

Bibiano announces 23-member squad for SAFF U-19 C'ship

PTI, ITANAGAR: Head coach Bibiano Fernandes announced a 23-member India squad for the SAFF U-19 Championship, which will be held in Arunachal Pradesh from May 9-18.

The Blue Colts arrived in Itanagar on April 30 with a 25-member probable squad and have been training in the city ahead of the subcontinental tournament, after an initial camp in Bengaluru.

Fernandes said, "We started more than a month back in Bengaluru with around 50 scouted players, who appeared for the trials. I was not surprised when I saw the talent that these boys have."
