

Ahmedabad plane crash: 231 victims identified

210 bodies handed over to kin

PTI, AHMEDABAD: Over a week after 270 people were killed in the Ahmedabad plane crash, 231 victims have been identified through DNA tests, and the mortal remains of 210 of them were handed over to their families, a health official said on Friday.

A London-bound Air India flight AI-171 carrying 242 passengers and crew members crashed in Ahmedabad on June 12. All but one on board the plane died along

DELHI-PUNE AIR INDIA FLIGHT SUFFERS BIRD HIT, RETURN JOURNEY CANCELLED

PTI, MUMBAI: Air India Pune-bound flight from Delhi suffered a bird hit on Friday, forcing the airline to cancel its return journey. The aircraft landed safely and the bird hit was detected after it touched down in Pune, the airline said in a statement. It has been grounded and extensive checks are being carried out by the engineering team, Air India said. "Flight AI2470 scheduled to operate from Pune to Delhi on June 20 has been cancelled due to a bird-hit which was detected after the incoming flight landed safely in Pune," it said. The airline also said it is making all arrangements, including providing accommodation for the stranded passengers. Refunds on cancellation or complimentary rescheduling is also being offered to passengers who opt for it, the airline said, adding that alternative arrangements are being made to fly the passengers to Delhi.

with nearly 29 on the ground when the aircraft smashed into a medical complex in Meghaninagar area of the city shortly af-

ter its take-off. Authorities are carrying out DNA matching to establish the identity of the victims, as several bodies

were charred beyond recognition or damaged.

"Till Friday evening, 231 DNA samples have been matched and relatives have been contacted. So far, the mortal remains of 210 victims have been handed over to families," Medical Superintendent of Ahmedabad Civil Hospital Rakesh Joshi said.

The 210 victims comprise 166 Indians, 36 British nationals, seven Portuguese nationals and one Canadian, he said. Of the 166 Indians, a total of 155 were on board the ill-fated aircraft, Joshi informed.

The Indian victims who were identified so far belonged to various parts of the country, including Gujarat, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Diu and Nagaland, he said.

Air India cancels 8 flights, 4 of them int'l services

PTI, MUMBAI: Air India has cancelled eight flights, including four international services, on Friday due to enhanced maintenance and operational reasons, the airline said.

Air India said its teams on the ground are making alternative arrangements for the passengers to fly to their respective destinations at the earliest.

It has also offered full refunds on cancellation to passengers, the airline said. The international flights to be cancelled were AI906 from Dubai to Chennai, AI308 from Delhi to Melbourne, AI309 from Melbourne to Delhi, and AI2204 from Dubai to Hyderabad.

Air India said four domestic flights - AI874 from Pune to Delhi, AI456 from Ahmedabad to Delhi, AI-2872 from Hyderabad to Mumbai, and AI571 from Chennai to Mumbai - have been cancelled.

Honeymoon murder: Victim's kin seek detailed questioning of Sonam to know 'complete truth'

PTI, INDORE: The elder brother of Raja Raghuvanshi, who was murdered in Meghalaya during his honeymoon trip, has alleged that the victim's wife Sonam Raghuvanshi is misleading the police, demanding that she be subjected to detailed questioning.

He said on Thursday that Sonam and four other accused in the case must be brought to Indore for a thorough investigation to uncover the "complete truth" behind the murder, which sent shockwaves across the country.

The remarks came on a day a Shillong court extended the police custody of Sonam and her alleged paramour Raj Kushwaha by two days.

"Sonam misled the investigators during her eight-day police custody and withheld key details about the murder. She must be remanded in police custody for a longer period for proper interrogation," Raja's brother Sachin Raghuvanshi told PTI in Indore.

He reiterated the demand for a narcoanalysis test of Sonam's entire family, al-

leging that her relatives and friends might also have played a role in the conspiracy to murder his brother.

"It is not easy to plan such a massive conspiracy. The motive behind my brother's murder must be clearly established. For that, Sonam and the other accused should be brought to Indore for detailed questioning," he added.

Raja's mother Uma Raghuvanshi broke down while remembering her late son and kept asking: "Why did Sonam get my son killed?"

Iran lifts airspace restrictions to help evacuate 1,000 Indians

PTI, NEW DELHI: In a special gesture, Iran has lifted airspace restrictions for three charter flights to evacuate about 1,000 Indian nationals, mostly students, from the Iranian city of Mashhad.

Mohammad Javad Hosseini, the deputy chief of mission at the Iranian embassy, said more evacuation flights could be operated in the coming days to bring back Indians if required.

The Indian nationals were moved to Mashhad from Tehran following Israeli attacks on the Iranian capital city. The evacuation flights, to be operated by Iranian airline Mahan, are being arranged by New Delhi.

India launched Operation Sindhu on Wednesday to bring back its nationals from Iran and Israel in view of the precarious security situation arising out of Iran-Israel hostilities. The first chartered flight carrying Indians are set to land in Delhi on Friday evening.

"We consider Indians as our own people. Iran's airspace is closed but because of this issue, we are making arrangements to open it for the safe passage of Indian nationals," Hosseini said at a media briefing.

"We are arranging for the safe passage of Indians who want to leave via air or via road, through third countries, or directly from Iran - Mohammad Javad Hosseini, Deputy chief of Iranian embassy

"We consider Indian nationals to be our own people. They are like Iranians," he said.

"About 1,000 Indians who were relocated from Tehran to Qom and then to Mashhad will be evacuated to New Delhi on three charter flights," Hosseini said.

"The first flight will land tonight at the New Delhi airport and there will be two more flights on Saturday," he said.

The Iranian diplomat said more such flights could be arranged in the coming days if required.

Hosseini said Tehran is in close contact with the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and the Indian embassy in Tehran to ensure safe evacuation of Indian nationals.

"We are arranging for the safe passage of Indians who want to leave via air or via road through third countries, or directly from Iran," he said.

Not necessary for woman to get husband's signature for applying passport: HC

PTI, CHENNAI: The Madras High Court has held that it is not necessary for a woman to get the permission of her husband and take his signature before applying for a passport before the authorities.

Justice N Anand Venkatesh gave the ruling in a recent order while disposing of a petition filed by Revathy. She sought a direction to the authorities to issue a fresh passport without insisting signature from her husband in a time bound manner.

The case of the petitioner was that she got married in the year 2023 and that there was a matrimonial dispute between the parties which resulted in her husband filing a petition before a local court, seeking for the dissolution of the marriage. This petition was pending.

The petitioner, applied for a passport in April this year before the Regional Passport Office (RPO) in the city. It was not processed and when enquired, the petitioner was informed that she must obtain the signature of her husband in

Form-J and only thereafter, the application will be processed by RPO.

The RPO also took into consideration the pending dispute between the petitioner and her husband before the Court.
