Four militants arrested; arms and ammunition seized

PTI, IMPHAL: Security forces have arrested four militants of a banned outfit from different areas in Imphal East district of Manipur, police said on Tuesday.

Three women, including a woman, belonging to PREPAK (Pro) outfit were arrested from Ngakhapat Adventure Kharok area on Monday, a police officer said.

A .32 pistol with a magazine loaded with five cartridges, six mobile phones and two two-wheelers were seized from their possession, he said.

They were allegedly involved in the recent kidnapping of two persons for ransom near Naorem Birahari College in Imphal East district, the officer said.

Another insurgent of PREPAK was arrested on Sunday from Sawombung in Imphal East district. He was identified as Khundrakpam Katho Singh (22).

KANGPOKPI DISTRICT POLICE ASKS ITS PERSONNEL TO STAY AWAY FROM APRIL 30 MEETING

PTI, IMPHAL: The Kangpokpi district police has asked its personnel not to attend the meeting called by a "fictitious organisation", stating that disciplinary action would be taken otherwise. In a statement, the district police said it was learnt from social media that the Kangchup Area Protection and Development Committee, under the aegis of Kuki Inpi, South West Sadar Hills, has called for a meeting of all personnel of police, Manipur Rifles and Indian Reserve Battalion from Kuki villages in Kangchup area on April 30. "All personnel are strictly warned that the announcement made by the fictitious organisation is illegal and any uniformed personnel attending the meeting will be considered to have committed gross service misconduct and strict disciplinary action will be initiated," it said. Raising concern over the law and order situation in the state, the Meitei Heritage Society said summoning police personnel for such a meeting was a "mockery of India and democracy".

PTI, AMRELI (GUJARAT): A trainee pilot was killed when a trainer aircraft belonging to a private aviation academy crashed in a residential area in Gujarat's Amreli district on Tuesday afternoon

and caught fire, a police official said.

The plane fell on a tree before crashing into an open plot. The aircraft crash-landed into a residential area in the Giriya

Road area of Amreli town at around 12:30 pm due to unknown reasons, killing the trainee pilot on the spot, said Amreli Superintendent of Police, Sanjay Kharat.

Rendered jobless, agitating teachers reject Mamata's appeal to withdraw agitation

PTI, KOLKATA: Unfazed by repeated appeals from West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and Education Minister Bratya Basu to withdraw agitation and rejoin classes, agitating teachers, now rendered jobless by a Supreme Court verdict, announced on Tuesday they would continue with their indefinite sit-in before the state School Service Commission headquarters till their demand for publication of a list of tainted and untainted candidates is met.

The decision of the protesting teachers, who braved the sultry Kolkata weather, lack of basic amenities like toilets and drinking water and continued their overnight siege to the SSC office while holding the commission top brass and staff gheraoed inside the building, came after a fresh round of talks between them and SSC Chairman Siddhartha Majumdar fell through.

The protesters, however, said they would allow food and medicines of the gheraoed officials and staff to reach their intended recipients inside Acharya Sadan, the SSC office.

In a similar demonstration, sacked non-teaching staff kept the streets outside the adjacent Derozio Bhavan, the office of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education (WBBSE), occupied and

threatened to stay put till the demanded list was published.

Earlier in the day the education minister, while assuring that the state government stood firmly beside the teachers who lost their jobs, urged the protesters to refrain from doing anything that "might weaken the review petition" which the state was planning to file before the top court.

IAF officer booked for assault in Bengaluru road rage incident

PTI, BENGALURU: An FIR has been registered against a 40-year-old IAF officer on charges of attempt to murder, criminal intimidation and voluntarily causing hurt based on a counter-complaint by a call centre employee, who was previously arrested on the officer's complaint in a road rage incident, police said on Tuesday.

Indian Air Force Wing Commander Shiladitya Bose made an allegation in a video he shared that he was attacked and verbally abused by a group of Kannada-speaking individuals who chased him on a bike in Bengaluru early Monday morning. Terming it a case of road rage, police arrest-

ed Vikas Kumar, who works as a team head at a software company's call centre.

Both parties have attacked each other, and some videos purportedly show the IAF officer roughing up Vikas Kumar, creating a scene for the onlookers.

The officer was captured engaging in an argument with Kumar and beating him up in full public view, even as his wife tried to stop him.

Home Minister G Parameshwara said an FIR has been registered against the IAF officer based on the complaint by a call centre employee, but he has gone to West Bengal.

"A case has been taken. Investigation will be done,

and he will be secured," he told reporters here.

Speaking to reporters, Bengaluru City Police Commissioner, B Dayanand said, "Police are investigating both the cases. We will come to a conclusion based on the eyewitness accounts, CCTV footage, and other materials."

"The initial information shows that it was an altercation between a bike rider and the officer. The details will be revealed after the investigation. Let us not jump into conclusions," he added.

The incident occurred while the officer was on his way to the airport with his wife, who is also an Indian Air Force (IAF) officer.
