

GAUMVADDI, ANJUNA: The Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB) suspended operations of M/s Diaz on June 18, 2025, just a day before the Goa Bench of the Bombay High Court was set to resume its hearing on Contempt Petition 12 of 2023. The show cause hearing was scheduled two days later. However, locals reported that M/s Diaz continued to play loud music on June 18, 19, and 20, causing sleepless nights and raising concerns that the unit was trying to mislead the court. "On one hand, the government authorities are informing the judges, hearing the Contempt Petition, that action is being initiated, whilst on the other, loud music is continuously being played till early morning in

Killed three Iranian commanders, says Israel

AFP, JERUSALEM: Israel said Saturday it had killed three Iranian commanders in its unprecedented bombing campaign across the Islamic republic, which Foreign Minister Gideon Saar claimed had already delayed Tehran's presumed nuclear plans by two years.

Israel's military said its fighter jets targeted top Iranian official Saeed Izadi, in charge of coordination with Palestinian militant group Hamas, in Qom south of Tehran and announced the deaths of two other commanders from Iran's Revolutionary Guards. Israeli foreign minister Gideon Saar said by the country's own assessment it had "already delayed for at least two or three years the possibility for them to have a nuclear bomb". "We will do everything that we can do there in order to remove this threat," Saar told German newspaper Bild, asserting Israel's onslaught would continue.

poll body instructed its officers to destroy CCTV, webcasting and video footage of the elections after

45 days. "Voter list? Will not give machine-readable format. CCTV footage? Hidden by changing the law. Election photos and videos? Now they will be deleted in 45 days, not 1 year. The one who was supposed to provide answers - is the one deleting the evidence," Gandhi alleged in a post on X.

"It is clear that the match is fixed. And a fixed election is poison for democracy," the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha posted in Hindi.
