PANJIM: A new force is rising in Indian women's football, Sesa Football Academy (SFA) senior women's team has scripted a remarkable debut in the Indian Women's League-2 (IWL-2), entering the national play-offs as one of the top-performing teams, which commenced at the Duler Stadium, Mapusa.

In their first-ever appearance in IWL2, the Sesa FA senior women's team, also known as the #SFALionesses, have turned heads with their aggressive playmaking, rock-solid defence, and unflinching spirit.

The team remained unbeaten through the group stage, topping the table and scoring 13 goals in four matches against experienced opponents - a feat that speaks volumes of the grit and ambition fuelling this dynamic squad.

Their campaign was marked by a confident, attacking brand of football, laced with tactical intelligence and an unmistakable hunger to win. The team's fluid movement and technical finesse were matched by their mental fortitude, making them one of the most talked-about sides in this year's IWL-2.

This is all the more remarkable as the team was initially not slated to be a part of the IWL-2 Group Stage. Getting an entry only due to a last-minute withdrawal, the #SFALionesses showed class and that they very much belong to the upper echelons of women's



football in India.

Speaking ahead of the play-offs, Severino Fernandes, head coach of the Sesa FA women's team, reflected on the journey with pride saying, "This team is the result of belief, resilience and pure hard work. We have built something truly special here at Sesa FA."

Sesa Football Academy Technical Director Gavin Araujo, believing this is just the beginning.

"This is a moment of transformation for women's football. What we're witnessing is a turning point. The performance of our women's team is not an outlier - it is the result of groundwork laid through the GFA-Vedanta Women's League, our investment in scouting and development, and a progressive footballing ecosystem that encourages young women to dream big. This group of players has shown what's possible when talent meets opportunity."
