43 arrested for 'defending Pak' post Pahalgam attack: Assam CM

PAKISTANI INTRUDER ARRESTED ALONG LOC IN J-K'S POONCH

PTI, JAMMU: A 26-year-old Pakistani intruder was arrested along the Line of Control in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch district on Tuesday, officials said. The arrest came amid a diplomatic flare-up between India and Pakistan and almost daily ceasefire violations on the borders in the aftermath of the Pahalgam terror attack in which 26 people, mostly tourists, were killed. Waqas, a resident of Tarkhal village in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK), was taken into custody by alert army personnel from a forward village in the Chakan-Da-Bagh area shortly after he crossed the Line of Control (LoC) and entered Indian territory, the officials said. Preliminary questioning revealed that Waqas had inadvertently crossed the LoC from his village on the other side, they said. No incriminating material was recovered from the intruder at the time of his arrest, they added.

the NSA (National Security Act) will be clamped on certain people who have been arrested, but not on all. Some have already apologised and said that they will not do it again.

There will be categorisation of the arrested persons, as some are habitual offenders, while others did it for publicity, Sarma said. "There is another category with Left leanings, who have done it for political reasons. A committee will

take the decision on whom NSA will be imposed and it is not going to be a political decision," he added.

Earlier, opposition AIUDF MLA Aminul Islam was arrested on sedition charges for allegedly defending Pakistan and its complicity in the Pahalgam attack.

On Friday, Sarma had warned of stringent action against those who raised 'Pakistan Zindabad' slogans in the aftermath of the April 22 attack.

Soldier among four killed after passenger bus falls into gorge in J-K's Poonch

PTI, MENDHAR: Four passengers including a soldier were killed and 44 others injured when a private bus skidded off the road and plunged into a deep gorge in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch district on Tuesday, officials said.

Lt Governor Manoj Sinha and Chief Minister Omar Abdullah expressed their grief over the accident.

Abdullah rushed his cabinet colleague and MLA Mendhar Javed Ahmad Rana to the scene to oversee the relief efforts. The bus was on its way to Mendhar from Ghani village when its driver lost control around 9.20 am and the vehicle rolled down into the gorge, the officials said. Locals immediately launched a rescue operation and were joined by police, Army and CRPF personnel.

The officials identified the deceased as 45-year-old Mohd Majeed, 55-year-old Shakeela Begum and

50-year-old Mohd Haneef of Ghani village and 60-year-old Noor Hussain of Kaslari. Majeed, a soldier posted in Assam, had come to his village on leave.

Hussain and Majeed were found dead on the spot by the rescuers, Begum died on the way to GMC Hospital Rajouri and Haneef succumbed during treatment at GMC Rajouri, they said, adding

the condition of seven more injured persons was stated to be "critical".

PTI, GUWAHATI: One more person has been apprehended in Assam for "defending Pakistan on Indian soil" following the Pahalgam terror attack, taking the total of arrests to 43 so far, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said on Tuesday.

Sarma, in a post on X, said the person was held in Bar-

peta district.

"#Update on crackdown against traitors for defending Pakistan on Indian soil... Total 43 anti-nationals have been put behind BARS for sympathising with Pakistan. No TRAITOR will be SPARED (sic)," he wrote.

Addressing a press conference during the day, the CM said: "(Provisions of

SC seeks FIR details in suicides of IIT student, NEET aspirant

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Tuesday sought to know if FIRs were registered after suicides of a IIT Kharagpur student and a NEET aspirant in Kota, Rajasthan, came to light.

A bench of Justices J B Pardiwala and R Mahadevan directed its registry to call for a report from both places at the earliest.

The top court noted a 22-year-old student studying in IIT, Kharagpur, was found hanging in his hostel room on May 4, 2025.

The deceased was a three-year civil engineering student. His body was found hanging in his room in the Madan Mohan Malaviya Hall. The student was identified as Moham-



mad Asif Qamar from Bihar's Sheohar District," the bench noted.

The top court went on, "The press reporting indicates that just moments before his death, he was on a video call with his friend in Delhi. This is one of those unfortunate suicides by a student for which we have constituted the task-force to work on the various issues relating to students suicide."

