US hopes Pak cooperates with India to find terrorists: VP Vance

PTI. NEW YORK: Vice President ID Vance has said that US hopes that India will respond to the Pahalgam terrorist attack in a way that does not lead to a "broader regional conflict" and expects Pakistan to "cooperate" with New Delhi to "hunt down" militants sometimes operating from their soil.

Vance made these remarks on Thursday in an interview with Fox News. Vance and his family were in India on a four-day visit when the attack - the worst since the Pulwama strike in 2019 - took place.

"Our hope here is that India responds to this terrorist attack in a way that doesn't lead to a broader regional conflict," Vance

Remarks by Vance assume significance amid rising tensions between India and Pakistan in the aftermath of the Pahalgam attack, in which 26 people were killed.

Vance, who was in India last month, had then condemned the attack and expressed solidarity with the victims and their families in

'Right to be heard': Delhi court issues notice to Sonia, Rahul

PTI, NEW DELHI: A Delhi court on Friday issued notices to former Congress president Sonia Gandhi and leader of opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi in the National Herald money laundering case.

Special judge Vishal Gogne said their "right to be heard" was available at the time of cognisance of the chargesheet.

"Right to be heard at any stage breathes life into fair trial," the judge said, posting the matter on May 8. The judge also issued notice

to Congress leader Sam Pitroda and Suman Dubey, and "Young Indian", Dotex Merchandise Pvt Ltd and Sunil Bhandari. The chargesheet was filed under Sections 3 (money laundering) and 4 (punishment for money laundering) of Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

In a 14-page order, the judge observed the "prosecuting agency ED does not come to any detriment if the accused is permitted to make submissions on the question of cognisance". "In this adherence to the

principles of fair hearing, the right to be heard is not inconsistent with any of the powers vested in the ED for investigation or the pre-

sumptions as well as burden of proof stipulated under the PMLA," the order said.

During a brief hearing, additional solicitor general S V Raju, representing the ED, said the probe agency was "not opposing such a notice precisely because it is votary of fair trial". The court further said,

"Besides, the proviso to Section 223 of BNSS (Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita) is a salutary provision in furtherance of the right to be heard, as a part of fair trial. It is designed to protect accused persons against improper implication by permitting them to make submissions prior to the court taking cognisance of the offences in question." The BNSS, the court noted, was therefore a progressive legislation and recorded among its objectives and reasons a "citizens centric

criminal procedure" being the "need of the hour". Section 223 of BNSS

grants an accused the right to be heard on the aspect of cognisance.

This "benevolent intent" of the BNSS should be read in favour of accused persons rather than the investigation agencies when a right to be heard is to be accorded at any stage of the proceedings, the court added.

"To summarise, the court finds that notice is required to be issued to the proposed accused persons for hearing on the question of cognisance upon the present complaint in terms of the proviso to section 223 BNSS. It is thus directed that notice be issued to the proposed accused persons in order that they may be heard on the question of cognisance upon the present complaint," the



Delhi HC orders CBI probe into Tihar jail extortion racket

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court on Friday ordered the CBI to conduct a preliminary inquiry over allegations of an extortion racket being run inside Tihar Jail involving its offi-

A bench of Chief Justice

D K Upadhyaya and Justice Tushar Rao Gedela directed the principal secretary, Home Department, Delhi government to hold a fact-finding inquiry and


tain facilities," the court observed. The bench said a report of the inspecting judge, Central Jail 8 and Semi Open Prison, tendered to it in a sealed cover after a "thorough" inquiry, revealed "very disturbing facts" indicating criminal activities and irregularities in functioning of Tihar Jail.


"For thoroughly conducting an inquiry into the matter, since the report (of inspecting judge) contained allegations of criminal activities, we deem it appropriate to require the CBI to conduct a preliminary enquiry into the matter," the court ordered.

The bench went on, "We also deem it appropriate to direct principal secretary, Home, GNCTD to conduct an administrative inquiry to find out the officials/officers/authorities responsible for such administrative lapses and mishappenings in jail." The director general (DG) Delhi prisons should extend all cooperation to the principal secretary, it added.

The court asked the CBI and the principal secretary to submit their reports before the next hearing on August 11.

The court was hearing a petition filed by a former inmate alleging extortion and pointing out safety and security of prisoners inside Tihar.
