# Reveal truth to country: Cong to govt after CDS remarks

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** The Congress asked the government on Saturday to truthfully tell the country what losses were suffered during the four-day conflict with Pakistan after Chief of Defence Staff Gen Anil Chauhan acknowledged aircraft loss in the hostilities.

Gen Chouhan, however, dismissed as "absolutely incorrect" Islamabad's claim of downing six Indian jets.

Latching on to the comment by the chief of defence staff (CDS), Congress leader Uttam Kumar Reddy said the country wanted to know whether any aircraft were downed during the conflict, especially in the wake of the CDS' "admission".

Congress general secretary Jairam Ramesh said that on July 29, 1999, the Vajpayee government set up the Kargil Review Committee under the chairmanship of "India's strategic affairs guru K Subrahmanyan, whose son is now our

external affairs minister". This was just three days after the Kargil war ended, he said.

"The committee submitted its detailed report five months later. The report titled 'From Surprise to Reckoning' was then laid on the Table of both Houses of Parliament on February 23, 2000, after the necessary redactions.

"Will the Modi government now take a similar step in light of what the Chief of Defence Staff has just revealed in Singapore?" Ramesh posed in a post on X.

Soon after CDS Gen Chouhan's remarks, made



during an interview with Bloomberg TV, got published, Reddy took the opportunity to say, "It appears very clearly a Rafale fighter aircraft was downed in the four-day operations."

"Today, an hour ago, CDS Gen Chauhan has confirmed that a Rafale aircraft was brought down in the four-day operation. The fact that the fighter aircraft were down is something that the Government of India needs to stop denying. The CDS himself mentioned that."

At a press conference, the Congress leader said, "Earlier, Air Marshal

(Awadesh Kumar) Bharti had mentioned it indirectly in his briefing along with the DGMO. He specifically said that 'losses are normal in combat; the mission objective of the operation has been achieved, and all pilots have come home.'"

He said when Rahul Gandhi first pointed it out in a question to External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar, it was "very bizarre and strange" that the ruling party functionaries at all levels accused him of not being patriotic.

"We are happy that the objectives (of Operation Sindoor) have been achieved, but the fact that the fighter aircraft were down is something that needs to be... the Government of India should stop denying that. The CDS himself has mentioned it and Air Marshal Bharti had also done so," Reddy said.

The Telangana minister reiterated that the Congress supports the Indian armed forces in every endeavour. "The party congratulates them as they have done a great job and we are proud of them, we salute them," he said.

"Today the whole country must realise that for some reason the Government of India were not up-front with whatever happened.

The other thing that needs reassessment by the government is that most of the firing in the four-day operation was done by respective countries from within their borders; still, we lost our aircraft.

"I think, this needs serious reassessment of technology so that lessons are learnt and we go forward and improve in those aspects," Reddy, a former IAF pilot, said.

He refuted allegations that his party was playing politics over the issue and said that after every war or conflict, all nation discloses what losses they inflicted on the enemy and what losses they suffered.

# Defamation case: Court rejects Rahul's plea on Savarkar grand-nephew's maternal lineage

**PTI, PUNE:** A court here on Saturday rejected

Rahul Gandhi's application seeking details of the maternal lineage of Satyaki Savarkar, the grand-nephew of V D Savarkar, over his defamation complaint filed against the Congress leader for his alleged objectionable remarks against the Hindutva ideology.

Judicial Magistrate (First Class) Amol Shinde dismissed the application, observing that the case pertains to an alleged defamatory speech made by Gandhi in London and not to the family tree of late Himani Ashok Savarkar, the mother of Satyaki Savarkar.

Himani Savarkar was the daughter of Gopal Vinayak Godse, the younger brother of Mahatma Gandhi's assassin Nathuram Godse.

# Chhattisgarh coal levy 'scam': 3 among 6 walk out of jail after SC relief

**PTI, RAIPUR:** Two days after being granted interim bail by the Supreme Court in the Chhattisgarh coal-levy scam case, two suspended IAS officers and a former deputy secretary in the chief minister's office walked out of jail on Saturday.

Defence counsel Faizal Rizvi told reporters that Sameer Vishnoi and Ranu Sahu, both IAS officers, and Saumya Chaurasia, a deputy secretary in the CMO during the previous Bhupesh Baghel government, and three others were released from Raipur central jail.

The SC has granted interim bail to eight persons, of whom two individuals - Suryakant Tiwari and Nikhil Chandrakar - have not been released (due to other pending cases), he said.