The top court previously ordered the formation of a national task force, headed by former top court judge Justice S Ravindra Bhat, to address the mental health concerns of students to prevent suicides in higher educational institutions.

The apex court said it was taking cognisance of the matter with a view to ascertain whether the management or administration of IIT, Kharagpur lodged an FIR with the local police station in accordance with its earlier directions.

It also took into account another case of suicide by a NEET aspirant who hanged herself at her room in Parshwanath area in the city ahead of the National Medical Entrants Examination scheduled on May 11.

TN CM Stalin: 'Opportunistic alliance' will fail in 2026

PTI, CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister and ruling DMK president M K Stalin on Tuesday exuded confidence that his party will once again form the government after the 2026 polls in the state and that the calculations of those who had forged an "opportunistic alliance," will be proven wrong by the people.

In a letter to party men coinciding with the DMK government stepping into its fifth year on May 7, Stalin also exhorted the party workers to actively work for the DMK's victory over the next year.

The party's four-year performance that was marked by a welfare government would ensure

DMK's win, he said.

"Those who had forged an opportunistic alliance and repeatedly betrayed Tamil Nadu, and their discreet allies are desperate to see DMK's defeat. People, with their calculations, will prove them wrong," he said in the letter, without naming anyone.

He called on party workers to reach out to the public, highlight the DMK government's achievements by way of a number of public meetings.

Most of the 505 promises made ahead of the 2021 elections have been implemented and the rest will also be put into effect soon and he "firm" about that, Stalin said.

Will join hands with TN to seek withheld central funds: Kerala Minister

PTI, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Kerala General Education Minister V Sivankutty said on Tuesday that the central government has withheld Rs 1,500.27 crore meant for the state under various centrally sponsored schemes.

Addressing a press conference here, Sivankutty said the Centre has not released the funds because Kerala has not signed the PM SHRI scheme memorandum.

Sivankutty said he had raised the matter with Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan during his recent meeting

with him in New Delhi.

"They told us this verbally, but they are not giving it to us in writing," he said.

Sivankutty said he will meet his Tamil Nadu counterpart soon to team up with the neighbouring state to raise the matter with the Centre.

"We are planning to raise this issue jointly with Tamil Nadu, as they are also facing the same problem," Sivankutty said.

The minister added that the Kerala government is also considering seeking legal options from the advocate general to recover the pending funds.

Indian food for astronaut Shukla during International Space Station stay: ISRO official

PTI, NEW DELHI: Indian astronaut Shubhan-shu Shukla will be able to savour varieties of rice, moong dal halwa and mango nectar during his sojourn to the International Space Station aboard the Axiom Mission 4 scheduled for launch later this month.

Shukla, who will spend 14 days aboard the International Space Station (ISS), will also have the option to choose from a range of international cuisine, as approved for the mission by NASA.

Scientists at the Indian Space Research Organi-



sation (ISRO), along with the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), have developed a range of rice dishes, moong dal halwa and mango nectar, among other items, for

astronauts to savour during space missions.

"Shukla ji will get 'ghar ka khana (home food)' and also have the option to choose from international cuisine, as approved

by NASA," said DK Singh, director of ISRO's Human Space Flight Centre.

ISRO and DRDO have developed food items for astronauts of the Gaganyaan mission and the same is being made available to Shukla with NASA's approval, he said.

Axiom Space last month shared a video of Axiom Mission 4 crew members sampling multiple food options available aboard the ISS.

In the video, Shukla could be seen sampling a variety of dishes, rating each based on taste and

preference. These meals will later be packed and sent to the space station for the Axiom Mission 4 astronauts to consume during their 14-day mission.

The Axiom Mission 4 will have veteran astronaut Peggy Whitson as commander, Shukla as mission pilot, and Polish astronaut Sawosz Uznanski-Wisniewski and Hungarian astronaut Tibor Kapu as mission specialists.

Axiom Space has announced the Axiom Mission 4 would be launched from NASA's Kennedy Space Centre at 10:33 pm IST on May 29.
