

Liberian vessel lists off Kerala coast

Spills marine fuel cargo into sea

PTI, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM/KOCHI: A Liberian container vessel carrying marine fuel listed several degrees, 38 nautical miles off the Kerala coast on Saturday afternoon, causing its cargo to spill into the sea, authorities said.

The Kerala State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA) cautioned the general public against touching the cargo containers or oil spill if they wash ashore.

They also asked people to immediately inform the police if they see container or oil spill on the shore.

According to a Defence release, the 184 metre long vessel - MSC Elsa 3 - departed from Kochi for the Vizhinjam port on Friday and at around 1.25 pm on May 24, the company owning the ship informed Indian authorities that it was listing by 26 degrees and sought urgent assistance.

It said that the Coast Guard was coordinating rescue operations by maintaining ships and aircrafts near the distressed vessel and of the 24 crew onboard, nine were in liferafts.

Operations are underway to rescue the remaining 15

crewmembers, it said.

"Indian Coast Guard aircrafts (Dornier) have dropped additional liferafts near the vessel to facilitate further evacuation. DG Shipping, in coordination with Indian Coast Guard, has issued directives to the ship managers for providing urgent salvage services for the vessel," the release said.

It also said that medical assistance was being provided to the crew members who were taken aboard one of the Coast

Guard vessels which took part in the rescue operation.

The 24-member crew of the vessel comprised one Russian, the Master, 20 Filipinos, two Ukrainians and one person from Georgia, the release said.

Earlier, KSDMA member secretary Sekhar Kuriakose, in a voice note shared with reporters, said that the information about the dangerous cargo falling into the sea was received from the coast guard.

Major Mexican drug cartel figure killed in clash with army

AFP, MEXICO CITY: A leader of a notorious Mexican drug cartel who had a bounty on his head in the United States has died in a clash with army troops, authorities said Saturday.

Sinaloa state, where the powerful cartel of the same name is based, is enduring a war between two rival factions that has left some 1,200 people dead since September.

Jorge Humberto Figueroa was shot and killed Friday in a raid carried out to arrest him, public safety secretary Omar Garcia Harfuch wrote on the social media platform X.

The US Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) had been offering up to \$1 million for information leading to his arrest on suspicion of fentanyl trafficking and money laundering.

German held for Hamburg stabbing

AP, BERLIN: More than a dozen people who were injured in a stabbing attack at the central train station in the German city of Hamburg were in stable condition, police said Saturday.

A 39-year-old woman, a German national, was arrested at the scene of Friday's attack without putting up resistance, and police said they believe she acted alone. The Hamburger Abendblatt newspaper reported that two passers-by managed to overpower the woman and take the knife from her.

It quoted a fire department spokesman, Philipp Baumann, saying that the attack injured 18 people between the ages of 19 and 85. Three women aged 24, 52 and 85, and a 24-year-old man were critically injured. According to the police, however, all four were in stable condition on Saturday.

indication of any political motive, and police said that investigators were looking into whether the suspect may have been mentally ill.

The woman was expected to appear before a judge on Saturday and then be placed in a psychiatric ward.

The attacker targeted people on the platform between tracks 13 and 14 in the station at around 6 pm Friday. The station in downtown Hamburg, Germany's second-biggest city, is a major hub for local, regional and long-distance trains.

India delegations conclude trips to Russia, Japan

PTI, MOSCOW/TOKYO/MANAMA: All party delegations from India to Russia and Japan on Saturday concluded their visits with "constructive meetings" with diplomatic leaderships discussing global fight against terror as a third similar team reached Bahrain to highlight New Delhi's response to cross-border radicalism.

The three delegations that exchanged views on furthering cooperation in counter-terrorism and combating radicalism, especially after the April 22 Pahalagam terror attack that saw 26 people dead, are part of India's global outreach with its seven multi-party delegations travelling to 33 global capitals to meet the international community.

Meeting with the political leadership, media, senior officials and members of the delegations spread awareness about Pakistan's designs and India's response to terror and shared information about Operation Sindoor.

The delegation to Moscow, led by DMK MP Kanimozhi Karunanidhi, addressed a press conference at the end of the visit and described Russia as a "close

and tried and tested" friend. "We naturally seek an understanding that Russia is by our side in this time of difficulty. It is better that people are aware of our suffering from state-sponsored terrorism from Pakistan," the delegation members said while answering a media question.

Opening the press conference, Kanimozhi described the Russia visit as a "great opportunity to explain our stand" and said, "Pakistan chooses to protect the terrorists, they go ahead and spread false propaganda. We had only targeted terror

hubs. India is very clear, we would not come to the table for peace talks when Pakistan continues attacking us."

On Friday, Russia had reiterated its decisive commitment to "an uncompromising joint fight" with New Delhi against all forms of terrorism.

When the delegation to Russia met Andrey Denisov, First Deputy Chair of the Committee on International Affairs, Russia, and Senators on Friday, Kanimozhi described the meeting as "constructive" and said they two sides "exchanged views on issues of mutual concern with respect to terrorism."
