**Over 100 ambulance workers go on strike in Shimla, demand minimum wage**  
HAMIRPUR/SHIMLA: Hundreds of 102 and 108 ambulance workers affiliated with the Centre of Indian Trade Unions (CITU) went on a 24-hour strike on Tuesday night. Union leaders on Wednesday explained that the strike was prompted by the ongoing discontent regarding the lack of minimum wage payments, which they say has led to harassment of workers. As a result, the ambulance workers will not provide services till 8 pm on Wednesday, they added. A meeting was held with the National Health Mission (NHM) Managing Director and Medswan Foundation Company State Head regarding the demands, however, the strike continued as there was no satisfactory response.

**Haryana intensifies pollution control efforts in Yamuna catchment**  
CHANDIGARH: In a concerted effort to rejuvenate the Yamuna River and strengthen pollution control initiatives, Haryana Chief Secretary Anurag Rastogi chaired a high-level meeting to assess the progress of projects in the Yamuna catchment area, an official statement said on Wednesday. The chief secretary emphasized the need for rigorous oversight and directed officials to review the status of all Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) projects bi-weekly to ensure timely progress. To strengthen pollution control measures, a task force has been established under the leadership of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB).

**UP: Teacher arrested for abducting, raping 15-year-old student in Ballia**  
BALLIA: A school teacher was arrested for allegedly abducting and raping his 15-year-old female student from the Bansdih police station area, officials said on Wednesday. The accused, identified as Mohammad Salauddin (26), was sent to judicial custody on Wednesday. The teenager, a resident of a village in the Bansdih police station area, was a student at a private school where Salauddin also taught. Salauddin was reportedly tutoring the minor for her high school studies.

**Student held for post on Indo-Pak conflict released from Pune jail**  
PTI, MUMBAI: A 19-year-old Pune student, arrested for a social media post concerning Indo-Pak hostilities, has been released from jail after the Bombay High Court granted her bail while rebuking the Maharashtra government for "ruining her life" and turning her into a "hardcore criminal". The girl was released from the Yerwada Central Jail on Tuesday night following the HC's order, as per her lawyer. In a rebuke to both the state and her educational institution, the court in its order on Tuesday also suspended the girl's rustication order issued by the Sinhgad Academy of Engineering.

# India's right to defend itself backed by countries across world: EAM

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** India gave a "firm, resolute and measured" response by destroying terror centres and launchpads in the wake of the Pahalgam attack, and the country's right to defend its people against terrorism has also been recognised by nations across the world, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said on Wednesday. In his address at an event held at the Italian embassy here, he also recalled the solidarity expressed by Italy following the "barbaric" terror attack on April 22 in which 26 lives were lost. The external affairs minister underlined that India-Italy bilateral ties are "undoubtedly on an upward trajectory". The event was hosted this evening to mark Italy's National Day. "We are thankful for Italy's solidarity and support to India following the barbaric terror attack in Pahalgam in Jam-

mu and Kashmir. India gave a firm and resolute and measured response by destroying the relevant terror centres and launchpads," Jaishankar said. India decimated nine terror camps in Pakistan and Pakistan-Occupied Kashmir with precision strikes early on May 7 under Operation Sindoor, in response to the dastardly Pahalgam massacre. "India's right to defend its people against acts of terror has also been recognised by countries across the world. We believe that the world will have zero tolerance for terrorism and cross-border terrorism," he said. In his address, Jaishankar said India's strategic partnership with Italy is based on "shared values and converging interests". This is evident on platforms like G20 and the meetings between Prime Minister Narendra Modi

and his Italian counterpart Giorgia Meloni at G20 and G7 fora. He underlined that India's partnership with Italy is also in multilateral initiatives such as the India-Middle East-Europe Economic Corridor, Global Biofuels Alliance, Indo-Pacific Oceans Initiative, International Solar Alliance, and the Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure. "Our bilateral relations have intensified after adoption of the Joint Strategic Action Plan for 2025-29, by our Prime Ministers last November. We are hopeful that the roadmap provided in the JSAP will result in concrete and practical outcome for our societies and peoples," he said. Trade and economic co-operation form an "important pillar of our partnership", the external affairs minister added. Jaishankar also underlined that the Indian diaspora in Italy

is among the largest in Europe, and they are well received and appreciated for their contribution in various sectors.

