Flesh trade racket operating from spa busted in Thane

THANE: The Anti-Human Trafficking Cell (AHTC) of the Thane city crime branch has busted a sex racket operating under the guise of a spa on Ghodbunder Road in Kasarwadavli area and arrested three persons, an official said. Acting on a tip-off and complaint, police raided 'Wellness and Spa' on Thursday, said Sailesh Salvi, a police spokesperson. The AHTC team rescued seven women and shifted them to a rescue home for rehabilitation while arresting two women and a man. An FIR was registered against the arrested trio under section 143 (trafficking of persons) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and sections of the Prevention of Immoral Trafficking Act (PITA) with Kasarwadavli police station. The police did not disclose the identities of the arrested persons.

NEHU student leader, accomplices attack Hindi professor in Shillong

SHILLONG: A Hindi teacher at the North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) here sustained minor injuries after a student leader and his accomplices allegedly locked him inside his office chamber and attacked him with scissors, police said on Friday. The incident took place on Thursday evening when Professor Alok Singh was in his office, and the NEHU student leader and his accomplices attacked him, they added. East Khasi Hills district SP said police have received an FIR filed by the teacher in this regard and a case will be filed. He said that during the incident, the students physically assaulted him and threatened to kill him by holding a scissor to his neck. The teacher urged police to take action and ensure his safety on the university campus. The attack was condemned by the varsity teachers.

Ambedkar's statue damaged in UP

SULTANPUR (UP): A statue of Bhimrao Ambedkar was damaged here in the Motigarpur area, police said on Friday. "The miscreants broke the fingers of the statue and damaged its shoulder on Thursday night," said Vijay Singh, station house officer (SHO), Motigarpur Police Station. The statue, erected in 1990, is situated on the banks of canal Sharda Sahayak Khand-16. Upon receiving news of the vandalism on Friday morning, Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) workers gathered at the site to protest. A police team arrived at the scene and assured the protesters that a case would be registered against the culprits. The SHO said that a case has been registered based on the complaint filed by Sugriv Buddh, and an investigation is currently underway.

4.5 kg RDX, weapons recovered in Amritsar

CHANDIGARH: A cache of arms and explosives, including 4.5 kg of RDX, was recovered by Punjab Police and Border Security Force (BSF) from a village in Amritsar on Friday, officials said. The recovery was made during a search operation. Two packets were recovered from a field in Amritsar's Sahawal village during the search operation conducted by Punjab Police and BSF. Upon opening these packets, four 9 mm pistols, five hand grenades, eight magazines, 220 rounds, two remote controls and a battery charger were found, a police official said. The security forces also recovered 4.50 kg of RDX, the official said.

Two killed, four injured in tempo-car collision in UP's Budaun

BUDAUN (UP): Two people, including a minor, were killed and four injured in a head-on collision between a tempo and a car here on Friday, police said. The incident occurred on the Bareilly-Dataganj road near Brahmpur village. The tempo was headed to Bareilly. "The tempo carrying a family collided with the oncoming car. The impact caused both vehicles to overturn," Dataganj police station in-charge Gaurav Bishnoi said. He said the tempo was carrying Janardan Singh (44), a resident of Chutmuri village in Dataganj tehsil, along with his wife Preeti, his sister-in-law Shivani, and Shivani's daughters Santosh (12) and Lado (3).

Three college students drown at Aliyar reservoir during trip

COIMBATORE (TAMIL NADU): Three college students drowned near the popular Aliyar reservoir on Friday, turning a fun trip into a tragedy. The victims, aged 21, 19, and 21, were recovered, and their families have been notified, police said. According to the police, 29 physiotherapy students from a college in Chennai had arrived to visit the popular tourist spots in Aliyar and Valparai. "This morning, at around 9 am, the students were visiting the nearby Aliyar reservoir. One of the boys, while bathing, fell into a deep area near a bridge," police told PTI.

# Amarnath yatra will not be affected by Pahalgam attack: J&K Deputy CM

PTI, SRINAGAR: The Pahalgam terror attack will not affect the annual Amarnath pilgrimage which passes through the south Kashmir tourist resort, Deputy Chief Minister Surinder Choudhary said on Friday. Pahalgam is one of the key base camps for the annual Amarnath yatra and falls on the traditional 43-km route leading to the 3,880 metre high cave shrine in south Kashmir Himalayas. "Amarnath yatra is a religious event. Those who want to come for Amarnath yatra will come of their own will. Some people go to Kedarnath and some do not go because there is snow... The yatra shall not be affected just because of

the Pahalgam terror attack," Choudhary told PTI Videos in an interview. Terrorists struck at a prime tourist location in Pahalgam in south Kashmir on Tuesday, killing at least 26 people, mostly tourists, and injuring several others. The Jammu and

Kashmir deputy chief minister said while the Pahalgam terror attack was a big incident, it cannot shake the foundations of rich culture and tradition in Jammu and Kashmir. "Kashmiris will themselves facilitate the yatra as they have been doing over the years.

