India warns Pakistan against unprovoked ceasefire violations along Line of Control in J&K

PTI, NEW DELHI: India has warned Pakistan against its unprovoked firings along the Line of Control (LoC) in Jammu and Kashmir as the directors general of military operations of the two armies spoke on the hotline amid the escalating tensions over the Pahalgam terror attack.

Pakistan has been resorting to firings on the Indian side of the LoC since Friday night in violation of a ceasefire understanding and the Indian Army responded to them "appropriately", according to military sources.

The directors general of military operations (DG-MOs) held the conversation on Tuesday. It came as India mulls its options to respond to the April 22 Pahalgam terror attack that killed 26 people.

The Pakistan military has been warned against the unprovoked firings, people familiar with the DGMO talks said. The sources, however, described the exchanges over the hotline as "routine", saying it was a weekly conversation between the DGMOs that is held every Tuesday.

786 PAKISTANIS EXIT INDIA; 1,465 INDIANS RETURN HOME FROM PAKISTAN AFTER VISA CANCELLATION

PTI, NEW DELHI: As many as 786 Pakistani nationals, including 55 diplomats, their dependents and support staff, besides eight Indians with Pakistani visa, have left India through the Attari-Wagah border crossing in the last six days following a government order in the wake of the Pahalgam terror attack, officials said. A total of 1,465 Indians, including 25 diplomats and officials, besides 151 Pakiinternational border crossing

Maharashtra man claims terror suspect spoke to him day before Pahalgam attack

PTI. IALNA: A young man from Jalna city in Maharashtra, who recently returned from Kashmir, has claimed that one of the suspected attackers in the Pahalgam terror case spoke to him a day before the carnage.

"Hindu ho kya. You don't look like you are Kashmir," said Adarsh Raut, recalling his south Kashmir's Anantnag interaction with a man at a food stall in the Baisaran Valley on April 21.

Twenty-six people, mostly tourists, were killed and several were injured when terrorists opened fire at a meadow near the popular tourist town of Pahalgam in district on April 22.

Days after the massacre of tourists, security agencies released sketches of three suspected attackers, and one of them matched the person who had spoken to him, Raut told the media on Tuesday.

Endangered Red-Crowned Roofed Turtle makes Ganga home again after 3 decades

PTI, NEW DELHI: The critically endangered Red-Crowned Roofed Turtle has been reintroduced in the Ganga river as part of the government's flagship programme of cleaning the river and enhancing its biodiversity.

In a post on X on Wednesday, Union Jal Shakti Minister C R Paatil said, 20 such turtles were released in Uttar Pradesh's Haiderpur Wetland On April 26.
