China's Xi Jinping to pay official visit to Russia, alongside Victory Day celebrations

PTI, BEIJING: Chinese President Xi Jinping will visit Russia from May 7-10 to attend the Victory Day Parade in Moscow and hold "strategic communication" with his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin on a series of major international and regional issues, it was announced on Sunday.

This will be Xi's first visit to Russia after Donald Trump took charge of the US Presidency. Xi last visited Russia in October 2024 for the BRICS Summit.

President Xi will pay a State Visit to Russia from May 7 to 10 and attend the celebrations marking the 80th anniversary of the Victory in the Great Patriotic War in Moscow, a spokesperson of the Chinese foreign ministry said in a statement in Beijing on Sunday.

PUTIN SAYS HE HOPES THERE WILL BE NO NEED TO USE NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN UKRAINE

AP, MOSCOW: Russian President Vladimir Putin said in comments broadcast Sunday that the need to use nuclear weapons in Ukraine had not arisen and that he hopes it will not. In a preview of an upcoming interview with Russian state television, published on Telegram, Putin said Russia has the strength and the means to bring the conflict in Ukraine to a "logical conclusion." Responding to a question about Ukrainian strikes on Russian territory, Putin said: "There has been no need to use those (nuclear) weapons ... and I hope they will not be required." "We have enough strength and means to bring what was started in 2022 to a logical conclusion with the outcome Russia requires," he said. Putin signed a revamped version of Russia's nuclear doctrine in November 2024, spelling out the circumstances that allow him to use Moscow's atomic arsenal, the world's largest. That version lowered the bar, giving him that option in response to even a conventional attack backed by a nuclear power.

under new circumstances and on a series of major international and regional issues, the statement said, in an apparent reference to the pressure being mounted

by Trump on Putin to end the Ukraine war and his tariff war against China.

In Moscow, the Kremlin said that the two leaders would sign several

bilateral inter-governmental and inter-departmental documents during Xi's official visit from May 7-10 at the personal invitation of President Putin.

"During the talks, the main issues of further development of relations of comprehensive partnership and strategic interaction, as well as current issues of the international and regional agenda will be discussed," it said.

Russia had invited Prime Minister Narendra Modi for the Victory Day parade, but it was decided that Defence Minister Rajnath Singh would attend the event. However, Singh is also set to skip the Victory Day parade and his deputy Sanjay Seth is likely to represent India at the event.

The move to send the Minister of State for Defence to the May 9 ceremony comes amid increasing tensions between India and Pakistan over the Pahalgam terror attack.

Leaders of 20 countries, including Brazil, Venezuela and Vietnam, are expected in Moscow on May 9 for the Victory Day celebrations, marking the 80th anniversary of the Soviet victory over Germany in World War II.

China, Japan spar over their aircraft flying over disputed islands

PTI, BEIJING: China and Japan on Sunday exchanged diplomatic protests, accusing each other of violating their airspace over the disputed islands in the East China Sea.

Liu Jinsong, Director-General of the Asian Affairs Department of the Chinese Foreign Ministry, on Sunday lodged solemn representations to Yokochi Akira, chief minister of the Embassy of Japan here, regarding Japanese right-wing elements intruding into China's territorial airspace over Diaoyu Dao by piloting a civilian aircraft, the state-run Global Times reported.

Japanese news agency Kyodo quoted Japan's defence ministry as saying that a helicopter from a China Coast Guard ship violated Japanese airspace close to the Senkaku Islands in the East China Sea on Saturday, making it the fourth airspace intrusion by Beijing.

The helicopter took off from one of the four Chinese coast guard ships that entered Japan's territorial waters around the Senkaku.

TREMORS OF TRAGEDY FELT AT STAMPEDE SPOT LAST YEAR TOO

It is also looking into reports that a fight between two groups of devotees triggered the stampede, he said.

Despite the lanes leading to the temple being narrow, the temple committee had allowed shops to be set up on the route, adding to congestion, the official said.

Meanwhile, rituals were held at the Sree Lairai Devi temple as hundreds of devotees arrived on foot despite the temple committee appealing to them to stay away.

Devotees walked at least two km to take part in a ritual where the goddess (her idol) 'visits' the houses of local residents.

The ritual follows a day after the 'homkhand' rite during which devotees walk on the embers of a big fire lit in the temple grounds.

Dinanath Gaonkar, president of the temple committee, said, "It was not possible to cancel the ritual. The incident on Saturday was unfortunate. Lives were lost. But we cannot stop the rituals. The temple committee had made an appeal to devotees to avoid visiting the village. The police have also placed barricades in Assonora to stop vehicles from entering the area."

