Over 1,000 illegal Bangladeshi immigrants detained in Ahmedabad, Surat

PTI, AHMEDABAD: More than 1,000 illegal Bangladeshi immigrants, including women and children, were detained following combing operations in Ahmedabad and Surat, and efforts were underway for their deportation, Minister of State for Home Harsh Sanghavi said on Saturday.

At least 890 Bangladeshis were detained in Ahmedabad and 134 in Surat, in what the minister termed as the biggest operation of its kind by the Gujarat police to date.

Sanghavi warned illegal immigrants residing in Gujarat to surrender before the police on their own accord, or else they will be nabbed and deported.

He also warned of legal action against people providing shelter to illegal immigrants.

"A historic success has been achieved in nabbing illegal Bangladeshis. As many as 890 illegal immigrants were caught by the Ahmedabad police and 134 by the Surat police. This is the biggest operation of the Gujarat Police against people living illegally in the state," Sanghavi told reporters in Surat after chairing a

DELHI HOME MINISTER SEEKS PUBLIC HELP TO TRACK OVERSTAYING PAKISTANIS

PTI, NEW DELHI: Delhi Home Minister Ashish Sood on Saturday appealed to people to help identify Pakistani nationals overstaying in the national capital, and inform the nearest police station immediately, a statement said.

India on Thursday announced revoking all visas (except Long Term Visas and Diplomatic and Official visas) issued to Pakistani nationals from April 27 as tensions between the two countries escalated over the Pahalgam terror attack that killed 26 people, mostly tourists, on April 22. Deadlines from April 26 to April 29 to exit India have also been prescribed for Pakistani nationals in this regard and henceforth no new visas would be issued to them, the statement read.

FOUR PERSONS LINKED TO TERRORIST ORGANISATIONS HELD IN JHARKHAND

PTI, RANCHI: Four persons allegedly linked to several terrorist organisations were arrested by Jharkhand Anti-Terrorist Squad (ATS) from Dhanbad district on Saturday, an official said.

Two pistols, 12 cartridges, several electronic devices such as mobile phones, laptops, besides a large number of documents, and books related to banned organisations have been seized, he said.

"A criminal case has been registered at ATS, Ranchi, in this regard and further investigation is underway," according to an ATS statement. Jharkhand ATS received a tip-off that some individuals associated with HuT (Hizb ut-Tahrir), AQIS (Al-Qaeda in Indian Subcontinent), ISIS, and other banned terrorist organisations are connecting youths in the state to their network, misleading them through social media and other means and promoting religious extremism while carrying out anti-national activities, it stated.

"Many of these people are involved with drug cartels, human trafficking, and as we saw how two out of the four Bangladeshis arrested recently worked in sleeper cells of Al Qaeda. A probe will be conducted into the background of these Bangladeshis and their activities in Gujarat."

He said arrangements were made "to complete all the procedures for their deportation as soon as possible."

"We will also investigate

fake documents they used to reach different parts of the country and Gujarat, and action will be taken against those who created the fake documents," he added.

Sanghavi said the police have been instructed to take action against illegal immigrants across Gujarat, and a clear order has been given to Pakistani nationals to leave Gujarat as per the decision taken at the meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Security.

As police launch verification drive, Pakistani Hindu refugees anxious about their status

PTI, NEW DELHI: Pakistani Hindu refugees staying at Delhi's Majnu Ka Tila are anxious about their status due to inadequate information even though the government has clarified that Long Term Visas (LTVs) already granted to Hindu Pakistani nationals will remain valid. Delhi Police officials said that a verification drive has been launched but they will ensure that no one is harassed unnecessarily.

India announced on Thursday that all visas issued to Pakistani nationals would be revoked from April 27 and asked these people to leave the country as tensions between the two countries escalated after the barbaric terror attack in Jammu and Kashmir's Pahalgam left 26 people, mostly tourists, dead.