I understand that innocent (tourists) have lost their lives but we cannot forget that there are people like Adil, a horse owner, who lost his life while saving the tourists. Jammu Kashmir has a rich culture," Choudhary said. "This act of terror in Pahalgam, though

it was big, cannot shake the foundations of brotherhood in Jammu and Kashmir," he said. The annual Amarnath yatra is scheduled to commence on July 3 and culminate on August 9 this year. On the fallout of the Pahalgam attack on tourism in Kashmir, Choudhary said, "We did not want the tourists to leave in the aftermath of the Pahalgam attack. We wanted the tourists to complete their tour which they had planned. "However, we have provided all possible assistance to the tourists who wanted to return. At the same time we have asked people to tell their governments to ensure the safety of people of

Jammu and Kashmir who are studying or working in their states because an ordinary Kashmiri has no role in these incidents," he said. On the role of Pakistan in terror activities in Jammu and Kashmir, the deputy chief minister said Islamabad will have to introspect why fingers are always pointed at it whenever anything goes wrong.

## Over 1,100 stranded tourists evacuated in landslide-hit Sikkim, 1,800 others await rescue

PTI, GANGTOK: Around 1,100 tourists stranded in north Sikkim's Chungthang town following landslides were evacuated by the authorities on Friday, while 1,800 others are awaiting rescue from two other popular hill stations in Mangan district, officials said. The administration is bringing the evacuated travellers to the state capital Gangtok, around 100 km from Chungthang. Those tourists, who spent Thursday night in a gurdwara, left in about 200 vehicles, officials said. From Chungthang, the vehicles reached Mangan, the district headquarters, via a reconstructed Bailey bridge at Sangkalang which was opened for traffic movement. Officials said that efforts were also on to clear the roads as fast as possible

to evacuate around 1,800 other tourists stuck in Lachen and Lachung. Roads to Lachen and Lachung remained closed due to mudslides caused by heavy rainfall on Thursday evening. Tourists need to travel via Chungthang to reach Lachen and Lachung, hill stations known for their natural beauty and

proximity to popular tourist destinations like Gurudongmar Lake and Yumthang Valley. The district administration has made all necessary arrangements to ensure the well-being of the tourists stranded in Lachen and Lachung. Meanwhile, Sikkim Governor Om Prakash Mathur said that all tourists are

safe in various places in north Sikkim. Chief Minister Prem Singh Tamang has been personally supervising the rescue operations of the stranded tourists, he said. In a related development, the Mangan district administration has announced suspension of all tourist permits for the time being. Permits already issued for travel have been declared invalid, officials said, adding the tour operators have been instructed not to send any tourists northward until further notice. Landslides have occurred at Munshithang on the Lachen-Chungthang road and at Lema/Bob on the Lachung-Chungthang road. The situation was aggravated due to continuous rain in the region.

## Humanity trumps terror: Kashmiri guide saves lives of children of Chhattisgarh tourists



PTI, RAIPUR: Risking his own life, a Kashmiri tourist guide saved the lives of children from a group of tourists from Chhattisgarh when terrorists struck in Pahalgam on Tuesday. Nazakat Ahmad Shah (28) was acting as a guide to a group of 11, four couples and three children, from Manendragarh-Chirmiri-Bharatpur district in Chhattisgarh during their Kashmir trip. Shah's cousin was killed in the attack that claimed the lives of 26 persons, he told PTI over the phone on Thursday. Arvind Agrawal, one of the tourists, posted pictures of him and his daughter with Shah on his social media handle and

wrote, "You saved our lives by risking your own. We will never be able to repay the debt of Nazakat Bhai." As per his Facebook profile, Agrawal is a member of the Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha - a youth wing of the BJP. Besides the Agrawals, the families of Kuldeep Stapak, Shivansh Jain and Happy Wadhwan were part of the group. Shah sold shawls in Chirmiri town of Chhattisgarh in the winter and knew these families. "They reached Jammu on April 17, and I received them and took them to Kashmir in two vehicles. I took them to Srinagar, Gulmarg, Sonmarg, and in the last leg, we decided to visit Pahalgam," he said.

"Pahalgam was to be the last venue as my village is close by, and I wanted to host them because Kashmiris have a passion for hospitality," Shah said. "We reached Baisran