The Enforcement Directorate (ED), which has been probing the money laundering angle in the alleged coal-levy scam

since 2022, had arrested Vishnoi in October 2022 and Chaurasia in December the same year. The central agency had taken Sahu into custody in July 2023.

Rizvi said the bureaucrat trio has been granted interim bail in the two cases related to the alleged coal-levy scam, one each registered by the ED and the state's Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB).

A Supreme Court bench of Justices Surya Kant and Dipankar Datta on Thursday imposed several conditions on the accused while granting them interim bail and asked the state government to generate confidence among the witnesses and ensure their protection.

The SC has directed Sahu, Vishnoi and Chaurasia not to stay in Chhattisgarh till further orders, except when they are required to be present before the investigating agency or the trial court.

# Delhi reports first Covid death amid surge in cases

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** A 60-year-old woman who was suffering from acute intestinal obstruction and had tested positive for COVID-19 has died in Delhi, officials said on Saturday.

According to official data, Delhi has 294 active COVID-19 cases.

"The woman was suffering from acute intestinal obstruction post-laparotomy. The COVID-19 finding was incidental," an official said.

Another official said a detailed report is awaited but stressed the preliminary findings suggest the woman was immunocompromised. He stressed that there was no need to panic.

This is the first fatality in the capital amid the current surge in coronavirus cases. Chief Minister Rekha Gupta said on Thursday that 19 Covid patients are hospitalised in Delhi, but there is no need to worry. The Delhi government is alert and hospitals are prepared to deal with any

## 63-YEAR-OLD MAN TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 DIES IN BENGALURU

**PTI, BENGALURU:** A 63-year-old man with co-morbidities and who tested positive for Covid-19 died at a private hospital here, taking the coronavirus-related death toll in the state to four, officials said on Saturday. He was admitted to a private hospital in Bengaluru Urban (Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike limits) on May 21 after he complained of weakness and died on May 29, they said. According to the health department statement, the elderly patient who was fully vaccinated was on post-operative chemotherapy and had co-morbidities like pulmonary TB with squamous cell carcinoma of buccal mucosa. The patient died due to sagittal sinus, internal jugular vein thrombosis with cancer cachexia with incidental Covid positive status, it added. Meanwhile, the health department bulletin pegged active Covid-19 cases at 238 in Karnataka as of May 31, with 58 new cases reported on Saturday. The day also saw a total of 420 tests being done for Covid, including 354 RTPCR and 66 RAT tests.

# Kuki groups want buffer zones maintained in Manipur

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Kuki groups on Saturday demanded that buffer zones should be maintained in Manipur as a "protective measure" unless a comprehensive political solution such as a Union territory with legislature is achieved.

At a press conference here, co-convenor of Kuki Zo Women Forum Chong Haokip reiterated the demand for carving out a Union territory with legislature from Manipur and said, "This is not against any community, this is a step required to ensure safety and right to existence of Kuki people."

She said that this demand should not be seen from a political angle, but as one required for safety and peace.

"Kuki-Zo tribals have been chased out of Imphal, killed like animals. We were treated like enemies. We were killed because of our identity and the security forces didn't intervene in time. Government could

have saved us, but they didn't do anything," Haokip alleged.

"Those living in Imphal for years were dislocated. The faith of Kuki Zo people has been shaken. Despite having police, our people were being killed," she claimed.

C Thangminlal Dounge, interim president of Kuki Students' Organisation Delhi & NCR, said buffer zones were a critical measure taken to halt violence and restore order.

"Unless a political solution is found, the buffer zones must be maintained. The status quo is required because so far, peace has not been achieved," he said.

The Kuki representatives also said their demand is within the tenets of the Constitution.

"So many states have been reorganised, recently, Jammu and Kashmir was reorganised into two Union territories. So what is the thing about Manipur's integrity? The Constitution recognises integrity of the country, not

of any state," said advocate Vishwajet Singh.

Haokip said they have been forced to demand a separate administration due to the "discrimination and violence" they faced.

She also claimed that several Kuki women have faced violence, and recalled the incident when two women were paraded naked.

"Kuki women were paraded naked, and police did not do anything," she alleged.

The KSO Delhi & NCR also demanded in a statement that the government should "fence the buffer zones".

"The buffer zones must remain intact and enforced until a comprehensive political solution such as a Union territory with legislature for the Kuki-Zo is achieved. If the majoritarian government is so hell bent on border fencing - it must also fence the buffer zones as that will act as permanent deterrent to the fragile peace in Manipur," the KSO said.
