3 more arrested on treason charges in Assam

**GUWAHATI:** Three more persons were arrested in Assam on treason charges, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said. With this, a total of 56 people have been arrested in the state since the Pahalgam attack on April 22. The three arrested were identified as Lalchan Ali of Dhubri, Samir Ali of Lakhimpur and Rakib Hussain of Karbi Anglong, Sarma said in a post on X on Monday night. "Any act of sympathising with the enemy is an act of treason. Cracking down on anti-national elements - 56 such elements are now behind bars," he said. Earlier, AIUDF MLA Aminul Islam was arrested on sedition charges for allegedly "defending" Pakistan's role in the Pahalgam terror attack in which 26 people were killed.

Proclaimed offender wanted in gang-rape case held in Delhi

**NEW DELHI:** A proclaimed offender, wanted in a 2021 gang rape case and a recent shooting incident, was arrested from Tis Hazari Court premises, police said on Tuesday. The accused, Abdul Gaffar, a resident of Burari, had been absconding since October 2021. He was wanted in a gang rape case in the Burari area, they said. "Three of his co-accused were arrested earlier, but Gaffar evaded arrest despite several police raids. He was declared a proclaimed offender by a Delhi court in April 2022," a senior police officer said. According to police, Gaffar was also wanted in another case registered in March after a man sustained gunshot injuries. He had allegedly fired upon the victim and gone into hiding. A team was formed and working on tracking Gaffar.

Army drone used for training goes missing in UP's Meerut

**MEERUT (UP):** An Army drone has gone missing during a routine military training here, police said on Tuesday. According to a complaint filed by technician Havildar Major Deepak Roy of the Corps of Electronics and Mechanical Engineers at the Railway Road police station, the incident took place near the city railway station on Monday evening, when a drone was flown as part of a military training exercise. During the flight, the drone lost connectivity with the control monitor and went astray. Sadar Circle Officer Santosh Kumar Singh told PTI, "As per the information provided by the Army, the drone flown in Rohta Road area crossed the railway line and went in the other direction."

Elderly pilgrim killed by boulder at Parvati Kund in Uttarakhand

**PITHORAGARH (UKD):** An elderly woman from Gujarat on a pilgrimage trip to the Adi Kailash peak died after being hit by a boulder in Jolkingong in Uttarakhand, the police said Tuesday. Sanwala Devyani, 64, died on the spot in the freak incident Monday afternoon, Gunji Police Station SHO Ashutosh Kumar said. Her relatives have been informed and her body has been sent to Dharchula for a post-mortem, he said. "The body has reached Dharchula for post-mortem, and we are waiting for her relatives from Gujarat. The body would be handed over to them after a post-mortem," Dharchula Sub-Divisional Magistrate Manjit Singh said.

Man kills 24-year-old in UP over love affair with his sister

**SHAHJAHANPUR (UP):** A 24-year-old man was killed here in Sahvaj Nagar village over an alleged love affair, police said Tuesday. Kaushal alias Mangal, from Sahvaj Nagar village, was called from his house by Santosh, a resident of the same village, on Monday afternoon. However, Kaushal didn't return home late into the night, Superintendent of Police (SP) Rajesh Dwivedi said. He added that the villagers then informed Kaushal's family about him lying on the road outside the village with several slashes on his chest. The police immediately rushed Kaushal to the Government Medical College where the doctors declared him dead. Initial inquiry indicated the slashes on his chest were made by a sharp weapon, Dwivedi said, adding that according to the villagers,

Man arrested for 'inflammatory' post on PM Modi in Karnataka

**BENGALURU:** A man was arrested for posting an inflammatory message on social media, questioning why Pakistan had not bombed Prime Minister Narendra Modi's residence in New Delhi, police said. "Why is Modi's house not being bombed in the fight between India and Pakistan? It's Modi who is creating trouble for people who were living happily. First, you bomb Modi's house," Nawaz had posted on his Instagram page. The accused was picked up following an uproar over the post, police said. "A man named Nawaz had posted the message on Instagram. Based on his social media post, we registered a case at the Bandepalya police station. He was arrested yesterday, and we are producing him before a court today," Bengaluru Joint Commissioner of Police (East Division) Ramesh Bhanot told reporters.

# Oppn to question govt on Trump's ceasefire mediation claim: Kharge

**PTI, KALABURAGI (KARNATAKA):** Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge on Tuesday said that the opposition will question the government at the all-party meeting, regarding US President Donald Trump's claims that his administration helped broker a "ceasefire" between India and Pakistan.

The Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha said he will urge the government to call an all-party meeting soon, to discuss the latest developments in border tension between India and Pakistan, including "ceasefire". Speaking to reporters here, he said, "Trump is saying things to claim credit. These people (PM and central government) are saying no. It is a sensitive matter. When an all-party meeting is called, we will discuss what's the matter, what happened and what were the telephone talks and ask all these things".

In response to a question whether PM Modi gave in to Trump's mediation, he said "It won't be right for me to speak about it now. We have our party meeting

today. I'm going for that. I will ask (Centre) to call an all-party meeting, let's see what they will do."

India and Pakistan reached an understanding on Saturday to end the military conflict after four days of intense cross-border drone and missile strikes.

Indian government sources have been maintaining that the Director Generals of Military Operations (DGMOs) of India and Pakistan reached an understanding to stop all firings and military actions, and no third party was involved.

There was no reference to trade in talks between top leaders of India and the US during the India-Pakistan military conflict, government sources said on Monday after American President Donald Trump claimed that he pressured New Delhi and Islamabad to stop hostilities by threatening to cut trade with both countries.

