Two years of Manipur conflict: Thousands wait to return home



PTI, IMPHAL: From running a successful business to no income and three children to support, G Kipgen is waiting to return to his home in Imphal amidst a sense of despair. But he is not alone, there are many like him.

The devastating impact of the ethnic conflict that rocked Manipur two years ago is still being felt, with thousands of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) continuing to live in overcrowded camps - waiting and hoping to return to their homes amidst fragile peace.

"I used to run a successful coaching institute in Imphal. It's all gone now. With no source of income and three children, I am worried about their future. I can't focus on anything. What is even more concerning is that there is no sign of how things will get better," an emotional Kipgen said.

Over 260 people have been killed, 1,500 injured, and over 70,000 people displaced after the ethnic violence broke out between the Meitei and the Kuki-Zo people on May 3, 2023.

Despite the sacking of controversial Chief Minister N Biren Singh for "not being

SHUTDOWN AFFECTS LIFE AS MANIPUR MOURNS THOSE KILLED IN ETHNIC VIOLENCE

PTI, IMPHAL: Shutdown called by various groups on Saturday to mark two years of the ethnic strife in Manipur affected normal lives in both the Meitei-controlled Imphal Valley and the Kuki-dominated hill districts. Meitei group Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity (COCOMI) called a shutdown in the valley districts, while the Zomi Students Federation (ZSF) and the Kuki Students Organisation (KSO) have imposed the shutdown in the hill districts. It was on this day in 2023 that ethnic clashes broke out between the Meiteis and Kukis, which left over 260 people killed, 1,500 injured, and over 70,000 people displaced, according to officials. Markets were shut, public vehicles remained off the roads, and private offices remained closed across the state. A few private vehicles were seen on the roads in the morning. Schools, colleges and other institutes were also shut. Security forces have also been deployed at key locations to prevent any unwanted activities.

CONGRESS SEEKS FRESH ELECTIONS

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Congress on Saturday demanded fresh elections in Manipur and alleged the ground situation in the strife-torn state was far from normal despite the imposition of President's rule. Addressing a press conference at the AICC headquarters, the Congress' Manipur in-charge Saptagiri Ulaka noted two years had passed since the violence first erupted. "It has been one of the gravest humanitarian crises in India. People fear that this violence was manufactured and two years have now gone by. More than 260 people have been killed, 1,500 injured and over 70,000 displaced since ethnic violence broke out. We had been demanding imposition of President's rule to control the situation but it was only imposed after 20 months. The violence in the state is not ending. President's rule was imposed in Manipur on February 13 and the assembly put under suspended animation, days after N Biren Singh resigned as chief minister. He vowed that the Congress would continue to fight for the rights of Manipur till normality was returned and justice done.

The IDPs, whether Meitei or Kuki, have voiced deep insecurity about their families' future and are grappling with severe psychological distress.

Many remain unable to comprehend how they suddenly became victims of hate and anger.

The government and NGOs imparted skill training to IDPs to make them employable, but these initiatives have done little to ease their emotional burden.

Abenao Devi, living in a prefabricated home in Imphal, said, "In the first few months after the violence broke out, there was significant community support, and provisions arrived on time. But gradually, we've been forgotten. Often, we have to depend on the mercy of others for basic needs. It is humiliating."

The IDPs are doing odd jobs they never imagined doing before, she said adding both the central and state governments are unable to curb hostilities and restore normalcy even after two years.

A central security agency official claimed: "The most problematic and worrisome aspect of this two-year-long conflict is that armed groups and their associates have taken control of the respective communities. They are pushing their agenda ignoring the suffering of ordinary people, particularly the IDPs."

He added, "There has also been a massive rise in extortion by armed outfits in the Imphal valley and illegal taxation along highways passing through Kuki-majority areas. Several previously defunct militant outfits have been re-activated, recruiting mostly unemployed, poorly educated youth."

Naxalite with Rs 8 lakh bounty killed in Chhattisgarh

PTI, GARIABAND: A hardcore Naxalite carrying a reward of Rs 8 lakh on his head was killed in an encounter with security forces in Chhattisgarh's Gariaband district, police said.

The gunfight took place on Friday late evening in a forest near Motipani village under Jugad police station limits when a joint team of the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) and E-30, a unit of the district police, was out on an anti-Naxal operation, a senior police official said.

The operation was launched based on inputs about the movement of Naxalites in the area, located over 180 km away from capital Raipur, he said.

NEET probe: NMC cancels admission of 14 students, orders suspension of 26 others

PTI, NEW DELHI: The National Medical Commission (NMC) has directed immediate suspension of 26 MBBS students found complicit in NEET-UG 2024 malpractices and cancelled admission of 14 students for the academic year 2024-25 for resorting to unfair means during the entrance exam, an official source said.

National Eligibility cum Entrance Test, or NEET, is a pan-India exam to be taken by aspirants to get admission into the country's medical colleges.

As part of the ongoing investigations by multiple agencies into the NEET-

UG 2024 paper leak case, the National Testing Agency identified instances of unfair means and debarred 42 candidates for three years-2024,2025, 2026 from taking the NEET-UG.

It also debarred nine candidates for 2025 and 2026 sessions. The candidature of 215 candidates who appeared in the NEET-UG 2024 exam has been put on hold pending an investigation, the source said.

The action against the students has been initiated based on the findings of the Central Bureau of Investigation which is investigating the cases.

"Given the severity of these violations and their potential to undermine the credibility of the medical education system, the National Medical Commission has issued directives to the concerned medical colleges and institutions to immediately suspend the 26 MBBS students found to be complicit," the source said.

The Commission stressed a "zero-tolerance" policy towards academic fraud and said it was committed to taking all measures to uphold integrity, transparency, and accountability in medical admissions.

The directive comes ahead of the NEET-UG 2025 scheduled for May 4.

More children find families as India's adoption landscape shifts

PTI, NEW DELHI: Neeraj's note to his mother was simple yet profound: "I love you Mom because you take me out to play."

Neeraj's words have been the culmination of a journey that began four years earlier, when he was born with a condition called "knock knees" and left at a Child Care Institution just a day old. He was put up for adoption, and for years, families hesitated, often discouraged by his medical condition.

His story was one of waiting - for the right family, waiting to be seen and

chosen. Families came and went, but his diagnosis often led to the end of the conversation. That was until 2021, when a couple saw him not as a problem to be solved, but as "their child."

Since then, Neeraj's life has transformed. His new parents enrolled him in swimming lessons to help with his legs, took him for regular check-ups, and showered him with love. Today, he is thriving, learning to swim, acting in school plays, and mastering parkour. Neeraj's journey is not an isolated one.

In India, there has been a noticeable surge in adoption numbers over the past decade, with their number increasing from 3,677 in 2015-16 to 4,027 in 2018-19. While there was a dip during the COVID-19 pandemic, according to the latest official data, there has been a continued positive trend, with record 4,515 child adoptions in FY 2024-25, the highest since 2015-16.

were adopted by Resident Indian (RI) parents, eight by Non-Resident Indians (NRI), six by Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), and 11 by foreigners.

But even with this progress, the demand for adoption far outpaces the availability of adoptable children.

216 OCIs, and 319 foreign nationals. For relative and stepchild adoptions, 1,934 in-country and 59 inter-country applicants are in the queue.

Contrastingly, only 2,435 children are currently available for adoption nationwide.
