Trump-Musk showdown: how it unfolded

A bitter war of words between the two culminated in Musk dropping the Epslein bomb

AFP, PARIS: A timeline in quotes of the public melt-down of Donald Trump and Elon Musk's relationship over several astonishing hours on Thursday.

"Look, Elon and I had a great relationship. I don't know if we will anymore. I was surprised," Trump told reporters in the Oval Office.

The US president was responding to comments made by Musk two days earlier in which Musk had called his "big, beautiful bill" on tax and spending a "disgusting abomination".

Responding on X to Trump's comments on Thursday, Musk fired back at 12:19 pm local time:

"ditch the MOUNTAIN of DISGUSTING PORK in the bill... Either you get a big and ugly bill or a slim and beautiful bill. Slim and beautiful is the way."

In the Oval Office, Trump continued:

"I'm very disappointed, because Elon knew the inner workings of this bill

better than almost anybody sitting here... All of a sudden, he had a problem."

To this, South African-born Musk responded:

"False, this bill was never shown to me even once

and was passed in the dead of night so fast that almost no one in Congress could even read it!" (12:25 pm)

And then in a fresh post 21 minutes later:

"Without me, Trump would have lost the election, Dems would control the House and the Republicans would be 51-49 in the Senate."

"Such ingratitude."

Just over an hour later, at 1:57 pm, Musk carried on, with a post that he pinned to the top of his timeline:

"Is it time to create a new political party in America that actually represents the 80% in the middle?"

Trump fired back on Truth Social under an hour later, as the spat got increasingly bitter.

"The easiest way to save money in our Budget, Billions and Billions of Dollars, is to terminate Elon's Governmental Subsidies and Contracts. I was always surprised that Biden didn't do it!" (2:37 pm)

US media have put the value of the contracts at \$18 billion.

At 3:10 pm Musk referred to US government documents on disgraced financier Jeffrey Epstein, who committed suicide in jail while awaiting trial for sex crimes.

"Time to drop the really big bomb: @realDonaldTrump is in the Epstein

files. That is the real reason they have not been made public. Have a nice day, DJT!"

"I don't mind Elon turning against me, but he should have done so months ago. This is one of the Greatest Bills ever presented to Congress." (Trump, 4:06 pm).

"In light of the President's statement about cancellation of my government contracts, @SpaceX will begin decommissioning its Dragon spacecraft immediately" (Musk, 4:09 pm)

SpaceX's Crew Dragon is currently the only US spacecraft certified to carry crew to the International Space Station under a contract worth more than \$4.9 billion.

Later in the day, Musk appeared to walk back his earlier comment on this subject, replying to a user on X: "OK, we won't decommission Dragon," though his tone was unclear.

Iran warns European powers against passing resolution on Tehran's non-compliance

AFP, TEHRAN, IRAN: Iran warned European powers on Friday against backing a draft resolution at the International Atomic Energy Agency next week accusing Tehran of non-compliance, calling it a "strategic mistake".

"Instead of engaging in good faith, the E3 is opting for malign action against Iran at the IAEA Board of Governors," Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said on X, referring to Britain, France and Germany.

"Mark my words as Europe ponders another major strategic mistake: Iran will react strongly against any violation of its rights."

cuse Iran of failing to meet its nuclear obligations and carries the threat of referral to the UN Security Council if Tehran "does not show goodwill", the source added.

Araghchi said Tehran had demonstrated 'years of good cooperation with the IAEA - resulting in a resolution which shut down malign claims of a 'possible military dimension' (PMD) to Iran's peaceful nuclear programme'.

The warning from Iran's top diplomat comes as the three European governments prepare to join Washington in backing a censure resolution at next week's board meeting, a diplomatic source told AFP.

The resolution would ac-

"My country is once again accused of 'non-compliance,'" he added, blaming "shoddy and politicised reporting".

The criticism follows a quarterly report from the IAEA last week which cited a "general lack of cooperation" from Iran and raised concerns over undeclared nuclear material.

Tehran rejected the report as politically motivated and based on "forged documents" it said had been provided by its arch foe Israel.

B'desh interim government chief

PTI, DHAKA: Bangladesh interim government chief Muhammad Yunus on Friday said national elections will be held by the first half of April 2026 amid demands from major political parties to hold polls by December.

"Based on this announcement, the Election Commission will provide a detailed roadmap for the elections at an appropriate time," he said during a televised address to the nation on the eve of the Eid-ul-Adha festival.

Yunus, who took charge after the toppling of the former premier Sheikh Hasina-led Awami League government in August last year, said that the government's key responsibility is to hold a clean, peaceful, festive, and inclusive election.

"Our goal is to prevent future crises. That requires institutional reform. Without ensuring good governance in the institutions directly linked to the electoral process, all the sacrifices made by students and citizens will be in vain," the 84-year-old Nobel Laureate said.

Yunus said his administration took over to carry

out three mandates "justice, reform and elections".

"I have repeatedly said that this election will be held between December and June next year. The government is doing whatever is necessary to create an environment conducive to elections in the country during this period," he said.

Yunus said he expected the reforms and justice issues would reach an "acceptable stage" ahead of the Muslim fasting month of Ramadan next year, which is to be observed from mid-February to mid-March 2026.

The interim government refers to the "justice" issue as the trial of leaders and officials of deposed prime minister Hasina's now disbanded Awami League and

her government that was ousted in a violent movement led by the Students against Discrimination (SAD) on August 5, 2024.

Yunus, who was in Paris at that time, flew from the French capital to take charge of the interim administration as its chief adviser three days later.

A large part of the leadership of the SAD floated the National Citizen Party (NCP) with Yunus's blessings in February this year.

Hasina, who now lives in India, and most of her senior colleagues in the party and government are in jail or fled the country as the interim government accused them of committing crimes against humanity, which may lead to capital punishment.

Canada, China agree to 'regularise communications'

AFP, MONTREAL, CANADA: Canada and China have agreed to regularise channels of communication, the office of Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney said, after a period of strained diplomatic ties between the two countries.

Tensions in the relationship soared following Ottawa's arrest of a senior Chinese telecom executive on a US warrant in 2018, remaining high in subsequent years amid disputes over human rights and election interference allegations.

During the call between Carney and Chinese Premier Li Qiang, "the leaders exchanged views on bilateral relations, including the importance of engagement, and agreed to regularize channels of communication between Canada and China," the prime minister's office said in a statement late on Thursday.

They also discussed trade and "committed their governments to working together to address the fentanyl crisis," the statement added.

According to Beijing's state news agency Xinhua, Li told Carney that relations between the countries "have faced unnecessary disturbances and encountered serious difficulties" in recent years.

He added that China is "willing to work with Canada to jointly uphold multilateralism and free trade" in the face of growing unilateralism and protectionism, Xinhua reported, noting that the call came at Carney's request.

The comments were a reference to major disruptions in global trade throughout recent weeks caused by US President Donald Trump, who has slapped stinging tariffs on allies and adversaries alike since beginning a second term in January.

China and Canada – both major US trading partners – have been on the receiving end of Washington's recent tariff blitz.
