudicate on this. Now, we will wait," he added.

BENGAL: WAQF VIOLENCE SHIFTS TO BHANGAR; MURSHIDABAD REMAINS CALM

PTI, KOLKATA/MURSHIDABAD/MALDA: Fresh episodes of Waqf (Amendment) Act-related violence rocked Bhangar area in West Bengal's South 24 Parganas district on Monday, even as police claimed that law and order situation in the previous riot epicentre of Murshidabad remained largely under control. Supporters of the Indian Secular Front (ISF) clashed with the police at Bhangar during protests over the Act, leading to several injuries, vandalising of public properties and the torching of multiple police vehicles. The clashes erupted when police stopped ISF supporters from heading towards Ramlila Maidan in central Kolkata to attend an anti-Waqf Act rally addressed by party leader and Bhangar MLA Naushad Siddique. According to police, the rallyists were stopped near Bhojerhat on the Basanti Highway, where a large number of ISF workers had gathered from Bhangar as well as neighbouring areas such as Minakhan and Sandeshkhali.

Jammu and Kashmir's ruling National Conference had on April 11 said it filed a petition in the Supreme Court, challenging the amendments to the Waqf Act.

Several Muslim bodies and leaders of different opposition parties have challenged the constitutionality of the law in the top court, which will hear the case on April 16.

Besides protests in Murshidabad, agitations against the legislation took place in a few other parts of the country on Sunday.

Security beefed up in Bishnupur, Churachandpur districts in Manipur

PTI, IMPHAL: Security was tightened in Manipur's Bishnupur and Churachandpur districts on Monday, as many Meiteis camped in Moirang to undertake their annual pilgrimage to the Thangjing foothills — a site they consider sacred — while members of the Kuki-Zo community urged them to refrain from the journey. To prevent any untoward incident, security deployment was increased in Kwakta and Phougakchaj Ikhai in Bishnupur district, officials said. The pilgrimage route to Thangjing must pass through these areas.

The Thangjing Hill is considered a sacred site by the Meitei community, who traditionally visit the area in April. On Sunday, many Meitei pilgrims from

TWO MILITANTS ARRESTED IN MANIPUR, RS 21 LAKH CASH, FIREARMS SEIZED

PTI, IMPHAL: Manipur Police arrested two militants of the banned United National Liberation Front (UNLF) from two separate places in Imphal East district and seized firearms and Rs 21 lakh in cash from their possession, an official said on Monday. One UNLF militant involved in extortion activities was arrested from Wangkhei area in Imphal East district on Sunday. One Berreta pistol with 15 live rounds was seized from his possession. In a raid conducted at his hideout police seized one SMG carbine gun, one 9 mm pistol, four magazine, one hand grenade, 66 sniper live round, and Rs 69,000 in cash, the official said. Another UNLF (Pambei) cadre was arrested from the Khundrakpam Awang Leikai area of Imphal East district on Sunday, the official said. Police said he was involved in extortion activities in and around the Imphal area. A sum of Rs 21,50,000 in cash was seized from his possession, they said.

Noida: 150 kg cannabis seized, 3 arrested

PTI, NOIDA: Three people were arrested and 150 kgs of 'ganja' (cannabis) worth Rs 40 lakh was recovered from them in Noida on Monday, police said. The arrested accused, Inam-ul-haq, Sahnawaz and No-man, residents of UP's Muzaafarnagar, were involved in cannabis smuggling for the last five years, Central Noida DCP Shakti Mohan Avasthy said. The arrests were made in a joint operation of Badalpur police and CRT team, he said.

Inam-ul-haq is the kingpin of the gang and has been jailed in a similar crime earlier as well but was released some time ago, the DCP said, adding that 150 kgs of cannabis worth Rs 40 lakhs was recovered from the three men.

Woman dead, 5 of family hurt in road accident in UP's Pilibhit

PILIBHIT (UP): A 50-year-old woman died and five members of her family were injured after their car overturned near Gularia Bhoop Singh village here on Monday, police said. The accident occurred around 6 am on the Ghunghchai-Banda state highway, when the victims were returning home after visiting Uttarakhand's Purnagiri temple, they said. Ghunghchai SHO Rakesh Kumar said the car veered off the road, hit a culvert and overturned, killing Usha Devi, a resident of Puraina village in Shahjahanpur district. Her son Amit (28), daughter-in-law Neetu (25), granddaughter Anika (5), relative Suman and another unidentified person suffered serious injuries in the accident, the police said.

Minor girl gangraped in UP's Kasganj, 8 nabbed

KASGANJ (UP): Eight men have been arrested for allegedly raping a 16-year-old girl here, police said on Monday. On April 10, the girl, along with a 17-year-old with whom her marriage had been fixed, had gone to get her ration card prepared, they said. At about 2.30 pm, when she was sitting near a canal with her fiancé after returning from the DSO office, Yogesh, Ajay and seven to eight unidentified men came there, the police said. The accused took them into separate bushes. While three men raped the girl, others took her gold earrings and Rs 5,000 cash and also forcibly got Rs 5,000 transferred from her fiancé's mobile through UPI, the victim alleged in her complaint.

Delhi couple held for Rs 2.70 crore property fraud

NEW DELHI: Delhi Police's Economic Offences Wing (EOW) arrested a couple for allegedly duping a businessman of Rs 2.70 crore on the pretext of promising commercial space in an unbuilt project, an official said on Monday. Those arrested have been identified as Vinay Jain (55) and his wife Asha Jain (52), they said. According to the statement, the couple lured the complainant, Virender Kathuria, into booking three shops in the proposed commercial complex. They falsely claimed that the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) had handed over vacant possession of the land for development. Trusting their representations, Kathuria paid Rs 2.70 crore on January 1, 2016, with an agreement to pay the balance of Rs 74.6 lakh upon getting possession, it said.

Two girls die of suffocation after getting locked inside car in Telangana

HYDERABAD: Two girls, aged four and five respectively, died of "suffocation" after accidentally getting locked inside a car in neighbouring Ranga Reddy district on Monday, police said. The incident happened in Damargidda village at around 2 PM when the girls, both cousins, while playing, got into the car parked near their relative's house, they said. Neither their parents nor their other family members were aware that the children had got locked inside the car, police said, based on preliminary information. It was after about 30-45 minutes, they found the girls unconscious in the car and immediately shifted them to a government hospital where they were declared brought dead, a police official at Chevella police station said.
