J&K faces blackout amid explosions and sirens

**PTI, JAMMU/SRINAGAR:** Blasts were heard and sirens sounded in the Jammu region and south Kashmir as many parts of the Union Territory plunged into darkness on Friday, officials said. Defence officials said drones were also sighted in Jammu, Samba and neighbouring Pathankot district in Punjab and they were being engaged.

In Srinagar, mosque loudspeakers were used to convey to locals to switch off their lights as a precautionary measure. Explosions were heard in areas surrounding the Awantipora air base in south Kashmir.

The drones were sighted a day after India thwarted attempts by the Pakistan military to attack Indian military installations using drones and missiles.

The officials said the drones were also engaged in Udhampur and Nagrota of Jammu and Punjab.

In a related development, heavy cross-border shelling



started along the International Border in Suchetgarh and Ramgarh sectors of Jammu and Samba districts.

Chief Minister Omar Abdullah said in a post on X, "Intermittent sounds of blasts, probably heavy artillery, can now be heard from where I am." He also posted a picture of the city in darkness, captioning the post as, "Blackout in Jammu now. Sirens can be heard across the city."

He said in another post,

"It's my earnest appeal to everyone in and around Jammu please stay off the streets, stay at home or at the nearest place you can comfortably stay at for the next few hours. Ignore rumours, don't spread unsubstantiated or unverified stories and we will get through this together."

On Thursday evening, Indian air defence units successfully intercepted at least eight missiles fired by Pakistan towards the

Guj govt bans use of drones, firecrackers

**PTI, AHMEDABAD:** The Gujarat government on Friday imposed a ban on the use of drones and firecrackers till May 15 in light of the military conflict between India and Pakistan.

The government also warned of taking strict action against those social media users who "spread anti-national sentiments".

"No firecrackers or drones will be allowed in any functions or events until the 15th of this month. Kindly cooperate and follow the guidelines," Gujarat Minister of State for Home Harsh Sanghavi said in a post on X.

Earlier in the day, Sanghavi chaired a meeting with state police officials through video conference in Gandhinagar.

Patanjali donates automated soil testing machine to ICAR



**PANJIM:** Patnjali has donated "Doctor Ka Doctor", an automated soil testing machine to the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) at the Central Soil Salinity Research Institute.

The equipment will facilitate farmers' assessment of the soil quality of their agricultural land, providing fertiliser recommendations tailored for both organic and inorganic farming practices.

Acharya Balkrishna, MD of Bharuwa Agri Science, told that the "Doctor Ka Doctor" machine has received certification from the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)

at the Central Soil Salinity Research Institute. The machine evaluates 12 critical soil parameters, including primary nutrients like nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium and secondary nutrients such as boron, iron, zinc, copper and manganese.

Patented by the Government of India, this machine has also obtained a CE certificate. Dr Rajendra Kumar Yadav, Director of the Central Soil Salinity Research Institute, stated that "Doctor Ka Doctor" will be an asset for farmers across the nation and will support the Government of India's soil health initiatives.

Half of 2020-born could face unprecedented exposure to climate extremes: Study

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Over half the children born in 2020 could face an unprecedented exposure to heatwaves, compared to 16 per cent of those born in 1960, even if global warming were limited to 1.5 degrees Celsius, a new study has found. Analysing demographic data and projections of climate extremes around the world, researchers calculated the fraction of each generation born between

1960 and 2020, who could face an unprecedented exposure in their lifetime. The younger a person, the higher their chances of experiencing unprecedented climate extremes, including heatwaves, river floods and droughts -- children in the tropics will bear the worst burden, the team said. Its findings were published in the journal 'Nature'.

"In this new study, living an unprecedented life

means that without climate change, one would have less than a 1-in-10,000 chance of experiencing that many climate extremes across one's lifetime," lead author Luke Grant, a climate scientist at Vrije Universiteit Brussel, Belgium, said.

"This is a stringent threshold that identifies populations facing climate extremes far beyond what could be expected without man-made climate change,"

Grant said.

The authors wrote, "Under a 1.5 degrees Celsius pathway, 52 per cent of people born in 2020 will experience unprecedented lifetime exposure to heatwaves."

Further, under a scenario of 3.5 degrees Celsius warming, "over 90 per cent will endure such exposure throughout their lives," Grant said.

Several Kashmir schools switch to online mode

**PTI, SRINAGAR:** With tension between India and Pakistan forcing closure of educational institutions in Kashmir, several schools have switched to online mode of classes to ensure that students do not lose precious academic time. As the schools have remained closed since May 7 following India's missile strikes on terror infrastructure in Pakistan, leading private schools in the valley started online classes for their students on Friday. "My kids have started to receive online education from today as it is not safe to venture out of homes, especially after what happened along the borders over the past three days," Saba Bhat, a mother of two, told PTI.

Saba's two sons are students at a leading private school in Pampore area of Pulwama district. While she believes that there is nothing better than attending classes in person, online classes in the current scenario are the best option.

A sudden power outage had plunged Jammu city into darkness following two loud explosions, likely resulting from the interception of the intruding drones. Immediately after, sirens echoed throughout the city, alerting residents to seek shelter.

The aerial objects had attempted to strike the strategic Jammu airport and its surrounding areas, which house army, air force, and paramilitary installations.

TN initiates evacuation of 52 students stranded in J&K

**PTI, CHENNAI:** As many as 52 students from Tamil Nadu pursuing higher education in Jammu and Kashmir and four others on an educational tour to that state have been stranded owing to the developments across the border and steps were on to bring them home safely, the state government said on Friday.

The students were currently pursuing agriculture, horticulture, fisheries, sericulture, NIFT, and NIT. They expressed difficulty in returning home due to the current tense situation prevailing in that state in the wake of military conflict between India and Pakistan.

Following requests from them, the state government has made arrangements to bring the students to Tamil Nadu, the government said.

It may be recalled that Chief Minister M K Stalin had arranged for the return of the tourists stranded in Jammu and Kashmir post the April 22 terrorist attack.

NIA chargesheets four persons for supplying weapons to Naxals

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has chargesheeted four accused for their involvement in supplying weapons to the Naxals and other criminal elements, an official statement issued on Friday said. The four accused, identified as Vikash Kumar, Satyam Kumar, Devmani Rai and Ahmad Ansari, were previously charged by the local police under the Arms Act, it said. As per the NIA, which has been investigating the case since May last year, the accused "had conspired and were actively involved in the illegal procurement and smuggling of prohibited bore weapons to Naxalites and other criminal elements", said the statement issued by the probe agency.

They had also raised and utilised funds for procurement of these arms as part of a conspiracy, aimed at disturbing the nation's unity, integrity, security and sovereignty, it added.

In its supplementary chargesheet filed before

the NIA Special Court in Patna on Thursday, the NIA has now charged all four under Section 120B of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Sections 13 and 18 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the statement said.

The chargesheet followed an investigation in a case related to the seizure of an AK-47 rifle in Bihar's Muzaffarpur.

The NIA said that the Muzaffarpur Rail Police had initially on May 7, 2024, recovered an AK-47 butt and a rifle lens from Vikash and Satyam.

"The duo disclosed during investigation that they had supplied an AK-47 rifle and five live rounds to Devmani Rai alias Anish, a resident of Mankauli under Faku-li PS, Muzaffarpur," the statement said.

"A search of Devmani's house later led to the recovery of the rifle and the live rounds. All three, along with accused Ahmad Ansari, were arrested in the case," it added.
