India to send delegations abroad to expose Pak on terror

PTI, NEW DELHI: As part of a major diplomatic offensive, the government will send several all-party delegations to different countries, starting next week, to expose Pakistan-sponsored terrorism on the world forum. The exercise is aimed at presenting India's stance against Pakistan on terror comes in the wake of Operation Sindoor - the Indian offensive against terror camps in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) following the April 22 terror attack in Pahalgalam in which 26 people, mostly tourists, were killed. Senior leaders, including MPs, of various parties from both the ruling and the opposition, have been sounded out by the government and some parties have also given their go-ahead to the presence of their members for the

Vikram University ragging incident: Five students expelled, police case filed

PTI, UJJAIN: A student staying in a hostel of Vikram University in Ujjain in Madhya Pradesh was ragged, following which a police case was registered and five of those allegedly involved in the incident were expelled, officials said on Friday. The 20-year-old victim, a third-year B.Tech student of Swami Vivekanand Engineering Institute, hails from Sagar district and was staying in the university's Shaligram Tomar hostel, a police of-

ficial said. "The incident took place in the intervening night of Tuesday and Wednesday. He was beaten up by some seniors, his clothes were torn and the students involved also threatened to kill him. A case was registered against two students identified as Vedant alias Krishna Udasi and Mukul Upadhyay," Madhavnagar police station in-charge Rakesh Bharti said. The victim underwent a medical examination at Charak Hospital.

Police said the victim has told them the ragging incident was a fallout of issues related to competition and pressure. University Vice Chancellor Arpan Bharadwaj said the management handed over a letter to police seeking legal action against those involved. "The University has also decided to take disciplinary action against five students. It has been decided to expel them from the hostel and related departments. Expulsion letters have also been given

to the heads of the departments," the VC said. The UGC's anti-ragging committee has also taken cognizance of the matter and has sought information and a report will be submitted to it by the university, Bharadwaj added.

Eleventh woman judge in SC history, Justice Bela M Trivedi bids adieu

PTI, NEW DELHI: Justice Bela M Trivedi, who was the eleventh woman judge to be elevated to the Supreme Court in its 75-year-old history on Friday demitted office after spending three-and-a-half years on the bench. Justice Trivedi, who had the rare distinction of being elevated to the top court after starting out as a trial court judge in Gujarat in July 1995, was part of the top court's several landmark judgements. "It was a happy coincidence that her father was already working as the judge, city civil and sessions court when she was appointed. The Limca Book of Indian records has recorded the entry in



their 1996 edition that "Father - daughter judges in the same court," Justice Trivedi's profile on the apex court website said. She was elevated as a judge of the apex court on August 31, 2021 when a record nine new judges, including three women, were administered oath of office. On Friday, Justice Trivedi sat in the ceremonial bench headed by Chief Justice B R Gavai as a tradition marking the exit of a top court judge.

She was part of a five-judge Constitution bench, which by a 3:2 majority, in November 2022 upheld 10 per cent reservation introduced in 2019 for economically weaker sections in admissions and government jobs that excluded the poor among the SC/ST/OBC categories. A seven-judge Constitution bench, which Justice Trivedi was part of, in August 2024 by a 6:1 majority held that states are constitutionally empowered to make sub-classifications within the Scheduled Castes, which form a socially heterogeneous class, for granting reservation for the uplift of castes that are socially and educationally more backward among them.