The source-based clarification came after Trump on Monday said he forced the two countries to stop the hostilities by using the

ENCOUNTER IN J-K'S SHOPIAN DISTRICT, THREE TERRORISTS KILLED

**PTI, SRINAGAR:** Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) commander Shahid Kuttay was among three terrorists killed in an encounter with security forces in Shopian district of Jammu and Kashmir on Tuesday, officials said. Based on a specific input about the presence of terrorists in Shukroo Kella area of the south Kashmir district, security forces launched a cordon and search operation there. They said the search operation turned into an encounter after the terrorists fired upon the forces who retaliated. In the exchange of fire, three terrorists were killed, they said. A senior police official said the terrorists belonged to LeT. He identified the two as Shahid Kuttay and Adnan Shafi. The identity of the third one was being ascertained.

CEASEFIRE MUST HOLD, PEOPLE WANT PEACE: OMAR ABDULLAH

**PTI, SRINAGAR:** Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah Tuesday said the ceasefire between India and Pakistan must remain intact as people on the border want to live in peace. We all want the ceasefire to remain intact. Only the anchors of a few TV channels, who sit far away from here in Noida and Bombay, do not like the ceasefire. "The people living near the borders or the LoC, and those who saw the situation in Jammu and Srinagar, they want a ceasefire. It is a good thing. This ceasefire should remain intact," Abdullah told reporters in the Tangdhar area of Kupwara district. The chief minister was visiting the shelling-affected areas of the north Kashmir district.

Boat capsizes in UP, three dead

**PTI, HARDOI (UP):** Three children drowned when a boat capsized in the Ramganga river here, police said. While four members of a family were rescued after the incident on Monday night, the bodies of the children were recovered by police with the help of divers.

Circle Officer (Harpalpur) Shilpa Kumari on Tuesday said seven members of a family of Diwari Lal were returning from their farm in a small boat when the incident took place around 8 pm.

While Diwari Lal, his sister Nirmala, wife Suman and daughter Kajal were taken out safely, his nephew and nieces identified as Sunaina (7), Shivam (14) and Sonia (13) drowned.

No blackouts scheduled; schools and markets open in Rajasthan

**PTI, JAIPUR:** As life returned to normal in border districts of Rajasthan, educational institutions in Bikaner, Sri Ganganagar and Jodhpur reopened on Tuesday and district administrations assured people that no blackouts are scheduled now. However, the residents have been asked to remain alert.

Rajasthan shares a 1,070-km frontier with Pakistan. Schools, colleges and other educational institutions were closed as a precautionary measure in many border districts of Rajasthan due to the military tensions between India and Pakistan. However, as the two

countries on Saturday reached an understanding to end the conflict, the situation is becoming normal and the administration has started relaxing the restrictions.

The district administration said that they have withdrawn the order to keep educational activities closed in Sri Ganganagar, Jodhpur and Bikaner. The Sri Ganganagar administration said, "All types of educational institutions in the district will be able to conduct regular educational activities from May 13."

Girl raped by six young men in Jharkhand

**PTI, GUMLA:** A girl was allegedly raped by six young men in Jharkhand's Gumla district, police said on Tuesday.

She was attending a wedding and had gone out of the venue to relieve herself along with three other girls when these men started accosting them. While the rest managed to flee, she could not and was taken to a nearby forest and allegedly raped, they said.

The accused men left her there to die and fled, they added.

After being found by her family, she narrated the incident to them, following which her father lodged a police complaint.

The incident happened on Friday, and police on Monday arrested all six accused involved in the crime, said Mukesh Tudu, the in-charge of the Sursang police station.

"Taking prompt action, a team was set up and all accused, aged 18 to 24, were arrested from different locations," he said, adding that a court sent them to judicial remand.

Bomb scare on Mumbai-bound plane at Kolkata airport

**PTI, KOLKATA:** A plane of a private airline was taken to the isolation bay at the Kolkata airport on Tuesday afternoon for a thorough security check after a passenger was suspected of carrying a bomb, officials said.

The passenger was detained after he told the airline's security officer that he had a bomb, an Airports Authority of India (AAI) official said.

The 26-year-old passenger, travelling to Mumbai from Imphal with a stopover in Kolkata, made the comment

during the step ladder point check, a secondary-level security procedure under which airline staff frisk passengers and their hand luggage just before boarding, he said.

"The passenger's claim was declared specific, security was beefed up, and standard operating procedure (SOP) implemented," he added.

The passenger arrived in Kolkata by an Indigo flight and was supposed to take another flight of the same airline to Mumbai.

From fighter pilots to face of Gaganyaan: Astronaut designates for India's maiden human spaceflight

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** "I have cast my feet in cement," India's astronaut-designate Angad Pratap jokingly tells his colleague Ajit Krishnan as people queued up to click selfies with the duo at a conference here last week.

The selection of Pratap and Krishnan as astronauts-designate, along with Shubhanshu Shukla and Prashanth Nair, for India's maiden human spaceflight project - Gaganyaan - have made them heroes overnight.

Shukla is scheduled to travel to the International

Space Station as part of the ISRO-NASA joint mission on May 29.

Pratap and Krishnan, both fighter pilots with the Indian Air Force, were at the three-day Global Space Exploration Conference (GLEX) organised by the International Astronautical Federation here last week.

Krishnan has rejoined the Indian Air Force after his astronaut training, while Pratap is pursuing his PhD and is on study leave.

"Their training will begin again 12 months before

that I learn from those interactions. I get to know about the dreams of a lot of people. I get a lot of inspiration from a lot of other people," he said.

India's first human spaceflight - Gaganyaan - is expected to be launched early 2027 with ISRO planning to send two astronauts in low earth orbit in a spacecraft for a few days and bring them back to earth safely.

The transition from being a test pilot to being an astronaut-designate was "challenging and exciting" for Pratap.