While the government later clarified that LTVs already granted to Hindu Pakistani nationals will remain valid, many refugees say they are worried about their fate as their visas are renewed every two years.

According to the official document of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs, the Long Term Visa is extended every two years.

While many Pakistani Hindus living in Majnu-ka-Tilla have got Indian Citizenship under the under the Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019, there are also several others whose applications are still pending for the same.

Sona Das, president of the Hindu refugee community at Majnu Ka Tila, said several families have been living in Delhi for years, renewing

their visas periodically after document verification by authorities.

"Also, many of these families crossed over from Pakistan just one or two months ago, some are living in camps near Majnu Ka Tila, while others have taken shelter under the Signature Bridge," Das told PTI.

"Many people have already got their visas extended. However, I am not sure whether these visas are called long-term visas or not," he added.

DRG jawan injured in IED blast on day 6 of anti-Naxal operation along Chhattisgarh-Telangana border

PTI, RAIPUR: A District Reserve Guard (DRG) jawan was injured on Saturday when a pressure-improvised explosive device (IED) planted by Naxalites went off in Chhattisgarh's Bijapur district where a massive operation against Maoists was underway for the last six days.

The operation involving about 10,000 security personnel in a hilly region Karregutta, Durgamgutta and Pujarikanker along the Chhattisgarh-Telangana border was launched on Monday, a senior official said.

A DRG jawan sustained a minor injury when a pressure IED exploded this morning, he said.

"The injured jawan was

administered treatment at a camp of security forces and his condition was stated to be out of danger. He would be in a position for active duty very soon," the official said.

Another jawan belonging to the Special Task Force (STF) had sustained a minor sprain on ankle due to impact of an IED blast on April 24 morning during the operation, he said, adding that his condition was normal and he has recovered.

Talking to reporters here, Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai said, "Our security forces have been bravely and strongly fighting against Naxalites. Security forces have been carrying out a major operation against

Naxalites on a hill along the Telangana-Chhattisgarh border, braving over 40 degrees Celsius in scorching summer."

Union Home Minister Amit Shah has resolved to eliminate Naxalism by

March 31, 2026 and the target will be achieved, he said.

The operation, one of biggest counter-insurgency actions launched in the Bastar region, involves personnel of dif-

ferent units, including the DRG, Bastar Fighters and STF of the Chhattisgarh police, the Central Reserve Police Force and its elite Commando Battalions for Resolute Action (CoBRA).

It is believed that some 500 cadres of the banned CPI (Maoist), including its top leaders, are holed up in the area, and Telangana Police are assisting in the exercise, said the official who is monitoring the action on the ground.

On Thursday, three women Naxalites were killed on Karregutta hills, and a huge cache of weapons, explosives and other materials was recovered during the operation.

Over 80 families relocated after cloudburst triggered floods in J&K

PTI, RAMBAN (J&K): Nearly 80 families were relocated and are being provided with assistance following the recent cloudburst-triggered flash floods that claimed the lives of three persons in this district of Jammu and Kashmir, a senior government official said on Saturday.

Ramban Deputy Commissioner (DC) Baseer ul Haq Chaudhary said over 80,000 kanals of agricultural land and 544 structures, including schools, also suffered damage in the district due to the natural calamity on April 20.

Chaudhary was briefing a meeting chaired by Chief Minister Omar Abdullah, who reviewed relief and restoration efforts during his third visit to Ramban.

Besides the loss of three precious human lives, the deputy commissioner said over 1,000 livestock also perished, while 11 key locations along the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway were severely affected by multiple landslides triggered by heavy rains in the district.

"A total of 93 vehicles were recovered, and 496 structures sustained damage. Of the 27 Jal Shakti department schemes affected, nine have been partially restored. Approximately 80,498 kanals of agricultural land and 46 schools also suffered damage," the officer said.

He said the district administration has established control rooms and camp offices near affected sites and set up multiple relocation centres equipped with basic amenities.
