

Protesters scuffle with security forces near Manipur Raj Bhavan

PTI, IMPHAL: A scuffle broke out between protesters and security forces on Sunday while they were on their way to gherao the Raj Bhavan here against the removal of the state's name from a government bus. The protesters responding to a call by COCOMI (Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity) to stage mass agitation gathered at Khwairamband and took out a rally for some 500 metres before they were stopped by security forces. They were demanding an apology from Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla over an alleged insult to Manipur's identity. Security forces fired several rounds of tear gas shells to disperse the protesters in front of Kangla Gate, some 150 metres from Raj Bhavan gate. Five protesters have been admitted to hospital with

AMID BUS ROW, MEITEI GROUP COCOMI SAYS IT WILL MEET HOME MINISTRY OFFICIALS

PTI, IMPHAL: A seven-member delegation of COCOMI, an umbrella body of Meitei groups, will meet Union Home Ministry officials in New Delhi on Tuesday and discuss the present situation in Manipur, particularly the row over hiding the state's name on a government bus in Gwalabi, its convener Khurajaim Athouba said. He said the agenda for the meeting includes the demand for a public apology from Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla over the Gwalabi incident, and the removal of the chief secretary, DGP, and security advisor. The central government and COCOMI have been communicating. The Ministry of Home Affairs has extended an invitation to COCOMI (Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity) for an exclusive meeting. The meeting is scheduled on Tuesday, Athouba said.

One protester told reporters, "The governor continues to disregard the sentiments of the people by his silence. He and his administration has completely humiliated the state's historical and cultural legacy all the while administer-

ing the state. The inquiry commission set up by the government to probe the incident is not enough and does not mention anything about penalising those who were involved."

The protest follows outrage over a reported directive to remove "Manipur" from Manipur State Trans-

port bus with journalists on board on May 20 en route to the Shirui Festival in Ukhrul district.

COCOMI has announced statewide agitation and demanded the resignation of the Chief Secretary, DGP, and Security Advisor.

The Manipur government on Wednesday ordered a probe into the allegations that security personnel forced to cover the state's name on a bus taking journalists to the Shirui Lily festival.

It was alleged that security forces had stopped the state-run bus, on which journalists were being taken by the government to cover the tourism festival in Ukhrul district on Tuesday, and forced the Directorate of Information and Public Relations (DIPR) staffers to cover the state's name written on the windshield with a white paper.

Karnataka takes safety measures against Covid-19

PTI, BENGALURU: With fresh Covid-19 cases being reported in the state, Karnataka Health Minister Dinesh Gundu Rao on Sunday said the government is taking all the necessary precautionary measures, including testing the risky cases. Speaking to reporters after the death of an 84-year-old man with severe comorbidities, who tested positive for Covid-19, the minister said, "He had several issues. So we have asked for an audit. We cannot say directly that he died because of COVID only."

Commenting on the current Covid status, he said that the situation at present is not concerning or calls for restrictions.


Officials and experts are constantly monitoring, and decisions on any further measures, if needed, will be taken based on the situation, in consultation with the central government, he added.

"An 84-year-old man has died. The death probably happened on May 17. We are getting this death audited. He was tested COVID positive, but he was bedridden for a year, he had a hip replacement, he had heart issues, and he was a TB patient. So we have asked for an audit to get a clear report," he said.

According to the health department, 38 active COVID-19 cases were reported in the state, including 32 in Bengaluru as on Saturday evening.

"We have asked our department officials to conduct tests. RT-PCR testing kits will most probably reach our centres by tomorrow or the day after. So, wherever necessary, we have asked for tests to be conducted, especially with Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) cases and Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) cases among aged people and children.



Delhi Police nabs family of 9 bangladeshi nationals

PTI, NEW DELHI: A family of nine Bangladeshi nationals who worked in a brick kiln in Haryana's Mewat but fled fearing arrest for entering India illegally have been nabbed by the Delhi police, officials said on Sunday. Upon receiving information about illegal Bangladeshis, a police team detailed a surveillance and verification drive in Wazirpur JJ Colony on May 23 which led to the detention of one such person. His interrogation helped the police apprehend eight other Bangladeshi nationals, including a newborn, of the same family who were living in India without valid documents, an official said.

They were nabbed from the Bharat Nagar area of northwest Delhi.

A smartphone with a banned video call and chat app that the family used to communicate with their kin in Bangladesh has been seized from them, he said.

During questioning, the family said that had entered the country illegally through the India-Bangladesh border in West Bengal's Cooch Behar district. They initially claimed Indian nationality but were found to be from Bangladesh Kurigram district, police said.

Panic grips Patna after miscreants fire in the air, flee

PTI, PATNA: Unidentified miscreants in an SUV fired several rounds in the air reportedly over a parking-related dispute at Patna's Boring Canal road area before fleeing, triggering panic in the locality, police said on Sunday.

No one was injured in the incident that took place on Saturday evening, they said.


Patna SSP Avakash Kumar told PTI that six police personnel have been suspended in connection with the incident for dereliction of duty.

"Unidentified miscreants in an SUV fired several rounds in the air at Boring Canal Road area. Incidentally, Additional ADG (Law and Order) Pankaj Darad was also present near the spot as he was returning from a meeting.

"The ADG's security guard also fired in the air near the GPO Golambar in an attempt to stop the assailants, who managed to escape, driving their vehicle recklessly. Darad also alerted the police control room," SDPO (Sachivalaya) Saket Kumar told reporters.

Eyewitnesses claimed that several rounds were fired in the air by the miscreants following a heated argument over a parking spot.






