Indore cartoonist booked for 'objectionable' social media content on RSS worker's complaint

INDORE: A cartoonist in Indore in Madhya Pradesh was booked on the complaint of an RSS functionary for allegedly posting objectionable content on social media, a police official said on Thursday. Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh activist and city-based lawyer Vinay Joshi, in his complaint at Lasudiya police station on Wednesday night, claimed the contents of Hemant Malviya's cartoons are "offensive", "obscene" and "indecent" and that he was intentionally posting them on social media to hurt the religious sentiments of Hindus and tarnish the image of the RSS. An official said the contents posted on Malviya's Facebook account include comments, cartoons, videos and photos related to Lord Shiva, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, RSS etc.

Man killed, kin injured in tiger attack in Chandrapur

CHANDRAPUR: A 55-year-old shepherd was killed and another injured in a tiger attack in Maharashtra's Chandrapur district on Thursday, an official said. The incident took place in Kosambi Chek village in Mul tehsil under Chichpally forest range when Bandu Urade and his kin Kishore Urade (35) were grazing cattle, he said. "In the tiger attack, Bandu died on the spot, while Kishore is injured and hospitalised. A forest department team inspected the spot, after which seven camera traps were placed to monitor the tiger's movement. The kin of the deceased has been given initial compensation of Rs 50,000," he added.

Urban guerrilla group in Myanmar claims responsibility for assassinating retired army officer

BANGKOK: A retired high-ranking officer in Myanmar's military was shot dead by a self-proclaimed urban guerrilla group on Thursday near his home in the country's biggest city, marking the latest assassination attributed to militants opposed to army rule. The former army officer, Cho Tun Aung, was shot by a man at around 9 am while he was standing in front of his home in Yangon's Mayangon township, a member of the local administration said. The official spoke on the condition of anonymity because he wasn't authorised to release information. A militant group calling itself the Golden Valley Warriors claimed responsibility for the attack on Cho Tun Aung, who also had previously served as Myanmar's ambassador to Cambodia.

Consider Maharashtra's Zudpi Jungle as forest lands: SC

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Thursday declared Zudpi Jungle lands in Maharashtra's eastern Vidarbha region as forests in line with its 1996 verdict but protected the structures existing on it for decades. The apex court 1996 verdict defined the term "forest". A bench of Chief Justice B R Gavai and Justice Augustine George Masih noted that "zudpi" was a Marathi word, literally translating to bushes or shrubs and "zudpi" lands meant an inferior type of unoccupied lands with bushy growth. The top court was dealing with the issue over the status of such lands in the districts of Nagpur, Wardha, Bhandara, Gondia, Chandrapur and Gadchiroli in Maharashtra's eastern Vidarbha region.

Four girls including three sisters drown in UP's Pratapgargh district

PRATAPGARH: Four minor girls, including three sisters, drowned in the Bakulahi River on Thursday while collecting clay from the riverbed, police said. The incident occurred around 11 am at Cheti Singh Ka Purwa village under the Kunda police station area, about 70 km from the district headquarters, said Additional Superintendent of Police (West) Sanjay Rai. The deceased girls have been identified as Swati (13), Sandhya (11) and Chandni (6) — all sisters from Jalalpur Dihwa village — and their neighbour, Priyanshi (7). According to police, the girls had gone to collect clay from the river to plaster their kitchen and walls with mud, a traditional practice in rural households. While digging near the bank of the river, the girls reportedly ventured into deeper water and drowned. Other children present at the site raised the alarm, following which locals rushed to the spot and pulled the girls out, but by then, all four had died, officials said.

# CoBRA commando, Naxalite killed in encounter

PTI , RAIPUR: A CoBRA commando of the CRPF and a Naxalite were killed during an anti-Maoist operation in Chhattisgarh's Bijapur district on Thursday, officials said.

The incident took place in the morning hours around the Tumrel area under the Usoor police station limits. The operation was led by the 210th Battalion of CRPF's CoBRA unit and troops from Chhattisgarh Police's DRG and STF, the officials said.

The troops launched the operation on Wednesday based on inputs about the movement of the PLGA battalion no. 1 of the outlawed CPI (Maoist).

CoBRA commando Constable Mehul Solanki was killed in action as he suffered a bullet injury. The troops engaged the Maoists and forced them to retreat to the jungles, the officials said.

Commando Solanki hailed from Gujarat.

According to the officials, the forces are in the area and the operation is underway.

Three other CoBRA troops were injured in the gun battle, the officials said. They said an IAF heli-

DRG JAWAN KILLED IN IED BLAST WHILE RETURNING FROM ABHUJMA ENCONTRE

PTI, NARAYANPUR: A District Reserve Guard (DRG) jawan of the state police was killed when an improvised explosive device planted by Naxalites went off in Chhattisgarh's Narayanpur district, officials said. The incident took place in densely forested Abhujmad area on Wednesday evening when security personnel were returning after a major encounter with Maoists, a senior police official said. At least 27 Naxalites including Nambala Keshav Rao alias Basavaraju (70), general secretary of the outlawed Communist Party of India (Maoist), were killed in the encounter which took place in the forests along the border of Narayanpur and Bijapur districts. While returning, Ramesh Hemla, a jawan belonging to the Bijapur DRG, stepped on a pressure-activated IED, triggering a blast that killed him on the spot, the police official said.

## Month after massacre of tourists, Pahalgam stares at loss

PTI , PAHALGAM: A month after the deadly terror attack on tourists in Pahalgam, locals in the south Kashmir resort town stare at mounting livelihood losses, even as the perpetrators have managed to evade the massive crackdown launched by security forces to track them down.

While several top terrorists have been killed in various operations launched after the deadly April 22 attack at Baisaran meadows, the terrorists who carried out the massacre have eluded the security forces, officials said on Thursday.

Terrorists descended on the picturesque Baisaran meadows of Pahalgam on April 22 and shot dead 25 tourists and a local man who tried to save them. Though the exact number of terrorists who carried out the attack is not known, sources have said there were between four and six terrorists.

Preliminary investigations have revealed that the terrorists shot the victims after verifying their religion by asking them to recite the "kalma", the verse recited to

profess Islamic faith.

The officials said the security forces were conducting relentless operations to track down the terrorists.

"They have managed to evade the security forces thus far but it won't be too long before we get them," a senior police officer said.

Thousands of suspects across Kashmir were called in for questioning while hundreds were detained as the security grid launched a massive crackdown to hunt down the perpetrators of the massacre.

Nearly 100 persons were booked under the Public Safety Act and sent to various jails.

There are reports that

security forces also picked up youngsters who had already served terms for past associations with militancy.

Meanwhile, locals in Pahalgam and adjoining areas are counting their losses as tourists have stopped visiting.

"The place looks desolate. We used to have thousands of tourists on any given day in Pahalgam, providing livelihood opportunities for everyone — shopkeepers, roadside vendors, pony-wallahs, cab drivers and hoteliers," said tour operator Nasir Ahmad.

He said Pahalgam had not worn such a deserted look even at the peak of the early 1990s insurgency.