## AI to play key role in early diagnosis of thyroid disorders: AIIMS

**PTI, BHUBANESWAR:** AIIMS Bhubaneswar executive director Ashutosh Biswas on Wednesday said Artificial Intelligence (AI) is set to transform early diagnosis and management of thyroid disorders in the country. He highlighted the growing role of AI in personalised medicine, especially for hypothyroidism, which affects about 1 in 10 adults in the country. "AI diagnosis, which is set to be introduced in AIIMS Bhubaneswar, will help in early diagnosis, track the progression of disease, and support outcome-based medication, especially benefiting patients in rural and underserved areas," Biswas said. Asserting that hypothyroidism is three times more common in women than men, and about 33 per cent of patients remain undiagnosed, he said untreated hypothyroidism can adversely impact major organs including the heart, brain, kidneys, liver, intestines, and the reproductive system. Among children and infants, it can lead to stunted growth, obesity, developmental delays, and poor academic performance, he added.

## 44 MLAs to form new government in Manipur, claims BJP

**PTI, IMPHAL:** Forty-four MLAs are ready to form a new government in Manipur, BJP legislator Thokchom Radheshyam Singh claimed on Wednesday after meeting Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla. Singh, along with nine other MLAs, met the governor at the Raj Bhavan. "Forty-four MLAs are ready to form a government as per the wishes of the people. We have conveyed this to the governor. We also discussed what solutions can be there for the issue," he said. "The governor noted what we had to say and will initiate actions in the best interests of the people," he added. Asked if they would stake a claim to form the government, he said the central leadership of the BJP will take the decision. "However, to inform that we are ready is similar to staking a claim to form a government. Speaker Th Satyabrata has individually and jointly met the 44 MLAs. There is no one who opposes the formation of a new government," Singh said. "People are facing too much hardship. In the previous term, two years

were lost due to COVID, and in this term, another two years have been lost due to the conflict," he said. Manipur has been under President's Rule since February after BJP leader N Biren Singh resigned as the chief minister, amid criticisms about his government's handling of the ethnic clashes between Meiteis and Kuki-Zos, which broke out in May 2023. The 60-member assembly at present has 59 MLAs, with one seat vacant due to the death of a legislator. In the BJP-led coalition, there are 32 Meitei MLAs, three Manipuri Muslim MLAs and nine Naga legislators, totalling 44. The Congress has five MLAs - all Meiteis. The remaining 10 MLAs are Kukis - seven of them won the last election on a BJP ticket, two belong to the Kuki Peoples' Alliance, and one is an Independent. The development comes amid massive protests in the Meitei-inhabited Imphal Valley over the hiding of the state's name written on the windshield of a government bus by security forces.

# Kerala deploys volunteers to clean plastic pellets after shipwreck

**PTI, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM:** In response to plastic pellets (nurdles) washing ashore after a cargo shipwreck off the Kerala coast, the state government has launched a major clean-up operation. Following a high-level meeting of experts, Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan said on Wednesday that volunteers are being stationed every 100 metres along the shoreline, guided by drone surveys, to remove the pellets and prevent environmental damage. Police, fire services, and pollution control officers are coordinating the efforts. Volunteers have received safety training, and supervisors are ensuring that no one undertakes dangerous tasks. In a statement, the Chief

Minister's Office said the government's top priorities are public safety, environmental protection, and safeguarding the fishing industry. The statement added that instructions have already been issued to coastal local self-government institutions and fishing communities on how

to handle unusual items or containers that wash ashore. In addition, fishing activities have been completely prohibited within a 20-nautical-mile radius around the wreck site. "Rapid response teams, under the leadership of the Pollution Control Board,

are prepared to handle any oil spill reaching the coast. Local arrangements, including oil booms, have been made, and installations have been advised at estuaries and river mouths," the statement said. The meeting of experts, convened at the instruction of Vijayan, brought together international and national specialists, including Dr Muralee Thummarukudy, known globally for his work in disaster management. Officials from Kerala's disaster response and environment departments also attended. Senior state officials, including the Chief Secretary and District Collectors, were also present, the release added.
