Visuals provided by the maritime security agencies showed the fire engulfing the mid section of the Singapore-flagged container vessel measuring 270 metres in length with a draught of 12.5 metres.

The Coast Guard said it initiated an immediate response, deploying two Dornier aircraft equipped with life rafts for aerial surveillance and situational assessment.

Five ICG ships, including specialised firefighting and pollution response vessels, have been mobilised to the incident site.

Espionage case: Punjab YouTuber Jasbir sent to judicial custody

PTI, CHANDIGARH: A Mohali court on Monday sent Punjab-based YouTuber Jasbir Singh arrested on espionage charges to judicial custody.

Singh was produced before the court after the completion of this two-day police remand. Post his arrest on June

4. he was sent to three days of police remand following which it was extended for two days. Singh's counsel Mohit

Dhupar said he will be produced in court again on June 23.

Jasbir Singh alias Jaan Mahal (41), who hails from Mahlan Village in Rupnagar District, was running a YouTube channel "Jaan-Mahal Video" with over 11 lakh subscribers, ostensibly posting travel and

cooking vlogs.

Singh was alleged to be in close touch with Harvana-based influencer Jyoti Malhotra, who is in judicial custody on charges of spying for Pakistan.

After Singh's arrest, Punjab Police claimed that it unearthed a "terror-backed espionage network" linking him to Pakistani intelligence and army officials.

Police said that the You-Tuber was allegedly spying for Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence.

The accused travelled to Pakistan on three occasions including in 2020, 2021 and 2024, and came into direct contact with ISI officers, who subsequently cultivated and recruited him to carry out espionage activities within India, police added.

School jobs: Cal HC reserves newly emerging judgment on plea over monetary **COVID-19 variant** support to non-teaching staff XFG detected in India: INSACOG

The West Bengal government and the School Service Commission have filed respective review petitions over the judgment, annulling the 25,753 appointments, before the Supreme Court.



Assam flood remains critical 2.6 lakh still affected

flood situation in Assam remained critical with around 2.6 lakh people in six districts still suffering from the deluge on Monday, even as the water levels continued to recede in many parts of the state, officials said. A senior official of

the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) told PTI that the floodwaters continued to recede in almost all inundated areas, with most parts of the state not witnessing any rain in the last 24 hours.

"If it does not rain today, we hope that the situation will improve considerably in most parts of the state," he added.

A report, issued by the ASDMA on Sunday night, said that three more people lost their lives in Kamrup district, and around 2.6 lakh people are suffering from the deluge across six districts.

The total number of people who lost their lives in this year's flood and landslides has increased to 26.

Sribhumi is the worst

PTI. GUWAHATI: The hit with over 1.62 lakh people suffering, followed by Hailakandi with almost 52,000 and Cachar with more than 36,000 reeling under floodwaters, it added.

The administration has been operating 130 relief camps and relief distribution centres in four districts, taking care of 24,908 displaced people currently.


The authorities have distributed 262.2 quintals of rice, 46.02 quintals of dal, 21.2 quintals of salt and 2,122.53 litres of mustard oil among the flood victims of the state in the last 24 hours.

At present, 741 villages are under water and 6,311.16 hectares of crop areas have been damaged across Assam, the ASDMA said.

Embankments, roads, bridges and other infrastructure have been damaged by flood waters in many districts across the state.

Currently, no river is flowing above the danger level.

On account of widespread flooding, over 1.44.597 domestic animals and poultry are affected across the state.