Yet, many were seen walking to the village on Sunday. Stalls set up in the lanes around the temple too remained open.

A local resident said, "You cannot stop people from attending the festival, as Devi Lairai is a revered deity with devotees across Goa, Maharashtra and Karnataka."

It may be recalled that in the wee hours of Saturday, a stampede broke out as thousands of devotees thronged the narrow lanes leading up to the temple. While six persons died, about 70 were injured.

The fact-finding committee on Saturday commenced its inquiry into the Shirgao stampede.

The committee started its work by visiting the site on Saturday.

Jacques said, "We are doing our homework. It is going to take a couple of days. We went to the site and saw what could be the probable reasons for the incident. We also met the temple committee members as well. The inquiry will go for a couple of days."

When asked whether the report will be completed and submitted by Sunday, Jacques said, "We are working on it because a lot of enquiries need to be done. The inquiry is still in the preliminary stage and we are doing our homework."

A 20-year-old student of BITS Pilani's Zuarinagar campus in Goa, Krishna Kaseera from Lucknow, was found dead by suicide last week. This was the second such incident at the BITS Pilani Goa campus in the past three months. On March 5, 2025, 20-year-old student Atharva Desai was found dead in his hostel room.

SPACEX LAUNCH SITE APPROVED AS NEW CITY OF STARBASE

The billionaire's popularity has diminished since he became the chain-saw-wielding public face of President Donald Trump's federal job and spending cuts, and profits at his Tesla car company have plummeted.

SpaceX has generally drawn widespread support from local officials for its jobs and investment in the area.

But the creation of an official company town has also drawn critics who worry it will expand Musk's personal control over the area, with potential authority to close a popular beach and state park for launches.

Companion efforts to the city vote include bills in the state Legislature to shift that authority from the county to the new town's mayor and city council.

All these measures come as SpaceX is asking federal authorities for permission to increase the number of South Texas launches from five to 25 a year.

The city at the southern tip of Texas near the Mexico border is only about 3.9 square kilometres, crisscrossed by a few roads and dappled with airstream trailers and modest mid century homes. SpaceX officials have said little about exactly why they want a company town and did not respond to emailed requests for comment.

"We need the ability to grow Starbase as a community," Starbase General Manager Kathryn Lueders wrote to local officials in 2024 with the request to get the city issue on the ballot.

The letter said the company already manages roads and utilities, as well as "the provisions of schooling and medical care" for those living on the property.

SpaceX officials have told lawmakers that granting the city authority to close the beach would streamline launch operations. SpaceX rocket launches and engine tests, and even just moving certain equipment around the launch base requires the closure of a local highway and access to Boca Chica State Park and Boca Chica Beach.

Critics say beach closure authority should stay with the county government, which represents a broader population that uses the beach and park. Cameron County Judge Eddie Trevino, Jr has said the county has worked well with SpaceX and there is no need for change.

IT GLITTERS, BUT MAJORITY OF INFLUENCERS NOT STRIKING GOLD IN INDIA

Revenue remains heavily skewed towards top-tier creators who land brand sponsorships and attract high ad earnings. In India, ad revenues typically range between Rs 50-Rs 200 per 1,000 views — meaning even 1 lakh views might earn as little as Rs 5,500.

Despite these challenges, creators play a powerful role in shaping consumer behaviour. They currently influence over 30% of all consumer spending — an estimated \$350-400 billion — yet direct monetisation for creators generates just \$20-25 billion in value. This figure is projected to grow fivefold by 2030 as new monetisation models mature.

The report categorises creators into six distinct groups based on their influence and audience dynamics. Among them, 'Trust Ambassadors' — nano influencers with 10,000-50,000 followers — command strong engagement and are increasingly favoured by brands for their authenticity. Other key segments include niche experts, inquisitive conversationalists, hype-driving icons, mass reach disseminators, and elite trendsetters who reinforce brand loyalty through consistent messaging.

Encouragingly, brands are taking note. Currently, 10-20% of marketing budgets are allocated to influencer partnerships, and nearly 70% of companies plan to increase these spends significantly in the next 2-3 years.

However, future growth hinges on embracing under-explored monetisation avenues. Models such as virtual gifting, subscriptions, live commerce, and affiliate marketing are gradually gaining traction. Regional platforms, particularly in Tier 2 and 3 cities, are leading adoption in categories like entertainment, spirituality, and self-help — where audiences actively engage through microtransactions and live tipping.
