**India, China prepare to resume Mansarovar Yatra; both sides agree on flight services**  
**NEW DELHI:** India and China are making preparations to resume the annual Kailash Mansarovar Yatra soon besides looking at restarting direct flights as part of broader efforts to normalise the bilateral ties that came under severe strain following the border row in eastern Ladakh. "We will soon issue a notice for the public regarding the Kailash-Mansarovar Yatra. There is a possibility of the yatra starting soon," External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said at his weekly media briefing. The pilgrimage to Kailash Mansarovar in China's Tibet Autonomous Region and direct flights between the two countries have been suspended since 2020 in view of the military standoff along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in eastern Ladakh.

**WB Gov to leave for violence-hit Murshidabad**

**PTI, KOLKATA:** West Bengal Governor C V Ananda Bose will visit refugee camps and riot-affected areas in Malda and Murshidabad on a two-day trip starting Friday, overruling Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee's request to defer the visit for a few more days.

Bose told reporters at Raj Bhavan that he would be visiting some of the areas and meeting people "to see the ground situation himself". Bose is expected to meet victims of the violence, assess the ground situation and hold discussions with district officials and police personnel.

"The governor will leave for Malda tomorrow morning and visit the camps where the refugees from Murshidabad are staying. Then he will leave for the riot-affected areas of Murshidabad and either return on Friday night or Saturday morning," a Raj Bhawan official said.

**HC reserves order on extending CAPF deployment in Murshidabad**

**West Bengal State government claims situation under control**

**PTI, KOLKATA:** The Calcutta High Court on Thursday reserved its order on the continuation of central forces in violence-hit Murshidabad district.

**WAQF PROTESTS**

The court suggested that a three-member panel, comprising one member each from the National Human Rights Commission, the West Bengal State Human Rights Commission and the State Legal Services Authority, should visit the affected pockets of the district to oversee the restoration of peace and rehabilitation of people displaced due to the violence.

A division bench of Justices Soumen Sen and Raja Basu Chowdhury heard a petition moved by the Leader of the Opposition Suvendu Adhikari, who claimed that bomb blasts took place during communal riots in the Muslim-majority district and prayed that the National Investigation Agency be handed over the probe into the violence.

Another petitioner pleaded for steps by the state government for the return of people displaced

by the violence to their homes. The lawyer appearing for the Centre prayed before the court that deployment of CAPF (central armed police forces) in Murshidabad be extended, considering the sensitivity of the situation on the ground.

Around 17 companies of central forces currently re-

main deployed in the trouble-torn pockets of Suti and Samsarganj-Dhulian in the district.

The high court had on Saturday ordered the deployment of CAPF in the district for the restoration of peace. While making its submission before the court, the state government placed a report and claimed that the law and order situation in the district is currently under control.

The state also submitted that some of the affected families have already returned to their homes.

Several people have taken shelter in a school-turned-relief camp in the adjoining Malda district after escaping the violence that took place during protests over the Waqf (Amendment) Act in Murshidabad in the past few days, the petitioner claimed.

**Patnaik files nomination for post of BJD prez for 9th time**

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar on Thursday questioned the judiciary setting a timeline for the president to take decisions and act as a "super Parliament", saying the Supreme Court cannot fire a "nuclear missile" at democratic forces.

**ATTACK ON JUDICIARY**

Dhankhar's strong words to the judiciary came during his speech to Rajya Sabha interns, days after the Supreme Court sought to fix a timeline for the president to grant assent to the bills reserved for her consideration by the governor.

"So, we have judges who will legislate, who will perform executive functions, who will act as super Parliament and absolutely have no accountability because the law of the land does not apply to them," Dhankhar said.

The vice president also described Article 142, which grants plenary powers to the Supreme Court, as a "nuclear missile against democratic forces available to the judiciary 24x7".

"Article 142 has become a nuclear missile against democratic forces (and) available to (the) judiciary 24x7," he said.



**'Why no FIR in burnt cash discovery at judge's house'**

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar on Thursday questioned the lack of an FIR in the discovery of wads of burnt cash case from the residence of a high court judge, wondering whether a "category beyond law" has secured immunity from prosecution.

Dhankhar also questioned the legal standing of the three-judge panel carrying out an in-house probe into the matter.

manner, and if not, becomes law," Dhankhar said.

The vice president said his worries were at a "very highest level" and he had never thought in "my life" that he would have the occasion to see it.

He reminded the audience that the president of India is in a very elevated position.

"(The) president takes an oath to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution. Others, including ministers, the vice president, parliamentarians and judges take an oath to abide by the Constitution," Dhankhar said.

"We cannot have a situation where you direct the president of India and on what basis? The only right you have under the Constitution is to interpret the Constitution under Article 145(3). There it has to be five judges or more..." he said.

**IIT Hyderabad helps Indian Army build world's first on-site 3D-printed military bunker in Leh**

**PTI, BENGALURU:** With the help of the Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad, a Hyderabad-based deep-tech start-up, Simpliforge Creations, has built the world's first on-site 3D-printed bunker in Leh for military use.

Project Prabal envisages military bunkers in different configurations in remote locations at higher altitudes, said Professor K V L Subramaniam of IIT-Hyderabad, under whose guidance the project was conceptualised.

"The demonstration project that we did is located in Leh, at an altitude of 11,000 feet above sea level, and we completed the construction under what is called HALO conditions – high altitude and low oxygen," Subramaniam said.

According to him, thanks to a lot of planning, they managed to achieve the project in under two weeks, including the transportation of the printer to

the remote spot. "The location was highly inhospitable, where we had to function at 40 to 50% oxygen levels. Lack of oxygen meant both man and machine had to perform at lower efficiency levels," said the professor.

The team is also behind the world's first 3D-printed temple inside Charvitha Meadows, a gated villa community at Burugupalli in Siddipet, Telangana.
