Torrential rain, landslides in K'ataka leave 5 dead

PTI, MANGALURU (KARNATAKA): Heavy rains and landslides across Karnataka's coastal Dakshina Kannada district have claimed five lives, officials said on Friday.

On Thursday night, a landslide struck a home at Montepadavu Kodi near here, trapping five people under debris, they said.

According to officials, a woman and her child were pulled from the debris and hospitalised in critical condition. However, another child of the woman was found dead.

Heavy rains overnight triggered a landslide around 4 am, collapsing the house where six members of the Poojary family were asleep.

Among the deceased were three-year-old Aryan and his two-year-old brother Aarush. Their grandmother, Prema Poo-

jary, also died in the incident.

Ashwini, their mother, tried to shield the children with her body as a wall came crashing down. Eyewitnesses said she was found under the debris, unconscious but still clutching her children. "I don't care what happens to me, please save my children," she had reportedly

pleaded as neighbours attempted a risky rescue amid continuing landslides.

However, Ashwini's husband Sitaram narrowly escaped by rushing out after hearing the landslide while his father Kantappa Poojary who sustained injuries, was rescued by locals and admitted to a hospital, a senior official said.

The National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), and local police were involved in the rescue operations.

A video taken by locals showed the harrowing moments. The younger child, Aarush, was seen trying to crawl out from the rubble, while Aryan had already succumbed.

Local rescue efforts had to pause due to unstable ground conditions until professional teams arrived.

Heavy rains and the limited access to the site had hampered rescue operations.

The National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), and local police were involved in the rescue operations.

In another incident at Deralakatte in Mangaluru, a compound wall collapsed on a house on Friday morning, killing a six-year-old girl identified as Fatima Naem. Authorities have issued

warnings for vulnerable zones in the region, as intermittent rains continue to batter the coastal belt.

In another rain-related incident, a 27-year-old lineman died of electrocution while attempting to repair a high-tension (HT) line in this coastal district on Thursday amid heavy rain, police said.

The incident occurred in Amar Jalu, a village in Kuvettu, Belthangady taluk, they said.

According to police, the deceased, Vijesh Jain, was a resident of Kuvettu and was engaged in HT line restoration work when he allegedly came into contact with a live wire. He was the

second son of Sukumar Jain and Pournima.

A case has been registered at Belthangady police station in connection with the incident.

Kerala floods: Homes damaged, power outages, disruptions amid heavy rains

PTI, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Houses in low lying areas of Kerala were flooded in the heavy rains, while the accompanying strong winds uprooted trees, damaged homes and caused power disruptions, throwing normal way of life into disarray across the state.

In Thrissur, Kannur and Kasaragod districts, there were reports of several homes getting flooded due to the heavy rains, forcing people to move to relief camps.

Not just homes, but many roads in these districts and other parts of the state were inundated due to the heavy rains.

In Pathanamthitta, Kottayam and Idukki districts, the heavy rains and strong winds uprooted trees and damaged electricity poles and transformers, leading to partial and complete destruction of hundreds of homes and power disruptions for hours, according to the authorities.

3 DIE AS HEAVY RAIN LASHES MEGHALAYA
PTI, SHILONG: Three persons, including an elderly woman and a minor, died in Meghalaya's East Khasi Hills district following heavy rain in the past 24 hours, officials said on Friday.

The woman, 50, died in Lumkyntung village due to a landslide, while a 35-year-old man drowned in Pamlakrai Mawbnyna as incessant rain inundated the area, they said.

Another death was reported from Mawkyntung Block when a tree fell on a 15-year-old boy, the officials said.

ONE DROWNS, OVER 200 SHELTERED IN RELIEF CAMPS IN TRIPURA AFTER RAIN

PTI, AGARTALA: A 16-year-old boy drowned in a pond while 57 families took shelter in relief camps as rainfall inundated several low-lying areas in Tripura, an official said on Friday.

Several low-lying areas are under water due to intermittent rain since Thursday but the situation is under control till now, Revenue Department Secretary Brijesh Pandey said at a press conference.

He said Tapan Debnath (16), a resident of Jirania in West Tripura district, drowned in a pond where he had gone with his father to catch fish on Friday morning.

Kottayam district on Saturday, district authorities said. In Kollam, uprooted trees and falling branches, due to the rains and strong

winds, caused damage to several homes and private vehicles in the district and a few persons were reportedly injured.

An 85-year-old woman, who worked as a MGN-REGA worker in Ernakulam district, died when an uprooted tree fell on top of her while returning home on Thursday evening.

The Ernakulam district authorities also reported a rise in the water level of the Muvattupuzha River above the flood warning markers, leading to the opening of three shutters of the Malankara Dam by 20 centimetres (cm).

Train services were also affected with some, including the Mangaluru-Thiruvananthapuram Vande Bharat Express, being diverted due to fallen trees on the tracks, while others were rescheduled or delayed due to the heavy rains, authorities said.

A red alert by IMD indicates heavy to extremely heavy rain of over 20 cm in 24 hours, while an orange alert means very heavy rain of 11 cm to 20 cm, and a yellow alert means heavy rainfall between 6 cm and 11 cm.

SEBI cracks down on Arshad Warsi, Maria Goretti in Rs 58 crore pump-and-dump scam

AGENCY, MUMBAI: The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has taken action against Bollywood actor Arshad Warsi, his wife Maria Goretti, and 57 others for their involvement in a pump-and-dump scheme linked to Sadhna Broadcast Limited, now rebranded as Crystal Business System Ltd.

SEBI has barred the couple and other individuals from participating in securities markets for periods ranging from one to five years. The crackdown follows an exten-

WHAT IS A PUMP-AND-DUMP?
In a pump-and-dump scheme, individuals seek to artificially inflate the price or perceived worth of a stock through deceptive means, such as issuing fraudulent recommendations, as demonstrated in this case by the use of YouTube videos. Once the manipulation drives up the stock value, the perpetrators swiftly sell off their stake in the company at the inflated price, resulting in significant financial gains.

sive probe into a coordinated stock manipulation scheme that involved deceptive YouTube promotions and structured trading patterns. The market regulator has also

ordered the return of Rs 58.01 crore in unlawful gains, with 12% annual interest from the end of the investigation period, and imposed fines of Rs 5 lakh each on Warsi and

Goretti. The investigation revealed that the couple bought and sold shares just before and after misleading promotional videos caused a surge in the stock price. On July 13, 2022, Arshad Warsi purchased 2,01,741 shares, while Maria acquired 3,20,204 shares from other entities involved in the scheme. They sold these shares shortly after the stock price spiked, making illegal gains of Rs 41.7 lakh and Rs 50.35 lakh respectively.
