Borim villagers secure 50% relief in house tax hike

PONDA: In a significant win for residents, the Borim villagers have successfully passed a gram sabha resolution to slash the house tax hike by 50 per cent, bringing long-awaited relief after two years of protests and demands.

The original hike, implemented following a government circular urging Panchayats to revise tax rates,

saw the Borim Panchayat raising house tax by Rs 28 per square metre for RCC structures. The hike had triggered strong opposition from villagers and even dissent among some Panchayat members who agreed that the increase was excessive.

On Sunday, the Borim Gram Sabha voted to reduce the hike by half. Sarpanch Jayesh Naik confirmed that the tax on RCC structures will now be Rs 14 per square metre, with corresponding reductions for laterite and mud houses.

Meanwhile, neighbouring villages under Bethora-Nirankal-Consheim-Codar Panchayat are rallying for a similar rollback. Villagers have called for mass participation in the upcoming gram sabha on Sunday, April 27, to demand a resolution reducing the Rs 20 per square metre house tax hike implemented last year.

Bhoma villagers warn of boycott if leader barred from CM's meet

Locals wary of authorities, demand transparency in decision-making process

PONDA: Tensions continue to simmer in Bhoma as locals remain firm in their demand for a bypass instead of a flyover under the proposed National Highway (NH) expansion project. Villagers have now issued a stern warning to the administration: if their leader Sanjay Naik is not allowed to participate in discussions with Chief Minister Pramod Sawant, no villager will attend the meeting.

The warning comes after PWD NH engineers carried out onsite land demarcation for the flyover at Bhoma, following directions from the Chief Minister. However, villagers have expressed dissatisfaction with the explanations provided by offi-

cials and remain unconvinced about the necessity of the proposed land acquisition.

NH EXPANSION

Local resident Putu Gaudé stated that Sanjay Naik, who has been at the forefront of the agitation for several years, is best equipped to represent the villagers' concerns. "He has filed petitions, studied the NH expansion documents, and understands the technicalities and is our resource person," Gaudé said.

Villagers alleged that Naik was deliberately excluded from the recent high-level meeting at the Secretariat, where plans for the flyover were presented. "There were calls from

the administration instructing us not to bring Sanjay Naik to the discussion," claimed a resident.

Although CM Sawant has expressed willingness to hold another round of talks, the villagers have made it clear: "No Sanjay Naik, no meeting."

"If a 25-metre flyover is being proposed, why is such a vast area being acquired? We need answers, and only our leader can raise the right questions. If he's not included, we will not engage," said Gaudé.

The standoff underscores the growing distrust between locals and authorities over the NH expansion plan, with the villagers demanding full transparency and meaningful participation in the decision-making process.

GSEC directed to hear plea against 11 Agassaim panchas

PANJIM: The High Court of Bombay at Goa has directed the Goa State Election Commission (GSEC) to adjudicate on the disqualification petition filed against 11 members of the St. Lawrence (Agassaim) Village Panchayat on its merits, and to dispose of the matter as expeditiously as possible, petitioner's counsel Adv Hrudaynath Shirodkar has informed.

The Court's directive comes in the wake of the GSEC earlier dismissing a related disqualification petition, citing a lack of jurisdiction.

Adv Shirodkar said that he had approached the GSEC on behalf of petitioner Hilario Pereira, a former panchayat member, seeking the disqualification of 11 panchayat members on grounds of having allegedly indulged in peculiar benefits. However, the GSEC rejected the petition, stating it had no jurisdiction to adjudicate such matters.

The petition had sought the dismissal of the panchayat members under Section 10(F) and Section 11 of the Goa Panchayati Raj Act.

When the writ petition came up for hearing before the division bench, Adv Shirodkar argued that the GSEC had illegally dismissed the petition on jurisdictional grounds. He submitted before the Court that it is only the GSEC that is legally empowered to hear such matters under Section 10(F) and to pass orders under Section 11 of the Goa Panchayati Raj Act.

Following the submissions, Adv Shirodkar stated that the Court upheld his contention and remanded the matter back to the GSEC with clear instructions to adjudicate it on merits and without undue delay.

"Though there is no specific time frame given, we will pursue the matter expeditiously to ensure it is heard and a decision is given at the earliest," Adv Shirodkar added.

FDA seizes chemically ripened bananas in Mapusa raid

PANJIM: A Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) team conducted a special raid at Mapusa, seizing bananas that were being chemically treated using a banned ripening agent.

In a post on social media, Health Minister Vishwajit Rane stated that surveillance checks at the Mapusa Yard had continued, during which samples of a suspected ripening liquid collected earlier tested positive for Ethaphone.

"Acting on these findings, an FDA team comprising Richard Noronha, Rajaram Patil, Amit Mandrekar, and Lenin De Sa conducted an inspection of the premises belonging to individuals identified as Vasir and Allaudin," Rane said.



"During the inspection, approximately two tonnes of bananas were found to have been treated with the banned ripening agent. In the interest of public health, the entire stock was immediately destroyed. Fresh samples of the fruit were also collected for further laboratory analysis, and a police complaint has been lodged against the vendors involved," he added.

South Goa to host State-level cyclone mock exercise on Apr 25

PANJIM: The South Goa District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), in co-ordination with the State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA), Goa, and in collaboration with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), will conduct a State Level Mock Exercise on Cyclone and Induced Disaster on April 25. The exercise will take place from 8 am to 3 pm.

The designated locations for the mock exercise across South Goa District include: Mormugao Port Authority (within MPA

premises); Goa Shipyard; Vaddem Ground (outside GSL premises); IOCL and HP Terminal (within IOCL Terminal); Baina Beach area; Baina Beach; Chowgule Shipyard; Office of the Mamlatdar of Ponda taluka; Murdi Bagh, Khandepar, Ponda; Naquerim Betul Panchayat (New) and Office of the Talathi, VP Naquerim-Betul.

The exercise will simulate evacuation procedures and the activation of early warning systems to assess the effectiveness of communication mechanisms during a disaster event. Members of the public are advised to remain calm and not to panic during the conduct of the exercise.

Goa schools directed to track students' academic progress

PANJIM: In a move aimed at enhancing the academic and vocational trajectory of students, the Directorate of Education has instructed all government and aided secondary and higher secondary schools in Goa to track and maintain records of students' academic pursuits after they complete Std X and Std XII. The directive will ensure that the educational progress of students is systematically monitored and is available for inspection by official review teams.

The initiative is part of a broader effort to better understand and support students' educational journeys, facilitating improved planning for future academic and career options.

Additionally, as part of the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the Education Department

has mandated that schools arrange visits for Std IX and X students to nearby Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

The policy aims to integrate vocational education into mainstream schooling, starting with hands-on exposure at the middle and secondary school levels. It also stipulates that each student should learn at least one vocational or technical skill and be introduced to various others. This approach is in line with NEP's goal to enhance students' readiness for personal and professional growth.

The circular further instructed school heads to ensure that teachers and students in Std IX and X visit their nearest ITIs to gain insight into skill education. Schools have also been directed to maintain records of the academic activities students pursue after completing their secondary and higher secondary education.
