Operation Sankalp: 22 Naxalites killed in Chhattisgarh encounter

PTI, BIJAPUR: Twenty-two Naxalites were killed in an encounter with security forces on Wednesday in the forests of Chhattisgarh's Bijapur district bordering Telangana during Operation Sankalp, a massive counter-insurgency initiative, a senior police official said.

The gunfight broke out in the morning in the Karregutta hills forest along the interstate border, he said.

"So far, bodies of 22 Naxalites have been recovered and a search operation was underway in the area", he said, adding that the identity of the slain cadres was yet to be established.

With the latest encounter, the toll of Naxalites gunned down under Operation Sankalp since April 21

has climbed to 26. Operation Sankalp, one of the biggest counter-insurgency actions launched in the Bastar region, involves around 24,000 security personnel from different units including District Reserve Guard (DRG), Bastar Fighters, Special Task Force (STF), all units of state police, Central reserve Police Force (CRPF) and its elite unit CoBRA.

The operation was launched based on inputs about the presence of senior cadres of battalion no. 1, the strongest military formation of Maoists, Dandakaranya Special Zonal Committee (DKSZC) and Telangana state committee of Maoists.

On April 24, three Naxalite women, belonging to

the PLGA battalion no.1 of Maoists carrying a reward of Rs 8 lakh each, were gunned down on the Karregutta hills, leading to the recovery of a huge cache of weapons, explosives, and other material.

On May 5, a woman Naxalite was killed in a gunfight with security forces in the area.

The area surrounded by dense forests and lined by hills is believed to be the base of the Maoist battalion no. 1, the police official said.

"The inputs suggest several senior-level Maoist cadres have either been killed or seriously injured during this operation, but their colleagues managed to drag them inside the forest," he said.

The official said hundreds of Naxal hideouts and bunkers have been destroyed so far during the operation, and a huge cache of explosive material, detonators, medicines, and other items was seized.

At least six security personnel, including an official of CoBRA unit, were injured in different incidents of pressure IED blasts. All the injured jawans are out of danger and are being treated in various hospitals.

With the latest action, 168 Naxalites have been gunned down in separate encounters in Chhattisgarh so far this year. Of them, 151 were eliminated in the Bastar division, comprising seven districts, including Bijapur.

Bomb threat diverts Chandigarh-Mumbai flight



PTI, MUMBAI: An IndiGo flight from Chandigarh made an emergency landing at the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport following a "bomb threat", police said on Wednesday.

According to a police official, the threat call was received at the airport's hotline number on Tuesday.

"At 14.32 pm on Tuesday, the ATC (air traffic controller) declared full emergency for an incoming IndiGo flight (6E-6382) due to a bomb threat," said a source from Mumbai airport.

The flight landed safely at 14.57 pm, and was taken to the isolation bay for checks as per the security protocol, the source said without disclosing the number of people on board. There was nothing suspicious found in the flight, he said.

A thorough security exercise was conducted on the aircraft, but nothing suspicious was found, said the police official.

Man arrested with two live cartridges at Nagpur airport

PTI, NAGPUR: A 40-year-old passenger was arrested after two live cartridges were allegedly found in his bag before he could board a flight at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport in Nagpur, police said.

CISF officials discovered the cartridges in the shaving kit carried by Irfan Khan Sardar Khan, a resident of Tajbagh area, during security screening before he could board an IndiGo flight to Mumbai on Tuesday, police said.

Khan claimed he brought the cartridges unknowingly from a friend's farmhouse in Ramtek city.

Unseasonal rains, thunderstorm leave over 760 houses damaged, one dead

PTI, PALGHAR: Unseasonal rains and thunderstorm damaged more than 760 houses in coastal Palghar district of Maharashtra and also led to the death of an elderly man due to electrocution, officials said.

The downpour and gusty winds also left around 50 fishing boats were damaged, they said.

Heavy rains lashed parts of Maharashtra, including Mumbai and its adjoining Thane, Palghar and Raigad districts, on Tuesday night.

"Storm and heavy rains on Tuesday night severely impacted several talukas in Palghar. As a result,



as many as 767 houses suffered damages. Dahanu reported the highest number of cases of houses damage at 230, followed by Vikramgad and Wada with 92 each, Jawhar at 89, Mokhada at 87, Palghar at 85, Talasari 63, and Vasai 29," Vivekananda Kadam, chief of the disaster management cell of Palghar district, told Wednesday.

A 65-year-old man, identified as Moreshwar Lohar, died after he accidentally stepped on a live electricity cable that gotten snapped and fallen to the ground due to gusty winds. The incident occurred at Vedi village when he was out to graze the goats, he said.

Cabinet committee nod for coal allocation to power plant

PTI, New Delhi: The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs on Wednesday approved the revised Scheme for Harnessing and Allocating Koyala Transparently in India (SHAKTI) for allocation of coal to the power sector to help them meet long-term and short-term coal requirement.

The approval was given by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in a move aimed at simplification of the linkage process.

The CCEA "has approved grant of fresh coal linkages to thermal power plants of central sector/state sector/independent power producers (IPPs)," the coal ministry said in a statement.

With the introduction of Revised SHAKTI (Scheme for Harnessing and Allocating Koyala Transparently in India) Policy, two windows --- coal linkage to central gencos/states at notified price and coal linkage to all gencos at a premium above notified price -- have been proposed.

The ministry further

said 'under coal at notified price' segment the existing mechanism for grant of coal linkage to central sector thermal power projects (TPPs) including joint ventures (JVs) and their subsidiary will continue.

Moreover, coal linkage earmarked to states may be utilized by states in its own genco, Independent Power Producers (IPPs) to be identified through Tariff-Based Competitive Bidding (TBCB) or existing IPPs having Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) for setting up of a new expansion unit under 'coal at notified price' window.

Under the 'premium over notified price' segment, any domestic coal-based power producer having PPA or untied and also imported coal-based power plants (if they so require) can secure coal on auction basis for a period up to 12 months or for the period of more than 12 months up to 25 years.

The Central Sector Thermal Power Projects (TPPs) shall continue to get coal linkage on nomination basis on the recommenda-

tion of Ministry of Power, whereas, the linkages earmarked to the States on nomination basis on the recommendation of Ministry of Power may be utilized by the States in the State Generating Company, the statement added.

Allowing flexible linkage for new capacity addition with or without PPA with a tenure ranging from 12 months to 25 years will encourage IPPs to plan new thermal capacities, which will help in achieving the future thermal capacity addition.

The revised policy, besides supporting brown-field expansion, will promote setting up of new thermal power projects primarily at pithead sites i.e. nearer to the coal source.

The policy was amended in 2019 on the recommendations of the Group of Ministers and was further amended in 2023. SHAKTI Policy has various paras for allocation of a coal linkage to the various categories of power plants, subject to meeting the eligibility criteria.
