Bopanna and Pavlaski will next face Great Britain's Joe Salisbury and Neal Skupski in the next round. But it was heartbreak for another Indian Yuki Bhambri. Bhambri and his American partner Robert Galloway crashed out in the opening round, losing 1-6 2-6 against fourth seeded pair of Marcel Granollers of Spain and Argentina's Horacio Zebal-

Praggnanandhaa to take on Duda in round 6 of Superbet Classic

BUCHAREST (Romania): In a three-way lead after the fifth round, Indian Grandmaster R Praggnanandhaa will open as black against Duda-Jan-Krzysztof of Poland in the sixth round of the Superbet Classic, a part of the Grand Chess tour, here, on Tuesday. A lone victory against Nodirbek Abdusattorov of Uzbekistan in round three and remaining four draws have taken Praggnanandhaa to three points out of a possible five and the Indian is in joint lead with Fabiano Caruana of the United States and Maxime Vachier-Lagrave of France. D Gukesh's hunt for an elusive victory continued in the first half of the event and the youngest ever world champion has just got four draws besides one loss in his five games thus far. Brazil signs Real Madrid coach Ancelotti one year ahead of 2026 World Cup

SAO PAULO: Brazil's soccer confederation said on Monday it has a deal with Real Madrid coach Carlo Ancelotti eyeing the 2026 World Cup. The 65-year-old Ancelotti, who will be Brazil's first full-time foreign coach in a century, is still under contract with Madrid. The last round of the Spanish league will be on May 25 and the CBF said in a statement that he will officially take over Brazil the following day. "Bringing Carlo Ancelotti to coach Brazil is more than a strategic movement. It is a statement to the world that we are determined to recover the top of the podium," CBF President Ednaldo Rodrigues said in a statement. Rodrigues said Ancelotti will take charge of Brazil's next two fixtures in South American World Cup qualifying, with his debut at Ecuador on June 5th and five days later in front of home fans against Paraguay in Sao Paulo. He will replace Dorival Júnior, who held the job for 14 months and was fired in March after a 4-1 defeat at Argentina.

Indian shuttlers win 19 medals at Fazza Para Badminton International

DUBAI: Indian shuttlers finished with a haul of 19 medals, including a gold, four silver and 14 bronze, at the 6th Fazza Para Badminton International tournament here. Sivarajan Solaimalai and Sudarsan Saravanakumar Muthusamy claimed the only gold medal at the championships, as the pair got a walkover from their top seed opponents Hong Kong's Chu Man Kai and Wong Chun Yim in the men's doubles SH6 finals on Sunday. Experienced shuttler Umesh Vikram Kumar settled for silver in two of his Standing Lower SL3 singles and men's doubles finals, while the pair of Hardik Makkar and Ruthick Ragupathi went down fighting to the top seeded Malaysian Cheah Like Hou and Muhammad Fareez Anuar in men's double Standing Upper SU5 finals. Tokyo Paralympic champion Krishna Nagar signed off with a bronze after losing to Brazil's Vitor Tavares in the semi-final.
